

## **COAT · BACCA**

## Design 05 - Filati Journal 63



Size One size

**Materials**: **700 g** of Lana Grossa **Bacca** (100% cotton; 120 m/ 50 g) in Jeans **(col 5)**. Size 3.5 mm circular needles, 60 and 120 cm long.

**Casting on over 2 needles**: Hold the 2 needle tips of the circular needle tog during cast on. Remove one needle tip after having cast on. This creates a more flexible cast-on edge.

**Two-stitch selvage**: At beg of every row: Sl 1 kwise, k1; at end of every row, k2.

**Selvage sts**: At beg of every row, k1; at end of every row, sl 1 pwise wyif.

Rib patt: K1, p1.

Garter st: K every row.

**Main patt**: Row 1 (WS): Two-stitch selvage, \* yo, k1, p1; rep from \* to last 2 sts, two-stitch selvage. Row 2 (RS): Two-stitch selvage, \* yo, k1, p2tog; rep from \* to last 2 sts, two-stitch selvage. Work row 1 once, then rep row 2.

**Full-fashion decrease A**: Worked over 3 rows. Row 1 (RS): Two-stitch selvage, yo, k1, p2tog, k1, patt to last 8 sts, k1, p2tog, yo, k1, p2tog, two-stitch selvage. Row 2 (WS): Two-stitch selvage, yo, k1, p3tog, p1, patt to last 6 sts, p2tog twice, two-stitch selvage. Row 3 (RS): Two-stitch selvage, yo, skp, patt to last 6 sts, yo, k2tog, p2tog, two-stitch selvage.

**Full-fashion decrease B**: Worked over 2 rows. Row 1 (RS): Two-stitch selvage, yo, k1, p3tog, p2tog, patt to last 8 sts, yo, k1, p3tog, p2tog, two-stitch selvage. Row 2 (WS): Two-stitch selvage, yo, skp, patt to last 6 sts, yo, k2tog, p2tog, two-stitch selvage.

**Full-fashion increase**: Worked over 5 rows. <u>Row 1 (RS)</u>: Two-stitch selvage, yo, k1, k1b (k1 in row below next st on left needle), patt to last 5 sts, k1b, yo, k1, p2tog, two-stitch selvage. <u>Row 2 (WS)</u>: Two-stitch selvage, yo, k1, p2tog, p1, patt to last 5 sts, p1, yo, k1, p2tog, two-stitch selvage. <u>Row 3 (RS)</u>: Two-stitch selvage, yo, k1, p2tog, M1L, k1, patt to last 6 sts, k1, M1L, yo, k1, p2tog, two-stitch selvage. <u>Row 4 (WS)</u>: Two-stitch selvage, yo, k1, p2tog, k1, p1, patt to last 7 sts, p1, k1, yo, k1, p2tog, two-stitch selvage. <u>Row 5 (RS)</u>: Two-stitch selvage, yo, k1, p2tog, patt to last 7 sts, yo, k1, p1, yo, k1, p2tog, two-stitch selvage.

**Gauge**: 19 sts and 31 rows =  $10 \times 10 \text{ cm}$  in main patt on size 3.5 mm needles, measured lying flat.

**Back**: With shorter size 3.5 mm circular needle cast on 76 sts [see casting on over 2 needles]. Work row 1 of main patt = 112 sts. Rep row 2 of main patt until a total of 181 rows = 58 cm has been worked from cast-on. Place marker in first and last st on last WS row to indicate beg of armholes. Cont in patt for 42 rows and piece meas 14 cm from armhole markers. Shape shoulders: Work full-fashion dec A over next 3 rows = 106 sts. Work 2 rows full-fashion dec B 7 times = 64 sts. [Work even for 2 rows, work 2 rows full-fashion dec B] 5 times, omitting yo at beg and end of last WS row = 32 sts. Bind off.

**Left front**: With shorter size 3.5 mm circular needle cast on 36 sts [see casting on over 2 needles]. Work row 1 of main patt = 52 sts. Rep row 2 of main patt until a total of 171 rows = 55 cm has been worked from cast-on. Shape neck: Work full-fashion dec A over next 3 rows at left edge only. [Work even for 31 rows, work 3 rows full-fashion dec A] 3 times. **At same time**, when same length as back to armhole, place armhole marker at right edge. Bind off rem 40 sts after last neck dec.

**Right front**: Work same as left front, reversing all shaping.

**Sleeves**: With shorter size 3.5 mm circular needle cast on 44 sts [see casting on over 2 needles]. Work row 1 of main patt = 64 sts. Rep row 2 of main patt until a total of 127 rows = 41 cm has been worked from cast-on. Shape sleeve: Work full-fashion inc over 5 rows. [Work 5 rows even, work 5 rows full-fashion inc] 2 times = 82 sts. Work even for 4 rows. Bind off all sts.


**Pockets**: Make 2. With shorter size 3.5 mm circular needle cast on 24 sts [see casting on over 2 needles]. Work row 1 of main patt = 34 sts. Rep row 2 of main patt until a total of 47 rows = 15 cm has been worked from cast-on. Work in garter st for 3 rows. Next row (WS): \* P2tog, yo; rep from \* to last 2 sts, p2tog, = 33 sts. Rows 5-7: Work in garter st. Rows 8-14: Work in rib patt. Bind off all sts in rib.

**Finishing**: Pin pieces to measurements and block. Sew shoulder seams. <u>Front and neckband</u>: With longer size 3.5 mm circular needle, pick up and k 459 sts evenly along right front, back and left front edge. Beg with a WS row and working first and last st as selvage sts, work in garter st for 2 rows. Next row (WS): Selvage st, \* p2tog, yo; rep from \*, end selvage st. Rows 4 – 6: Work in garter st. Rows 7 – 17: Work in rib patt. Bind off all sts in rib. Sew on sleeves between markers, matching \* to \* on schematic. Note: Sleeves are not centered over shoulder line; shoulder line is moved 10 cm towards back. Sew side and sleeve seams.

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

## Gauge Swatch

#### Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.

**beg** = begin(ning)  $\cdot$  **ch** = chain  $\cdot$  **cont** = continue  $\cdot$  **dec** = decreas(e)(ing)  $\cdot$  **inc** = increas(e)(ing)  $\cdot$  **k** = knit  $\cdot$  **kwise** = as if to knit **meas** = measures  $\cdot$  **M1L** = lift strand between sts from front to back and knit this strand through the back loop  $\cdot$  **M1R** = lift strand between sts from the back and knit this strand through the front loop  $\cdot$  **patt** = pattern  $\cdot$  **pm** = place marker  $\cdot$  **p** = purl **pwise** = as if to purl  $\cdot$  **rem** = remain(ing)  $\cdot$  **rep** = repeat(s)  $\cdot$  **rev St st** = reverse stockinette stitch  $\cdot$  **rnd(s)** = round(s)  $\cdot$  **RS** = right side  $\cdot$  **sc** = single crochet  $\cdot$  **skp** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 1 stitch, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch  $\cdot$  **sk2p** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 2 together, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch  $\cdot$  **s2kp** = slip 2 stitches as if to knit, k 1 stitch, pass slipped stitches over knitted stitch  $\cdot$  **s1** = slip  $\cdot$  **st(s)** = stitch(es)  $\cdot$  **St st** = stockinette stitch  $\cdot$  **tbl** = through the back loop  $\cdot$  **tog** = together  $\cdot$  **wyib** = with yarn in back of work  $\cdot$  **wyif** = with yarn in front of work  $\cdot$  **WS** = wrong side  $\cdot$  **yo(s)** = yarn over(s)
