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# **PULLOVER RICCIO**

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**Size** One size

**Materials:** 300 g of Lana Grossa **Riccio** (84% cotton, 16% polyamide; 110 m/50 g) in White (**col 1**). Size 6 and 7 mm needles; size 5.5 mm circular needle, 50 cm long.

**Selvage sts:** On every row: Knit first and last st.

**Garter st:** K every row.

**Clam patt:** Multiple of 19 + 2 selvage sts. **Row 1 (RS):** Selvage st, knit to last st, selvage st. **Row 2 (WS):** As row 1. **Row 3 (RS):** Selvage st, \* k1, yo twice, p2tog tbl, k13, p2tog, yo twice, k1; rep from \*, end selvage st. **Row 4 (WS):** Selvage st, \* k1; k1&p1 into dbl yo; k15; p1&k1 into dbl yo; k1; rep from \*, end selvage st. **Row 5 (RS):** As row 1. **Row 6 (WS):** As row 1. **Row 7 (RS):** Selvage st, \* k1, [yo twice, p2tog tbl] 2 times, k11, [p2tog, yo twice] 2 times, k1; rep from \*, end selvage st. **Row 8 (WS):** Selvage st, \* [k1; k1&p1 into dbl yo] 2 times; k13; [p1&k1 into dbl yo; k1] 2 times; rep from \*, end selvage st. **Row 9 (RS):** As row 1. **Row 10 (WS):** Selvage st, \* k6, [yo twice, k1] 14 times, k5; rep from \*, end selvage st. **Row 11 (RS):** Selvage st, \* k1, [yo twice, p2tog tbl] 2 times, yo twice, [sl 1 st pwise, dropping yos and pulling st up to elongate] 15 times, sl 15 sts back to left needle, p15 tog, [yo twice, p2tog] 2 times, yo twice, k1; rep from \*, end selvage st. **Row 12 (WS):** Selvage st, \* [k1, k1&p1 into dbl yo] 3 times, k1, [p1&k1 into dbl yo, k1] 3 times; rep from \*, end selvage st. Rep rows 1 – 12 for clam patt.

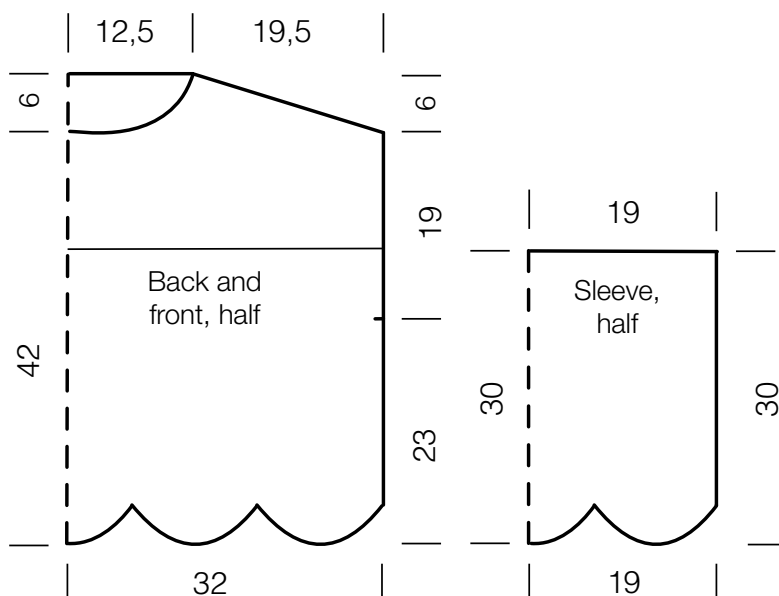
**Gauges:** 14 sts and 30 rows = 10 x 10 cm in garter st on size 6 mm needles; 15 sts and 16 rows = 10 x 10 cm in clam patt on size 7 mm needles.

**Back:** With size 7 mm needles very loosely cast on 97 sts. Knit 1 WS row. With size 6 mm needles work clam patt for 36 rows = 23 cm, working patt rep 5 times across row. Place marker in first and last st on last WS row to indicate beg of armholes. Cont in clam patt for 12 rows. Work in garter st for 19 cm, decreasing 8 sts evenly across first row = 89 sts. Cont in garter st and shape shoulders as foll: At each shoulder edge bind off 2 sts at beg of next 6 rows, 3 sts at beg of next 14 rows. Bind off rem 35 sts.

**Front:** Work same as back to shoulder shaping. Shape shoulders same as for back. **At same time**, on first row of shoulder shaping, shape neck as foll: Bind off center 21 sts. Working each side separately, bind off 2 sts at each neck edge 2 times, 1 st 2 times. Work 3 rows even, then bind off 1 st 1 time. No sts rem.

**Sleeves:** With size 7 mm needles very loosely cast on 59 sts. Knit 1 WS row. With size 6 mm needles work clam patt for 48 rows, working patt rep 3 times across row. Loosely bind off all sts.

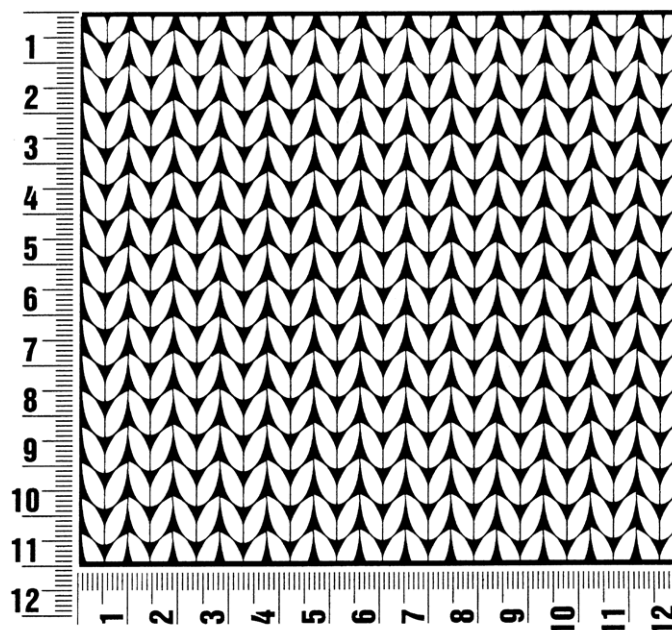
**Finishing:** Pin pieces to measurements and block. Sew shoulder seams. **Neck trim:** With size 5.5 mm circular needle, pick up and k 90 sts evenly around neck edge. Place beg of rnd marker and join for working in rnds. Purl 1 rnd. Bind off all sts kwise. Sew on sleeves between markers. Sew side and sleeve seams. Carefully weave in all ends.



## Gauge Swatch

### Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvedge stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.



## Abbreviations

**beg** = begin(ning) · **ch** = chain · **cont** = continue · **dec** = decreas(e)(ing) · **inc** = increas(e)(ing) · **k** = knit · **kwise** = as if to knit  
**meas** = measures · **M1L** = lift strand between sts from front to back and knit this strand through the back loop · **M1R** = lift strand between sts from the back and knit this strand through the front loop · **patt** = pattern · **pm** = place marker · **p** = purl  
**pwise** = as if to purl · **rem** = remain(ing) · **rep** = repeat(s) · **rev St st** = reverse stockinette stitch · **rnd(s)** = round(s) · **RS** = right side · **sc** = single crochet · **skp** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 1 stitch, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch · **sk2p** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 2 together, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch · **s2kp** = slip 2 stitches as if to knit, k 1 stitch, pass slipped stitches over knitted stitch · **sl** = slip · **st(s)** = stitch(es) · **St st** = stockinette stitch · **tbl** = through the back loop · **tog** = together · **wyib** = with yarn in back of work · **wyif** = with yarn in front of work · **WS** = wrong side · **yo(s)** = yarn over(s)
