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# WRAP JACKET · ALLORA HAND-DYED

Design 06 – Hand-dyed 02

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**Size** 36/38 (40/42, 44)

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

**Materials:** 200 (250, 250) g of Lana Grossa **Allora hand-dyed** (76% cotton, 14% superfine Merino wool, 10% baby alpaca; 300 m/50 g) in Tulsi (**col 252**). Size 4 mm needles; two size 2.5 mm double-pointed needles [dpns]; size 3 mm crochet hook.

**Garter st:** K every row.

**St st:** K on RS, p on WS.

**7-st left front band:** Row 1 (RS): [P1, k1tbl] 2 times, p1, two-stitch selvage. Row 2 (WS): Two-stitch selvage, [k1, p1tbl] 2 times, k1. Rep rows 1 and 2.

**7-st right front band:** Row 1 (RS): Two-stitch selvage, [p1, k1tbl] 2 times, p1. Row 2 (WS): [K1, p1tbl] 2 times, k1, two-stitch selvage. Rep rows 1 and 2.

**Two-stitch selvage:** On RS row, sl 1 pwise wyib, k1, patt to last 2 sts, k1, sl 1 pwise wyib. On WS row, p1, sl 1 pwise wyif, patt to last 2 sts, sl 1 pwise wyif, p1.

**Full-fashion decrease 1 [raglan shaping]:** At beg of RS row, k3, skp; at end of RS row, work to last 5 sts, k2tog, k3.

**Full-fashion decrease 2 (dbl decrease) [neck shaping]:** At beg of RS row, 7-st right front band, skp (sk2p); at end of RS row, work to last 9 (10) sts, k2tog (k3tog), 7-st left front band – 1 (2) st(s) decreased.

**Full-fashion increase:** On RS row: M1R, 2 sts in from each edge.

**Gauge:** 24 sts and 33 rows = 10 x 10 cm in St st on size 4 mm needles.

**Back:** With size 4 mm needles cast on 160 (176, 192) sts. Beg and end with a WS row, work in garter st for 3 rows. Work in St st until piece meas 9 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Next RS (I-cord row): Work in St st, k4tog 18 (20, 22) times evenly across row = 106 (116, 126) sts. Cont in St st until piece meas 29 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape raglan: Working full-fashion dec 1, dec 1 st at each end of next RS row, then every alt 2nd and 4th row 18

(10, 4) times, then every alt row 18 (31, 42) times and when piece meas 56 (57, 58) cm from cast-on, bind off rem 32 sts.

**Left front:** With size 4 mm needles cast on 160 (176, 192) sts. Beg and end with a WS row, work in garter st for 3 rows. Next row (RS): Work in St st to last 7 sts, work 7-st left front band. Work in patt as set by last row until piece meas 9 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Next row (RS): Work in patt as established, k4tog 18 (20, 22) times evenly across St st section = 106 (116, 126) sts. Cont in patt as established and shape front edge as foll: Working full-fashion dec 2, dec 1 st at end of next 73 RS rows (72 RS rows, 2 sts at end of next 3 RS rows / 71 RS rows, 2 sts at end of next 6 RS rows). At same time, when piece meas 29 cm from cast-on, shape raglan at right edge as foll: Working full-fashion dec 1, dec 1 st at beg of next RS row, then every alt 2nd and 4th row 18 (10, 4) times, then every alt row 14 (27, 38) times. No sts rem.

**Right front:** Work same as left front, reversing all shaping and patt placement and working 7-st right front band.

**Left sleeve:** With size 4 mm needles cast on 66 (72, 78) sts. Beg and end with a WS row, work in garter st for 3 rows. Work in St st and shape sleeve as foll: Working full-fashion inc, inc 1 st at each end of 3rd row, then every alt 2nd and 4th row 7 times (then every alt 2nd and 4th row 3 times, then every alt row 6 times / then every alt row 11 times) = 82 (92, 102) sts. Work even until piece meas 8 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape sleeve cap: Working full-fashion dec 2, dec 1 st at each end of next RS row, then every alt 2nd and 4th row 18 (10, 4) times, then every alt row 14 (27, 38) times. Work 1 WS row. Next row (RS): Dec 1 st at beg of row only, work to end. Next row (WS): Bind off 3 sts, work to end. Rep last 2 rows 3 more times. No sts rem.

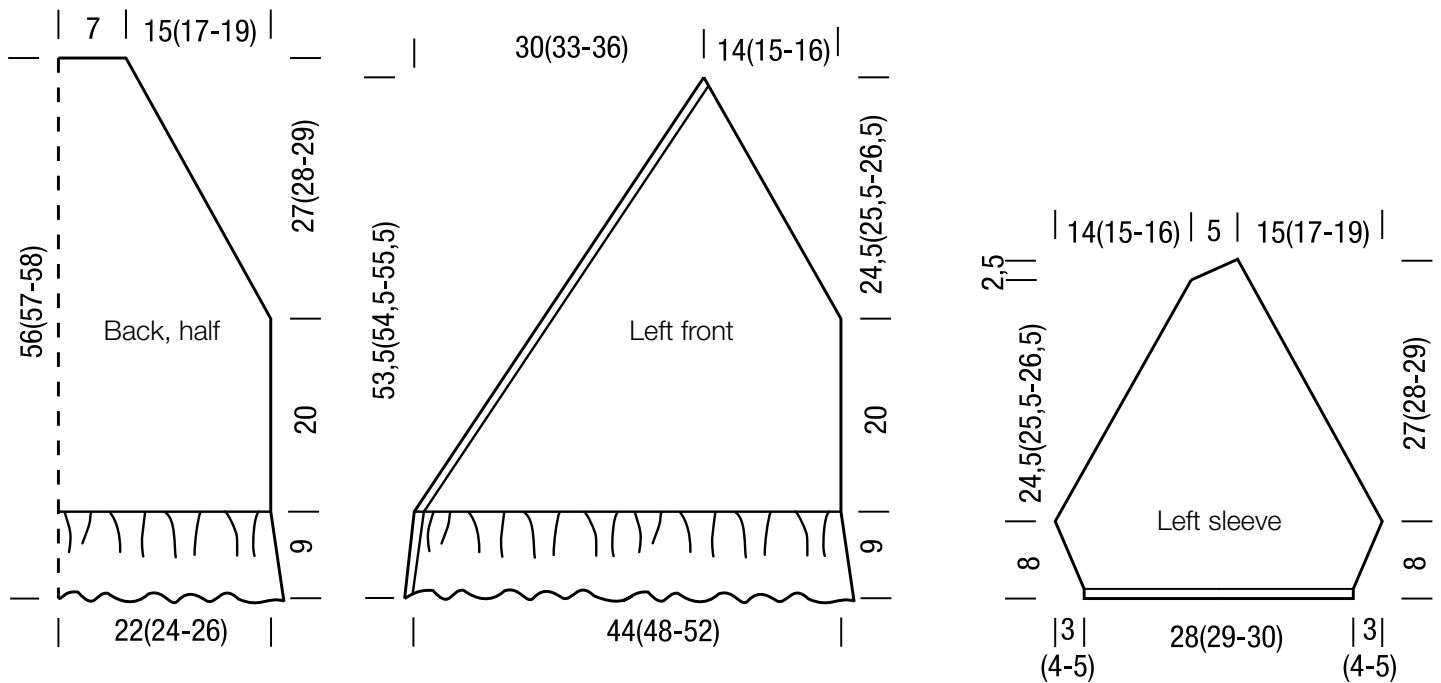
**Right sleeve:** Work same as left sleeve, reversing cap shaping.

**I-cord:** With dpn, cast on 4 sts and work as foll: \* Next row (RS): With 2nd dpn, k4, do not turn. Sl sts back to beg of needle to work next row from RS, pulling yarn tightly from end of row; rep from \* until I-cord measures 150 (158, 166) cm. Cut yarn, draw yarn end through sts and pull tight. Carefully weave in ends.

**Finishing:** Pin pieces to measurements and block. Sew raglan side and sleeve seams. With size 3 mm crochet hook, work 1 row sc along top edge of fronts, sleeves and back. Thread I-cord through k4tog sts on I-cord row.

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## Gauge Swatch

### Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.
