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PULLOVER · GOMITOLO ALOHA

Design 11 – Filati Gomitolo 05

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Size 36/38 (40/42, 44)

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

Materials: 500 (500, 600) g of Lana Grossa **Gomitolo Aloha** (50% cotton, 50% viscose; 250 m/100 g) in Ochre/Blackberry/Umbra/Aubergine/Emerald/Turquoise/Green (**col 303**). Size 4.5 mm needles; size 4 mm circular needle, 40 cm long.

Rib patt: P1, k1.

St st: K on RS, p on WS.

Two-stitch selvage: On RS row, sl 1 pwise wyib, k1, patt to last 2 sts, k1, sl 1 pwise wyib. On WS row, p1, sl 1 pwise wyif, patt to last 2 sts, sl 1 pwise wyif, p1.

Full-fashion decrease: At beg of RS row, selvage st, k2, skp.

Full-fashion increase: At beg of RS row, selvage st, k2, M1R.

Gauge: 19 sts and 28 rows = 10 x 10 cm in St st on size 4.5 mm needles.

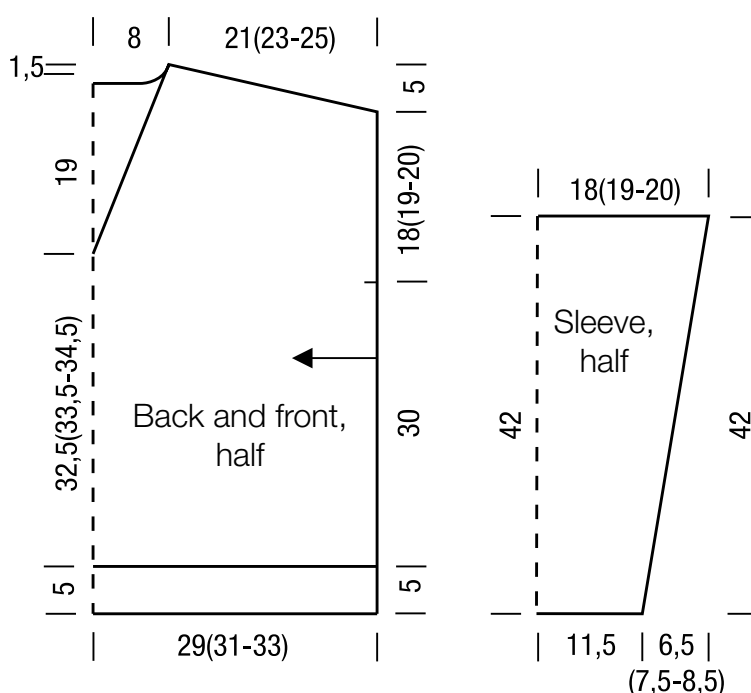
Note: Back and front are worked separately and side to side. Arrow on schematic shows direction of work. Back is 5 cm longer than front.

Back: With size 4.5 mm needles cast on 110 (112, 114) sts. Next row (RS): Selvage st, work 92 (94, 96) sts in St st; beginning with p1 work 15 sts in rib patt, two-stitch selvage. Cont in patt as established and shape shoulder as foll: Working full-fashion inc, inc 1 st at beg of 7 (7, 9)th row from cast-on, then every alt 4th and 6th row 6 times, then every 6th row 3 times (then every 6th row 8 times, then every 4th row 1 time / then every 6th row 9 times) = 120 (122, 124) sts. Work even until piece meas 21 (23, 25) cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape neck: Working full-fashion dec, dec 1 st at beg of next RS row, then every alt RS row 2 times = 177 (119, 121) sts. Work even for 13 rows, ending with a WS row. Place marker to indicate center of back. Work even for 14 rows, ending with a WS row. Working full-fashion inc, inc 1 st at beg of next RS row, then every alt RS row 2 times = 120 (122, 124) sts. Work even for 5 (3, 5) rows, ending with a WS row. Shape shoulder: Working full-fashion dec, dec 1 st at beg of next RS row, then every 6th row 3 times, then every alt 4th and 6th row 6 times (then every 6th row 9 times / then every 6th row 8 times, then every 8th row 1 time) = 110 (112, 114) sts. Work even for 6 (6, 8) rows. Bind off all sts as they appear.

Front: With size 4.5 mm needles cast on 100 (102, 104) sts. Next row (RS): Selvage st, work 92 (94, 96) sts in St st; beginning with p1 work 5 sts in rib patt, two-stitch selvage. Cont in patt as established, shape shoulder at right edge same as for back = 100 (112, 114) sts. Work even until piece meas 21 (23, 25) cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape V-neck: Bind off 4 sts at beg of next 6 RS rows, 3 sts at beg of next 5 RS rows = 71 (73, 75) sts. Work even for 3 rows, ending with a WS row. Cable cast on 3 sts at beg of next 5 RS rows, 4 sts at beg of next 6 RS rows = 110 (112, 114) sts. Work even for 1 cm, ending with a WS row. Shape shoulder at right edge same as for back = 100 (102, 104) sts. Work even for 6 (6, 8) rows. Bind off all sts as they appear.

Sleeves: With size 4.5 mm needles cast on 46 sts. Work in St st and shape sleeve as foll: Inc 1 st at each end of 11 (7, 7)th row from cast-on, then every alt 8th and 10th row 11 times (then every 8th row 13 times / then every alt 6th and 8th row 15 times) = 70 (74, 78) sts. Work even until piece meas 42 cm from cast-on. Bind off all sts.

Finishing: Pin pieces to measurements and block. Sew shoulder seams. **Rollneck:** With size 4 mm circular needle, pick up and k 118 sts evenly around neck edge. Place beg of rnd marker and join for working in rnds. Knit 4 rnds. Bind off all sts kwise. Place markers 18 (19, 20) cm down from shoulders on front and back. Sew on sleeves between markers. Sew side and sleeve seams, remembering that back is 5 cm longer than front.



Gauge Swatch

Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.
