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PULLOVER · AMOROSO & BRILLINO

Design 03 – Lookbook 10

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Size 36/38 (40/42, 44/46, 48)

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

Materials: **300 (400, 400, 500) g** of Lana Grossa **Amoroso** (23% pure wool, 23% silk, 23% cotton, 23% acrylic, 8% polyamide; 400 m/100 g) in Antique Pink/Fuchsia/Orange (**col 5**) and **150 (200, 200, 250) g** of Lana Grossa **Brillino** (83% viscose, 17% metallic fiber; 200 m/25 g) in White/Gold (**col 9**). Size 6 and 8 mm needles; size 6 mm circular needle, 40 cm long.

Note: Work with 1 strand of each yarn held tog throughout = 2 strands held tog.

Rib patt in rows: Multiple of 2 + 1 + 4 selvage sts. **Row 1 (WS):** Two-stitch selvage, * k1, p1tbl; rep from * to last 3 sts, k1, two-stitch selvage. **Row 2 (RS):** Two-stitch selvage, * p1, k1tbl; rep from * to last 3 sts, p1, two-stitch selvage. Rep rows 1 and 2 for rib patt.

Rib patt in rnds: Multiple of 2. * P1, k1tbl; rep from * around.

St st: K on RS, p on WS.

Rev St st: P on RS, k on WS.

Two-stitch selvage: On RS row, sl 1 pwise wyib, k1, patt to last 2 sts, k1, sl 1 pwise wyib. On WS row, p1, sl 1 pwise wyif, patt to last 2 sts, sl 1 pwise wyif, p1.

Full-fashion decrease (double decrease): At beg of RS row, two-stitch selvage, p1, k4, skp (sk2p); at end of RS row, work to last 9 (10) sts, k2tog (k3tog), k4, p1, two-stitch selvage – 1 (2) st(s) decreased at each edge.

Full-fashion increase: On RS row: M1R, 4 sts in from each edge.

Gauge: 14 sts and 19 rows = 10 x 10 cm in St st with size 8 mm needles and 2 strands held tog.

Back: With size 6 mm needles and 2 strands held tog cast on 79 (85, 91, 97) sts. Beg and end with a WS row, work in rib patt for 7 cm. Change to size 8 mm needles. Next row (RS): Two-stitch selvage, 1 st in rev St st, work in St st to last 3 sts, 1 st in rev St st, two-stitch selvage. Work in patt as set by last

row and shape sides as foll: Working full-fashion inc, inc 1 st at each end of 11 (13, 13, 15)th row from rib patt, then every 10th row 2 times (then every 12th row 2 times / then every 12th row 2 times / then every 10th row 1 time, then every 14th row 1 time) = 85 (91, 97, 103) sts. Work even until piece meas 31 (32, 33, 34) cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape raglan: Working full-fashion dec, dec 2 sts at each end of next 2 (3, 4, 4) RS rows, 1 st at each end of next 13 (14, 15, 16) RS rows, 2 sts at each end of next 3 (3, 3, 4) RS rows = 39 sts and when piece meas 50 (53, 56, 59) cm from cast-on, bind off all sts.

Front: Work same as back to raglan shaping, ending with a WS row. Shape raglan: Working full-fashion dec, dec 2 sts at each end of next 1 (1, 2, 3) RS row(s), 1 st at each end of next 14 (15, 16, 17) RS rows, 2 sts at each end of next 2 (3, 3, 3) RS rows. At same time, when piece meas 46 (49, 52, 55) cm from cast-on, shape neck as foll: Next row (RS): Bind off center 27 sts. Working each side separately, bind off 5 sts at each neck edge 1 time, 4 sts 1 time. No sts rem.

Left sleeve: With size 6 mm needles and 2 strands held tog cast on 49 sts. Beg and end with a WS row, work in rib patt for 9 cm. Change to size 8 mm needles. Next row (RS): Two-stitch selvage, 1 st in rev St st, work in St st to last 3 sts, 1 st in rev St st, two-stitch selvage. Work in patt as set by last row and shape sleeve as foll: Working full-fashion inc, inc 1 st at each end of 11 (9, 7, 5)th row from rib patt, then every alt 8th and 10th row 4 times (then every 6th row 7 times / then every alt 4th and 6th row 6 times, then every 4th row 4 times / then every 4th row 12 times, then every alt row 1 time) = 59 (65, 71, 77) sts. Work even until piece meas 38 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape sleeve cap: Working full-fashion dec, dec 2 sts at each end of next 1 (2, 3, 3) RS row(s), 1 st at each end of next 13 (14, 15, 16) RS rows, 2 sts at each end of next 2 (2, 2, 3) RS rows = 21 sts. Next row (WS): Bind off 6 sts, work to end. Next row (RS): Dec 2 sts at beg of row only, work to end. Rep last 2 rows once more. Bind off rem 5 sts.

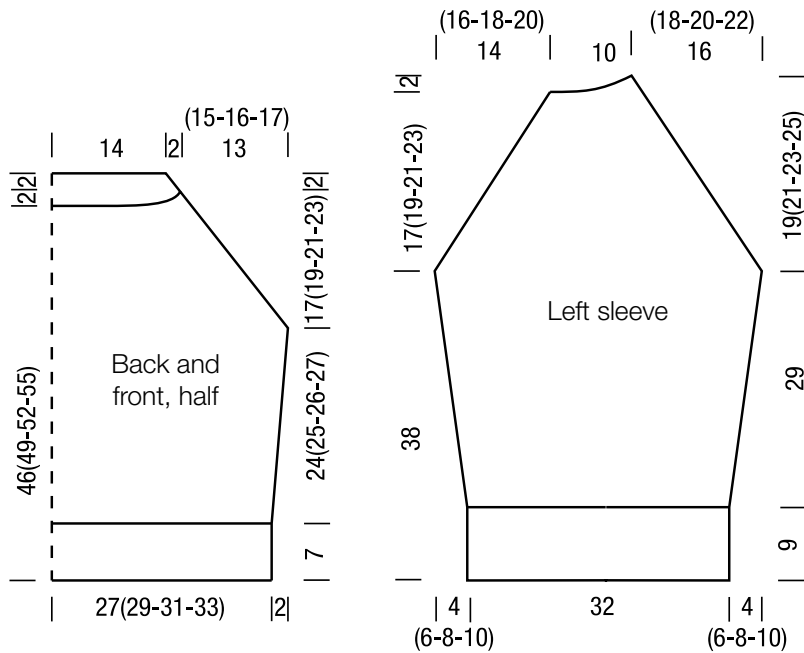
Right sleeve: Work same as left sleeve, reversing cap shaping.

Finishing: Pin pieces to measurements and block. Sew raglan, side and sleeve seams. Sew all seams 1 st in from edge.

Neckband: With size 6 mm circular needle, pick up and k 106 sts evenly around neck edge. Place beg of rnd marker and join for working in rnds. Work rib patt in rnds for 4 cm. Bind off all sts in rib.

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Gauge Swatch

Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.

beg = begin(ning) · **ch** = chain · **cont** = continue · **dec** = decreas(e)(ing) · **inc** = increas(e)(ing) · **k** = knit · **kwise** = as if to knit
meas = measures · **M1L** = lift strand between sts from front to back and knit this strand through the back loop · **M1R** = lift strand between sts from the back and knit this strand through the front loop · **patt** = pattern · **pm** = place marker · **p** = purl
pwise = as if to purl · **rem** = remain(ing) · **rep** = repeat(s) · **rev St st** = reverse stockinette stitch · **rnd(s)** = round(s) · **RS** = right side · **sc** = single crochet · **skp** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 1 stitch, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch · **sk2p** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 2 together, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch · **s2kp** = slip 2 stitches as if to knit, k 1 stitch, pass slipped stitches over knitted stitch · **sl** = slip · **st(s)** = stitch(es) · **St st** = stockinette stitch · **tbl** = through the back loop · **tog** = together · **wyib** = with yarn in back of work · **wyif** = with yarn in front of work · **WS** = wrong side · **yo(s)** = yarn over(s)
