

PULLOVER · FOURSEASON & CAPRI

Design 36 - Classici 20



Size 36/38 (40/42, 44)

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

Materials: 200 (250, 300) g of Lana Grossa Fourseason (45% extrafine organic Merino wool, 40% organic cotton, 15% recycled cashmere; 105 m/50 g) in Light Petrol (col 6) and 150 (200, 200) g of Lana Grossa Capri (55% cotton, 30% polyamide, 15% silk; 150 m/50 g) in Mint (col 14). Size 3.5 mm needles; size 5 mm circular needle, 100 cm long.

St st: K on RS, p on WS.


Pattern: Work 2 rows each in St st with Fourseason and Capri alternately throughout.

Gauge: 18 sts and 27 rows = $10 \times 10 \text{ cm}$ in patt on size 5 mm needles.

Pullover: Worked side to side and in one piece beginning at left sleeve. Arrow on schematic shows direction of work. With size 3.5 mm needles and Fourseason cast on 54 sts. Purl 1 WS row. Work in patt for 2 rows. Change to size 5 mm circular

needle. Work in patt for 2 rows. Mark center 2 sts and shape shoulder as foll: Next RS (inc) row: M1R before and after center 2 sts. Cont in patt, rep inc row every alt RS row 16 times. At same time, when piece meas 20 cm from cast-on, cast on 19 (20, 20) sts at beg of next RS and WS row, then 19 sts at beg of next 2 rows, 20 sts at beg of next 2 rows (then 20 sts at beg of next 4 rows / then 21 sts at beg of next 4 rows) for back and front side edge = 204 (208, 212) sts after all shoulder and side edge incs have been worked. Work even until piece meas approx. 52 (54, 56) cm from sleeve cast-on, ending with 2 rows Capri. Divide for neck: Next row (RS): Patt over 88 (90, 92) sts, bind off next 39 sts, patt to end. Next row (WS): Patt to bound-off sts, cast on 39 sts over bound-off sts, patt to end. Work right half of pullover same as left half, reversing all shaping, that is: bind off sts for back and front side edge and work decreases to shape right shoulder as foll: K2tog before center 2 sts, skp after center 2 sts. Work in patt to 3 rows before end of right sleeve, ending with 2 rows Capri. Work last 3 rows with size 3.5 mm needles and Fourseason. Bind off all sts kwise.

Finishing: Pin piece to measurements and block. Sew side and sleeve seams.






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Gauge Swatch

Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.



Abbreviations

beg = begin(ning) \cdot **ch** = chain \cdot **cont** = continue \cdot **dec** = decreas(e)(ing) \cdot **inc** = increas(e)(ing) \cdot **k** = knit \cdot **kwise** = as if to knit **meas** = measures \cdot **M1L** = lift strand between sts from front to back and knit this strand through the back loop \cdot **M1R** = lift strand between sts from the back and knit this strand through the front loop \cdot **patt** = pattern \cdot **pm** = place marker \cdot **p** = purl **pwise** = as if to purl \cdot **rem** = remain(ing) \cdot **rep** = repeat(s) \cdot **rev St st** = reverse stockinette stitch \cdot **rnd(s)** = round(s) \cdot **RS** = right side \cdot **sc** = single crochet \cdot **skp** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 1 stitch, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch \cdot **sk2p** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 2 together, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch \cdot **s2kp** = slip 2 stitches as if to knit, k 1 stitch, pass slipped stitches over knitted stitch \cdot **s1** = slip \cdot **st(s)** = stitch(es) \cdot **St st** = stockinette stitch \cdot **tbl** = through the back loop \cdot **tog** = together \cdot **wyib** = with yarn in back of work \cdot **wyif** = with yarn in front of work \cdot **WS** = wrong side \cdot **yo(s)** = yarn over(s)
