# SHAWL · PIÙ BELLA

## Design 5 – Tücher & Co. 06



**Size** approx. 50 x 192 cm

**Materials:** 50 g each of Lana Grossa **Più Bella** (59% baby alpaca, 20% polyamide, 15% cashmere, 6% Merino wool; 100 m/25 g) in Pink (**col 4**), Antique Pink (**col 5**), Pale Purple (**col 6**) and Grey (**col 11**). Size 7 mm circular needle, 60 cm long.

**Rib patt:** K1, p1.

**St st:** K on RS, p on WS.

**Stripe patt:** Work 1-row stripes as foll: \* Work 1 RS row in first col, sl sts to other end of needle, work 1 RS row in second col. Work 1 WS row in first col, sl sts to other end of needle, work 1 WS row in second col. Rep from \* throughout.

Begin stripe patt: Work 22 cm in Pink, ending with a WS row. Work [1 row in Antique Pink, 1 row in Pink] 3 times. Work 22 cm in Antique Pink, ending with a WS row. Work [1 row in Grey, 1 row in Antique Pink] 3 times. Work 22 cm in Grey. Work [1 row in Pale Purple, 1 row in Grey] 3 times. Work 44 cm in Pale Purple, ending with a WS row. Work [1 row in Grey, 1 row in Pale Purple] 3 times. Work 22 cm in Grey, ending with a WS row. Work [1 row in Antique Pink, 1 row in Grey] 3 times. Work 22 cm in Antique Pink, ending with a WS row. Work [1 row in Pink, 1 row in Antique Pink] 3 times. Work 22 cm in Pink, ending with a WS row.

**Two-stitch selvage:** On RS row, sl 1 pwise wyib, k1, patt to last 2 sts, k1, sl 1 pwise wyib. On WS row, p1, sl 1 pwise wyif, patt to last 2 sts, sl 1 pwise wyif, p1.

**Gauge:** 13 sts and 19 rows = 10 x 10 cm in St st on size 7 mm needles.

**Shawl:** With size 7 mm circular needle and Pink cast on 66 sts. Next row (WS): Two-stitch selvage, \* k1, p1; rep from \* to last 2 sts, two-stitch selvage. Begin patt: Row 1 (RS): Two-stitch selvage, 6 sts in St st, [yo, skp] 3 times, 38 sts in St st, [k2tog, yo] 3 times, 6 sts in St st, two-stitch selvage. Row 2 (WS): Two-stitch selvage, purl all sts and yos, two-stitch selvage. Rows 3 and 4: Two-stitch selvage, work in St st to last 2 sts, two-stitch selvage. Rep rows 1 – 4 for patt and work in stripe patt. Next row (RS): Work in rib patt same as first WS row and bind off at same time.

**Finishing:** Pin piece to measurements and block. Cut strands for weaving: 2 x 6 strands Pink, 2 x 6 strands Grey, 2 x 6 strands Pale Purple. Weave strands through yos at right and left edge of shawl. Begin with Pale Purple at outer edge, followed by Pink and Grey. Leave 24 cm long ends as fringe, knot ends at edge of shawl.

## Gauge Swatch

### Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.



## Abbreviations

**beg** = begin(ning) · **ch** = chain · **cont** = continue · **dec** = decreas(e)(ing) · **inc** = increas(e)(ing) · **k** = knit · **kwise** = as if to knit  
**meas** = measures · **M1L** = lift strand between sts from front to back and knit this strand through the back loop · **M1R** = lift strand between sts from the back and knit this strand through the front loop · **patt** = pattern · **pm** = place marker · **p** = purl  
**pwise** = as if to purl · **rem** = remain(ing) · **rep** = repeat(s) · **rev St st** = reverse stockinette stitch · **rnd(s)** = round(s) · **RS** = right side · **sc** = single crochet · **skp** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 1 stitch, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch · **sk2p** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 2 together, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch · **s2kp** = slip 2 stitches as if to knit, k 1 stitch, pass slipped stitches over knitted stitch · **sl** = slip · **st(s)** = stitch(es) · **St st** = stockinette stitch · **tbl** = through the back loop · **tog** = together · **wyib** = with yarn in back of work · **wyif** = with yarn in front of work · **WS** = wrong side · **yo(s)** = yarn over(s)
