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JACKET · ALTA MODA ALPACA
Design 20 – Classici 21

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Size 36/38 (40/42, 44)

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

Materials: 850 (950, 1050) g of Lana Grossa **Alta Moda Alpaca** (90% baby alpaca, 5% Merino wool, 5% polyamide; 140 m/50 g) in Nut Brown (**col 78**). Size 9 and 10 mm needles.

Note: Work with 2 strands held tog throughout.

Rib patt: K1, p1.

St st: K on RS, p on WS.

Selvage sts: On RS row, ktbl first st, sl last st pwise wyib. On WS row, ptbl first st, sl last st pwise wyif.

Full-fashion increase: On RS row: M1R, 2 sts in from each edge.

Gauge: 11 sts and 16.5 rows = 10 x 10 cm in St st with size 10 mm needles and 2 strands held tog.

Back: Worked in two halves. **Right half:** With size 9 mm needles and 2 strands held tog cast on 35 (37, 39) sts. Next row (WS): Selvage st, * p1, k1; rep from * to last 2 sts, p1, selvage st. Cont in rib patt as set by last row until piece meas 5 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Change to size 10 mm needles. Maintaining selvage sts, work in St st until piece meas 36 cm from cast-on. Place marker at right edge to indicate beg of armhole. Cont until piece meas 58 (59, 60) cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape shoulder: At beg of RS rows, bind off 4 (4, 5) sts 1 time, then 4 sts 3 times, 3 sts 2 times (then 4 sts 5 times / then 5 sts 1 time, 4 sts 4 times). Work 1 WS row. Bind off rem 13 sts. Work **left half** same as right half, reversing all shaping.

Left front: With size 9 mm needles and 2 strands held tog cast on 42 (44, 46) sts. Next row (WS): Selvage st, * p1, k1; rep from *, end selvage st. Cont in rib patt as set by last row until piece meas 5 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Change to size 10 mm needles. Next row (RS): Selvage st, 34 (36, 38) sts in St st, 6 sts in rib patt as established, selvage st. Cont in patt as set by last row until piece meas 36 cm from cast-on. Place marker at right edge to indicate beg of armhole. Cont until piece meas 58 (59, 60) cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape shoulder at right edge same as for right half of back, work to end of last RS row = 20 sts rem for hood. Next row (WS): Patt over 20 sts, backloop cast on 25 sts = 33 sts. Cont in patt until hood meas 25 cm from last shoulder bind-off, ending with a WS row. Bind off 2 sts at beg of next 12 rows. Bind off rem 21 sts.


Right front: Work same as left front, reversing all shaping and patt placement.

Sleeves: With size 9 mm needles and 2 strands held tog cast on 30 sts. Next row (WS): Selvage st, * p1, k1; rep from *, end selvage st. Cont in rib patt as set by last row until piece meas 5 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Change to size 10 mm needles. Maintaining selvage sts, work in St st and shape sleeve as foll: Working full-fashion inc, inc 1 st at each end of 5th row, then every 6th row 9 times (then every 6th row 8 times, then every 4th row 2 times / then every 6th row 7 times, then every 4th row 4 times) = 50 (52, 54) sts. Work even until piece meas 44 cm from cast-on. Bind off all sts.

Finishing: Pin pieces to measurements and block. With WS tog (so seam forms a ridge on RS), sew back halves tog. Sew shoulder seams. With WS tog (so seam forms a ridge on RS), sew 25 cm long side edges of hood halves tog. With RS tog, sew seam at top of hood. Sew bottom 11 cm of each hood half to back neck. Sew on sleeves between markers. Sew side and sleeve seams.

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
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Gauge Swatch

Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.
