

PULLOVER · PIMA

Design 29 - Filati Classici 18



Size 36 (38, 40, 42)

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

Materials: 400 (450, 450, 500) g of Lana Grossa Pima (100% Pima cotton; 125 m/50 g) in Khaki (col 16). Size 4 and 4.5 mm needles; size 4 mm circular needle, 40 cm long.

Twisted rib in rows: Row 1 (RS): Selvage st, * p1, k1tbl; rep from * to last 2 sts, p1, selvage st. Row 2 (WS): Selvage st, * k1, p1tbl; rep from * to last 2 sts, k1, selvage st. Rep rows 1 and 2 for twisted rib in rows.

Twisted rib in rnds: Rnd 1: * P1, k1tbl; rep from * around. Rep rnd 1 for twisted rib in rnds.

Main patt: Work according to chart. Multiple of 6 + 1 + 2 selvage sts (not shown on chart). Number at right edge of chart indicates RS row, number at left edge of chart indicates WS row. Rep rows 1 and 2 for main patt.

Selvage stitches: On every row: Knit first and last st.

Full-fashion decrease: On RS row, p2tog 5 sts in from each edge.

Gauge: 21 sts and 27 rows = 10×10 cm in main patt on size 4.5 mm needles.

Back: With size 4.5 mm needles cast on 99 (105, 111, 117) sts. Next row (RS): Selvage st, work patt rep 16 (17, 18, 19) times, work last chart st; selvage st. Cont in patt as established until piece meas 37 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape raglan: Bind off 4 sts at beg of next 2 rows. Work-

ing full-fashion dec, dec 1 st at each end of next 16 (18, 20, 22) RS rows = 59 (61, 63, 65) sts and when piece meas 49 (50.5, 52, 53.5) cm from cast-on, place sts on holder.

Front: Work same as back.

Sleeves: With size 4 mm needles cast on 57 (63, 57, 63) sts. Next row (RS): Selvage st, * p1, k1tbl; rep from * to last 2 sts, p1, selvage st. Cont in twisted rib as established until piece meas 8 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Change to size 4.5 mm needles. Next row (RS): Selvage st, work patt rep 9 (10, 9, 10) times, work last chart st; selvage st. Cont in patt as established and shape sleeve as foll: Inc 1 st at each end of 13 (13, 7, 7)th row worked in main patt, then every 12th row 3 times, then every 10th row 2 times (then every 12th row 3 times, then every 10th row 2 times / then every 6th row 11 times / then every 6th row 11 times) = 69 (75, 81, 87). To increase, M1 1 st in from each edge. Work increased sts into main patt. Work even until piece meas 37 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape sleeve cap: Bind off 4 sts at beg of next 2 rows. Working full-fashion dec, dec 1 st at each end of next 16 (18, 20, 22) RS rows = 29 (31, 33, 35) sts and when piece meas 49 (50.5, 52, 53.5) cm from cast-on, place sts on holder.


Yoke: Return 29 (31, 33, 35) sleeve sts, 59 (61, 63, 65) front sts, 29 (31, 33, 35) sleeve sts, 59 (61, 63, 65) back sts from holders to size 4 mm circular needle = 176 (184, 192, 200) sts and with RS facing rejoin yarn. Join for working in rnds. Set-up rnd: Work twisted rib in rnds and at same time, k2tog tbl all adjoining selvage sts = 172 (180, 188, 196) sts. Cont in twisted rib until piece meas 9 cm from joining rnd. Bind off all sts in rib.


Finishing: Pin piece to measurements and block. Sew raglan, side and sleeve seams.




Chart key:

- $\Box = p1$



Gauge Swatch

Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.



Abbreviations

beg = begin(ning) \cdot **ch** = chain \cdot **cont** = continue \cdot **dec** = decreas(e)(ing) \cdot **inc** = increas(e)(ing) \cdot **k** = knit \cdot **kwise** = as if to knit **meas** = measures \cdot **M1L** = lift strand between sts from front to back and knit this strand through the back loop \cdot **M1R** = lift strand between sts from the back and knit this strand through the front loop \cdot **patt** = pattern \cdot **pm** = place marker \cdot **p** = purl **pwise** = as if to purl \cdot **rem** = remain(ing) \cdot **rep** = repeat(s) \cdot **rev St st** = reverse stockinette stitch \cdot **rnd(s)** = round(s) \cdot **RS** = right side \cdot **sc** = single crochet \cdot **skp** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 1 stitch, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch \cdot **sk2p** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 2 together, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch \cdot **s2kp** = slip 2 stitches as if to knit, k 1 stitch, pass slipped stitches over knitted stitch \cdot **s1** = slip \cdot **st(s)** = stitch(es) \cdot **St st** = stockinette stitch \cdot **tbl** = through the back loop \cdot **tog** = together \cdot **wyib** = with yarn in back of work \cdot **wyif** = with yarn in front of work \cdot **WS** = wrong side \cdot **yo(s)** = yarn over(s)
