

PULLOVER · PIMA

Design 01 - Filati Classici 18



Size 36/38 (40/42, 44/46, 48/50)

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

Materials: 600 (650, 700, 750) g of Lana Grossa Pima (100% Pima cotton; 125 m/50 g) in Emerald (col 15). Size 3.5 mm needles; size 3.5 mm circular needle, 40 cm long.

St st: K on RS, p on WS.

Seed stitch: Even number of sts. <u>Row 1</u>: Selvage st, * k1, p1; rep from *, end selvage st. <u>Row 2</u>: Selvage st, purl the knit sts and knit the purl sts, selvage st. Rep row 2 for seed stitch.

Full-fashion decrease: At beg of RS row, selvage st, 2 sts in St st, skp; at end of RS row, work to last 5 sts, k2tog, 2 sts in St st, selvage st.

Full-fashion increase: On RS row: M1R, 3 sts in from each edge.

Gauge: 22 sts and 37 rows = 10 x 10 cm in seed st on size 3.5 mm needles.

Back: With size 3.5 mm needles cast on 122 (130, 138, 146) sts. Purl 1 WS row. Work in St st for 2 rows. Work in seed st until piece meas 33 (34, 35, 36) cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape raglan: Working full-fashion dec, dec 1 st at each end of next 43 (47, 51, 55) RS rows = 36 sts and when piece meas 56 (59, 62, 65) cm from cast-on, bind off all sts.

Front: Work same as back until same length as back to raglan, ending with a WS row. Shape raglan: Working full-fashion dec, dec 1 st at each end of next 39 (43, 47, 51) RS rows. At same time, when piece meas 51 (54, 57, 60) cm from caston, shape neck as foll: Next row (RS): Bind off center 10 sts. Working each side separately, bind off 5 sts at each neck edge 2 times, 4 sts 1 time, 3 sts 1 time.

Left sleeve: With size 3.5 mm needles cast on 58 sts. Purl 1 WS row. Work in St st for 2 rows. Work in seed st and shape sleeve as foll: Working full-fashion inc, inc 1 st at each end of 13 (11, 9, 7)th row, then every alt 10th and 12th row 13 times (then every alt 8th and 10th row 11 times, then every 8th row 6 times / then every alt 6th and 8th row 21 times / then every 6th row 25 times) = 86 (94, 102, 110) sts. Work increased sts into seed st. Work even until piece meas 45 (45, 44, 44) cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape sleeve cap: Working full-fashion dec, dec 1 st at each end of next RS row, then every alt 2nd and 4th row 18 times, then every alt row 11 times (then every alt 2nd and 4th row 18 times, then every alt row 15 times / then every alt 2nd and 4th row 18 times, then every alt row 19 times / then every alt 2nd and 4th row 18 times, then every alt row 23 times). Dec 1 st at beg only of next 4 RS rows and at same time, bind off 5 sts at beg of next WS row, 6 sts at beg of next 2 WS row.


Right sleeve: Work same as left sleeve, reversing cap shaping.

Finishing: Pin pieces to measurements and block. Sew raglan, side and sleeve seams. Neckband: With size 3.5 mm circular needle, pick up and k 122 sts evenly around neck edge. Place beg of rnd marker and join for working in rnds. Knit 4 rnds. Loosely bind off all sts.

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


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Gauge Swatch

Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.



Abbreviations

beg = begin(ning) \cdot **ch** = chain \cdot **cont** = continue \cdot **dec** = decreas(e)(ing) \cdot **inc** = increas(e)(ing) \cdot **k** = knit \cdot **kwise** = as if to knit **meas** = measures \cdot **M1L** = lift strand between sts from front to back and knit this strand through the back loop \cdot **M1R** = lift strand between sts from the back and knit this strand through the front loop \cdot **patt** = pattern \cdot **pm** = place marker \cdot **p** = purl **pwise** = as if to purl \cdot **rem** = remain(ing) \cdot **rep** = repeat(s) \cdot **rev St st** = reverse stockinette stitch \cdot **rnd(s)** = round(s) \cdot **RS** = right side \cdot **sc** = single crochet \cdot **skp** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 1 stitch, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch \cdot **sk2p** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 2 together, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch \cdot **s2kp** = slip 2 stitches as if to knit, k 1 stitch, pass slipped stitches over knitted stitch \cdot **s1** = slip \cdot **st(s)** = stitch(es) \cdot **St st** = stockinette stitch \cdot **tbl** = through the back loop \cdot **tog** = together \cdot **wyib** = with yarn in back of work \cdot **wyif** = with yarn in front of work \cdot **WS** = wrong side \cdot **yo(s)** = yarn over(s)
