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Design 12 – Nordic Knits 2

PULLOVER SETASURI

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Size 36/38 (40/42, 44/46, 48/50)

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

Materials: 250 (300, 350, 400) g of Lana Grossa **Setasuri** (69% Suri alpaca, 31% silk; 212 m/25 g) in Viola (**col 53**). Size 5 and 5.5 mm circular needles, 40 and 80 cm long; 1 size 5 mm double-pointed needle [dpn]; stitch markers.

Note: Work with 2 strands held tog throughout.

St st: K on RS, p on WS; k every rnd.

Rev St st: P on RS, k on WS; p every rnd.

Rib patt: K1, p1.

Slip st rib in rows: Row 1 (RS): * K1, p1; rep from *, end k1. Row 2 (WS): * P1, k1; rep from *, end p1. Row 3 (RS): * Sl 1 pwise wyib, p1; rep from *, end sl 1 pwise wyib. Row 4 (WS): As row 2. Work rows 1 – 4 once, then rep rows 3 and 4.

Slip st rib in rnds: Rnd 1: * K1, p1; rep from * around. Rnd 2: * K1, p1; rep from * around. Rnd 3: * Sl 1 pwise wyib, p1; rep from * around. Rnd 4: As rnd 2. Work rnds 1 – 4 once, then rep rnds 3 and 4.

Two-stitch selvage: On RS row, k1, sl 1 pwise wyib; patt to last 2 sts, sl 1 pwise wyib, k1. On WS row, sl 1 pwise wyif, p1; patt to last 2 sts, p1, sl 1 pwise wyif.

Gauge: 16 sts and 25 rows/rnds = 10 x 10 cm in St st with size 5.5 mm needles and 2 strands held tog.

Pullover: Worked from the top down. Arrow on schematic shows direction of work. **Back:** With size 5.5 mm needles and 2 strands held tog cast on 87 (93, 101, 107) sts. Work in St st for 21 (22, 23, 24) cm, ending with a WS row. Place sts on holder, cut yarn. **Right front:** With size 5.5 mm needles, pick up and k 30 (33, 36, 39) sts along right back shoulder. Beg with a WS row work in St st and shape neck as foll: Inc 1 st at neck edge every RS row 3 (3, 2, 2) times, then cast on at neck edge 2 sts 1 (1, 2, 2) time(s), 4 sts 1 time, 9 sts 1 time = 48 (51, 55, 58) sts. Working 9 sts at neck edge in slip st rib and rem sts in St st as established, cont until piece meas 21 (22, 23,

24) cm from pick-up row, ending with a WS row. Place sts on holder, cut yarn. **Left front:** With size 5.5 mm needles, pick up and k 30 (33, 36, 39) sts along left back shoulder. Complete as given for right front. Leave sts on holder, do not cut yarn. **Join fronts and back:** Next row (RS): Work 9 sts in slip st rib, knit to last left front st, p2tog last left front st and first back st, knit to last back sts, p2tog last back sts and first right front sts, knit to last 9 sts, work last 9 sts in slip st rib = 181 (193, 209, 221) sts. Maintaining slip st rib and working decreased st between fronts and back in rev St st as a faux seam, cont in St st over rem sts until piece meas 30 cm from shoulder line, ending with a WS row. Next, work body in rnds as foll: Patt to last 9 sts, sl last 9 sts to dpn. With dpn held parallel and in front of circular needle, ktog each st on dpn with its corresponding st on circular needle, knit to rev St st at left 'side seam', plm, work to end = 172 (184, 200, 212) sts. Keeping sts at each faux seam in rev St st, work rem sts in St st until piece meas 40 (41, 42, 43) cm from underarm. Change to size 5 mm circular needle. Work in slip st rib for 8 rnds. Bind off all sts.

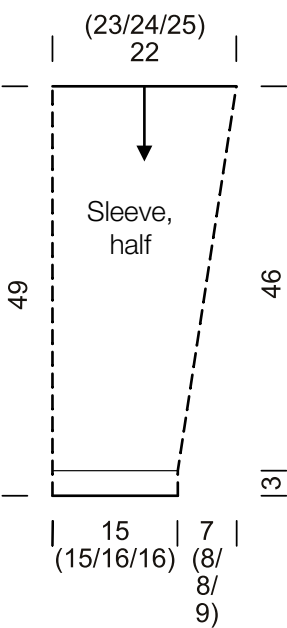
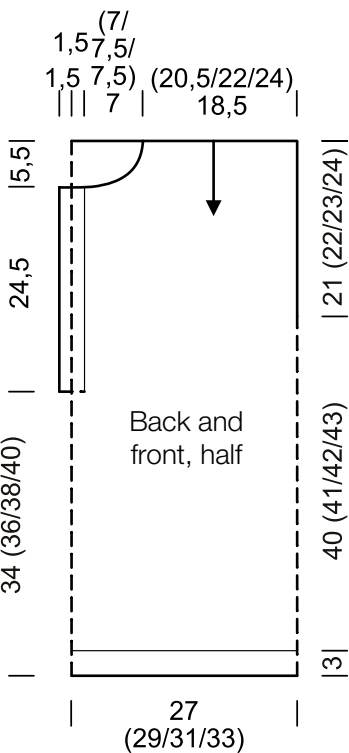
Sleeves: With shorter size 5.5 mm circular needle and 2 strands held tog, pick up and k 70 (74, 76, 80) sts evenly around armhole edge. Place beg of rnd marker and join for working in rnds. Marker is at center of underarm. Work in St st for 8 (7, 7, 6) rnds. Next dec rnd: K1, k2tog, knit to last 3 sts, skp, k1. Rep dec rnd every 9 (8, 8, 7)th rnd 9 (11, 11, 13) times = 50 (50, 52, 52) sts. Work even until piece meas 46 cm from pick-up rnd. Change to shorter size 5 mm circular needle. Work in slip st rib for 8 rnds. Bind off all sts.

Collar: With shorter size 5 mm circular needle and RS facing, beginning 9 sts in from right front edge and ending 9 sts in from left front edge, pick up and k 71 (71, 73, 73) sts evenly along neck edge. Beg and end with a WS row, work in St st for 3 rows. Place sts on holder, cut yarn. Next, with longer size 5 mm circular needle and WS facing, pick up and k the same amount of sts = 71 (71, 73, 73) sts. Beg and end with a WS row, work in St st for 3 rows. Holding both circular needles parallel, ktog each st from one needle with its corresponding st from 2nd needle. Working a two-stitch selvage at each edge and beg with a WS row, work slip st rib for 15 rows. Change to size 5.5 mm circular needle and cont in slip st rib for 25 rows. Loosely bind off all sts.

Finishing: Carefully weave in all ends. Pin piece to measurements and block.

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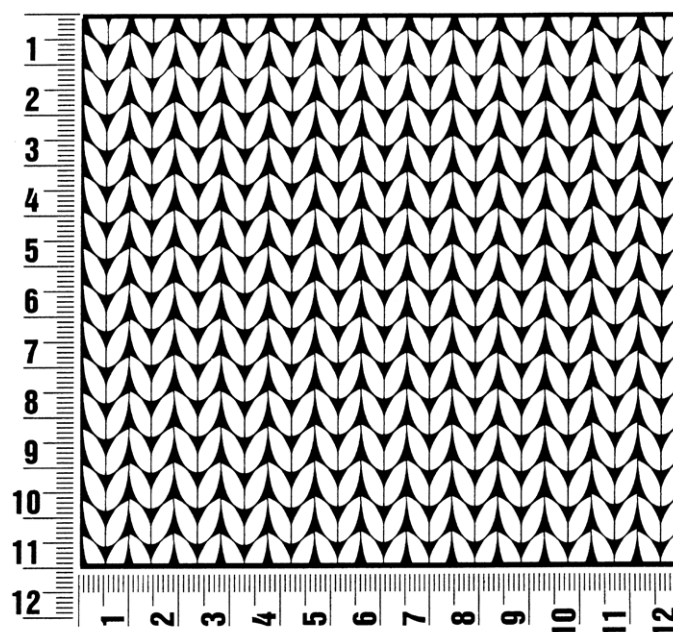
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Gauge Swatch

Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.
