Design 12 – Hand-dyed Special 04



Size 90 x 180 cm

Materials: 100 g each of Lana Grossa **Allora hand-dyed** (76% cotton, 14% superfine Merino wool, 10% baby alpaca; 300 m/50 g) in Lichi (**col 267**) and Ber (**col 266**). Size 4 mm circular needle, 100 cm long; size 3.5 mm crochet hook for fringe; 1 locking stitch marker.

St st: K on RS, p on WS.

Drop st patt: Rows 1 – 4: Knit. Row 5 (RS): * Yo, k1; rep from * to end. Row 6 (WS): Purl all sts, dropping all yos. Rows 7 – 10: Knit.

Star patt: Multiple of 6 + 3 + 2 selvage sts. Row 1 (RS): Knit. Row 2 and all foll WS rows: Purl. Row 3: Selvage st, k3, * work star st (= p3tog, k3tog, p3tog all in next 3 sts tog), k3; rep from *, end selvage st. Row 5: Knit. Row 7: Selvage st, * work star st, k3; rep from * to last 4 sts, work star st, selvage st. Rep rows 1 – 8. NOTE: When working shaping, it might be necessary to adjust the number of sts between star sts to 1, 2, 4 or 5 sts.

Two-stitch selvage: On RS row, sl 1 pwise wyib, k1, patt to last 2 sts, k1, sl 1 pwise wyib. On WS row, p1, sl 1 pwise wyif, patt to last 2 sts, sl 1 pwise wyif, p1.

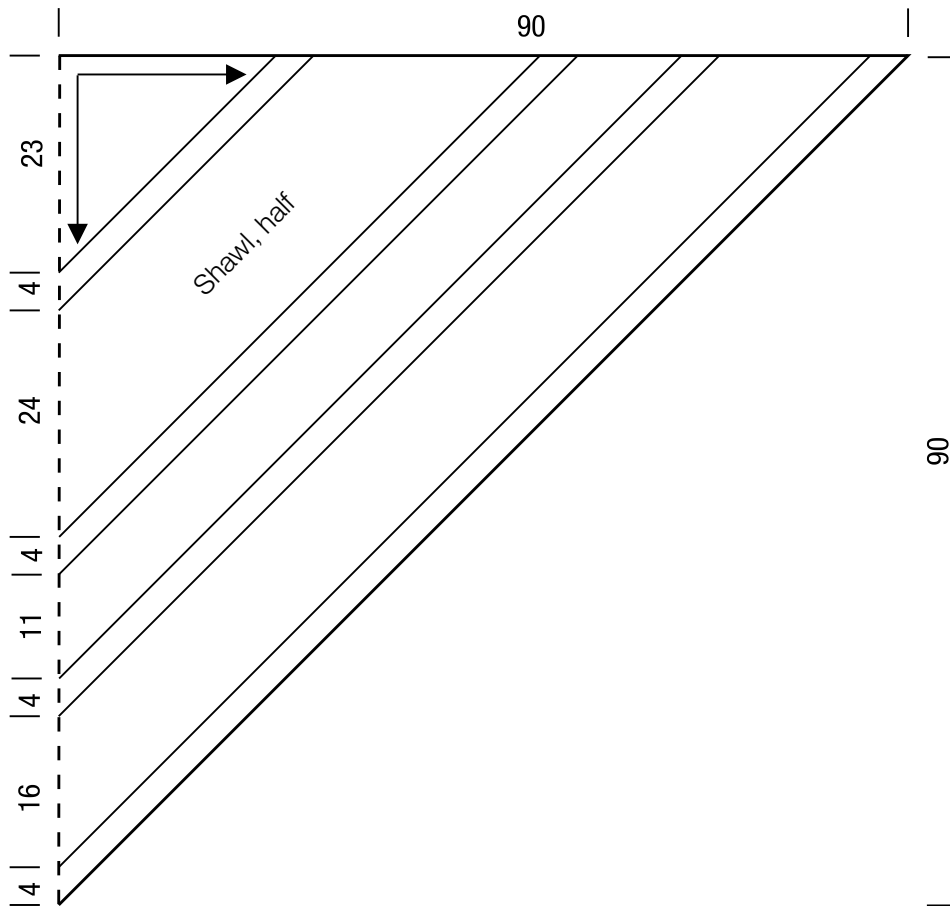
Gauge: 23 sts and 32 rows = 10 x 10 cm in star patt on size 4 mm needles.

Shawl: With size 4 mm circular needle and Lichi cast on 7 sts. Next row (WS): Two-stitch selvage, p3, two-stitch selvage. Next row (RS): Two-stitch selvage, M1R, k1, M1R, k1 and mark this st = center st, M1R, k1, M1R, two-stitch selvage = 4 sts increased and 11 sts total. Next row (WS): Two-stitch selvage, purl to last 2 sts, two-stitch selvage. Next row (RS): Two-stitch selvage, M1R, knit to center st, M1R, k1, M1R, knit to last 2 sts, M1R, two-stitch selvage. Next row (WS): Two-stitch selvage, purl to last 2 sts, two-stitch selvage. Rep last 2 rows until a total of 9 rows has been worked from cast-on. Maintaining two-stitch selvage and working incs as established cont as foll: Work rows 3 – 8 of star patt, then work rows 1 – 8 five times. Work in St st for 2 rows. Change to Ber, work rows 1 – 10 of drop st patt. Change to Lichi, work star patt for 52 rows, then work in St st for 2 rows. Change to Ber, work rows 1 – 10 of drop st patt, work in St st for 2 rows, work star patt for 20 rows, work in St st for 2 rows, work rows 1 – 10 of drop st patt. Change to Lichi, work in star patt for 40 rows, then work rows 1 – 10 of drop st patt. Loosely bind off all sts.

Finishing: Pin piece to measurements and block. **Fringe:** For each fringe, cut 4 strands of Lichi, each strand approx. 30 cm long. Insert crochet hook into fabric from WS, fold 4 strands of yarn in half to form a loop, draw loop through fabric, then draw yarn ends through loop and tighten. Attach 68 fringe evenly spaced along each side edge, 1 fringe in bottom point. Trim fringe to 14 cm.

Gauge Swatch

Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.

beg = begin(ning) · **ch** = chain · **cont** = continue · **dec** = decreas(e)(ing) · **inc** = increas(e)(ing) · **k** = knit · **kwise** = as if to knit
meas = measures · **M1L** = lift strand between sts from front to back and knit this strand through the back loop · **M1R** = lift strand between sts from the back and knit this strand through the front loop · **patt** = pattern · **pm** = place marker · **p** = purl
pwise = as if to purl · **rem** = remain(ing) · **rep** = repeat(s) · **rev St st** = reverse stockinette stitch · **rnd(s)** = round(s) · **RS** = right side · **sc** = single crochet · **skp** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 1 stitch, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch · **sk2p** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 2 together, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch · **s2kp** = slip 2 stitches as if to knit, k 1 stitch, pass slipped stitches over knitted stitch · **sl** = slip · **st(s)** = stitch(es) · **St st** = stockinette stitch · **tbl** = through the back loop · **tog** = together · **wyib** = with yarn in back of work · **wyif** = with yarn in front of work · **WS** = wrong side · **yo(s)** = yarn over(s)
