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Design 28 – Lookbook 18

SHIRT SILKHAIR

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Size 36/38 (40/42, 44/46, 48/50)

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

Materials: 125 (125, 150, 150) g of Lana Grossa **Silkhair** (70% superkid mohair, 30% silk; 210 m/25 g) in Lilac (col 173). Size 3.5 and 4 mm needles; short size 3.5 mm circular needle.

Rib patt: P1, k1.

St st: K on RS, p on WS.

Two-stitch selvage: At beg of row, sl 1 pwise wyif, k1. At end of row, sl 1 pwise wyif, k1.

Gauge: 19 sts and 25 rows = 10 x 10 cm in St st on size 4 mm needles.

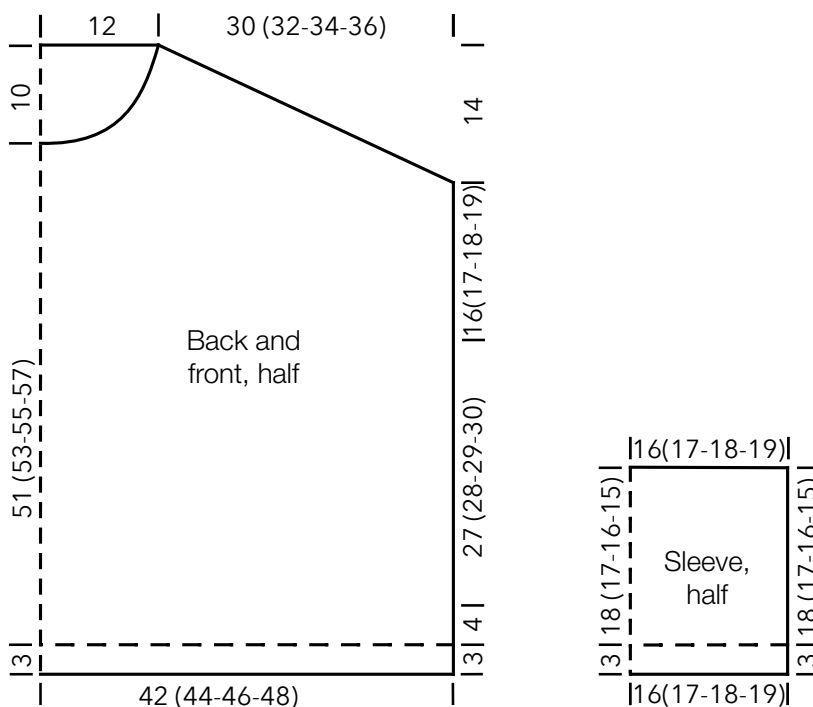
Back: With size 3.5 mm needles cast on 163 (171, 179, 187) sts. Next row (RS): Two-stitch selvage, * p1, k1; rep from * to last 3 sts, p1, two-stitch selvage. Work in rib patt as set by last row until piece meas 3 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Change to size 4 mm needles. Maintaining two-stitch selvage at each edge, work in St st until piece meas 7 cm from cast-on. Place marker in first and last st on last WS row

to indicate top of split hem. Next row (RS): K2tog, knit to last 2 sts, k2tog = 161 (169, 177, 185) sts. Cont in St st across all sts until piece meas 34 (35, 36, 37) cm from cast-on. Place marker in first and last st on last WS row to indicate beg of armholes. Cont until piece meas 16 (17, 18, 19) cm from arm-hole markers, ending with a WS row. Shape shoulders: At each shoulder edge bind off 3 sts 10 times, 4 sts 7 times (3 sts 6 times, 4 sts 11 times / 3 sts 2 times, 4 sts 15 times / 4 sts 15 times, 5 sts 2 times). Bind off rem 45 sts.

Front: Work same as back to shoulder shaping. Shape shoulders same as for back. At same time, when working 6th RS shoulder bind-off row, work neck as foll: Bind off center 25 sts. Working each side separately, bind off 3 sts at each neck edge 1 time, 2 sts 2 times, 1 st 3 times. No sts rem.

Sleeves: With size 3.5 mm needles cast on 62 (66, 70, 74) sts. Work in St st until piece meas 3 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Change to size 4 mm needles. Cont in St st until piece meas 21 (20, 19, 18) cm from cast-on. Bind off all sts.

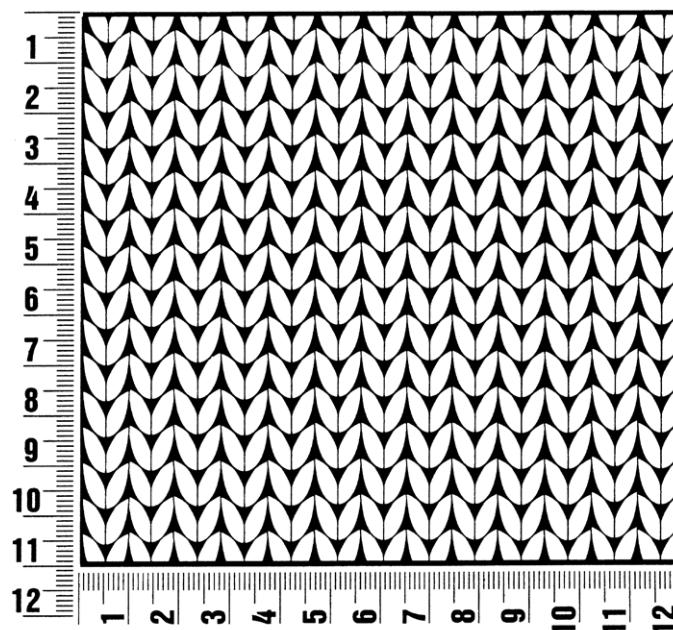
Finishing: Sew shoulder seams. **Neckband:** With size 3.5 mm circular needle, pick up and k 158 sts evenly around neck edge. Place beg of rnd marker and join for working in rnds. Work in rib patt for 2 cm. Bind off all sts. Sew on sleeves between markers. Sew side and sleeve seams, leaving bottom 7 cm of side seams open for split hem.



Gauge Swatch

Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvedge stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.
