

JACKET · RISERVA

Design 30 - Filati Journal 63



Size 36/38 (40/42, 44/46)

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

Materials: 450 (500, 550) g of Lana Grossa Riserva (70% organic cotton, 30% recycled polyamide; 125 m/50 g) in Petrol (col 7) and 250 (300, 350) g in White (col 1). Size 6 mm needles; size 6 mm circular needle, 60 cm long; 60 cm long separating zipper in petrol.

Selvage sts: On every row: K first st, sl last st pwise wyif.

Rib patt: K1, p1.

St st: K on RS, p on WS.

Full-fashion decrease: At beg of RS row, selvage st, k1, k2tog; at end of RS row, work to last 4 sts, skp, k1, selvage st

Full-fashion dbl decrease: At beg of RS row, selvage st, k1, k3tog; at end of RS row, work to last 5 sts, sk2p, k1, selvage st.

Full-fashion increase: On RS row: M1R, 3 sts in from each edge.

Stripe patt A: 22 rows in Petrol, 38 rows in White, 38 rows in Petrol, 38 rows in White, rem rows in Petrol.

Stripe patt B: 40 rows in Petrol, 4 rows in White, 40 rows in Petrol, 4 rows in White, rem rows in Petrol.

Gauge: 19 sts and 27 rows = $10 \times 10 \text{ cm}$ in St st on size 6 mm needles.

Back: With size 6 mm needles and Petrol cast on 116 (122, 130) sts. Beg and end with a WS row and working first and last st as selvage sts, work in rib patt for 17 rows and piece meas 6 cm from cast-on. Maintaining selvage sts, work in St st and stripe patt A for 114 (110, 108) rows and piece meas 42 (41, 40) cm from end of rib patt. Shape armholes: Bind off 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows. Working full-fashion dbl dec, dec 2 sts at each end of next 3 RS rows; working full-fashion dec, dec 1 st at each end of next 5 RS rows, then every alt RS row 3 times = 82 (88, 96) sts. Work even until a total of 48 (52, 54) rows has been worked from beg of armhole shaping and armhole meas 18 (19, 20) cm. Shape shoulders and neck: At each shoulder edge bind off 4 (4, 6) sts 1 time, 4 (5, 5) sts 3 times, 5 (5, 6) sts 2 times. At same time, when working 3rd RS shoulder bind-off row, work neck as foll: Bind off center 24 sts. Working each side separately, bind off 2 sts at each neck edge 1 time, 1 st 1 time. No sts rem.

Left front: With size 6 mm needles and Petrol cast on 58 (61, 65) sts. Beg and end with a WS row and working first and last st as selvage sts, work in rib patt for 17 rows and piece meas 6 cm from cast-on. Maintaining selvage sts, work in St st and stripe patt A for 114 (110, 108) rows and piece meas 42 (41, 40) cm from end of rib patt. Shape armhole: Bind off 3 sts at beg of next RS row. Working full-fashion dbl dec, dec 2 sts at beg of next 3 RS rows; working full-fashion dec, dec 1 st at beg of next 5 RS rows, then every alt RS row 3 times = 41 (44, 48) sts. Work even until a total of 31 (35, 37) rows has been worked from beg of armhole shaping and armhole meas 12 (13, 14) cm. Shape neck: Bind off 5 sts at beg of next WS row. Working full-fashion dbl dec, dec 2 sts at end of next 3 RS rows; working full-fashion dec, dec 1 st at end of next 4 RS rows and when same length as back to shoulder, shape shoulder at right edge same as for back. No sts rem.

Right front: Work same as left front, reversing all shaping.

Sleeves: With size 6 mm needles and Petrol cast on 47 (49, 51) sts. Beg and end with a WS row and working first and last st as selvage sts, work in rib patt for 17 rows and piece meas 6 cm from cast-on. Maintaining selvage sts, work in St st and stripe patt B and shape sleeve as foll: Working full-fashion inc, inc 1 st at each end of 9 (7, 5)th row, then every alt 8th and 10th (then every 8th / then every 8th) row 11 (12, 13) times = 71 (75, 79) sts. Work even until a total of 116 (118, 122) rows has been worked in St st and piece meas 43 (44, 45) cm from end of rib patt. Shape sleeve cap: Bind off 3 (4, 5) sts at beg of next 2 rows. Working full-fashion dbl dec, dec 2 sts at each end of next 3 RS rows. Work 1 WS row. Bind off 3 sts at beg of next 6 rows, 4 sts at beg of next 4 rows. Bind off rem 19 (21, 23) sts.


Pockets: Make 2. With size 6 mm needles and Petrol cast on 34 sts. Beg and end with a WS row and working first and last st as selvage sts, work in St st for 43 rows and piece meas 16 cm from cast-on. Bind off all sts.

Finishing: Pin pieces to measurements and block. Referring to schematic for placement, sew pockets to fronts. Sew shoulder seams. <u>Collar</u>: With circular needle and Petrol, pick up and k 87 sts along right front, back and left front neck edge. Work in rib patt for 8 cm, ending with a WS row. Change to White. Cont in rib patt for 8 cm. Bind off all sts. Sew in zipper. <u>Zipper facings</u>: Make 2. With White, cast on 5 sts. Work in St st for 60 cm. Bind off. Sew facings to WS to cover zipper tape. Fold collar in half to WS and sew down. Close short edges of collar. Sew in sleeves. Sew side and sleeve seams.

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


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Gauge Swatch

Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.



Abbreviations

beg = begin(ning) \cdot **ch** = chain \cdot **cont** = continue \cdot **dec** = decreas(e)(ing) \cdot **inc** = increas(e)(ing) \cdot **k** = knit \cdot **kwise** = as if to knit **meas** = measures \cdot **M1L** = lift strand between sts from front to back and knit this strand through the back loop \cdot **M1R** = lift strand between sts from the back and knit this strand through the front loop \cdot **patt** = pattern \cdot **pm** = place marker \cdot **p** = purl **pwise** = as if to purl \cdot **rem** = remain(ing) \cdot **rep** = repeat(s) \cdot **rev St st** = reverse stockinette stitch \cdot **rnd(s)** = round(s) \cdot **RS** = right side \cdot **sc** = single crochet \cdot **skp** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 1 stitch, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch \cdot **sk2p** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 2 together, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch \cdot **s2kp** = slip 2 stitches as if to knit, k 1 stitch, pass slipped stitches over knitted stitch \cdot **s1** = slip \cdot **st(s)** = stitch(es) \cdot **St st** = stockinette stitch \cdot **tbl** = through the back loop \cdot **tog** = together \cdot **wyib** = with yarn in back of work \cdot **wyif** = with yarn in front of work \cdot **WS** = wrong side \cdot **yo(s)** = yarn over(s)
