



Design 16 – Lookbook 20

**TOP
CORALLO**



Size 36/38 (40/42, 44/46, 48/50)

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

Materials: 400 (500, 500, 600) g of Lana Grossa **Corallo** (70% organic cotton, 30% Merino wool; 210 m/100 g) in Beige/Greige/Off White (**col 10**). Size 4 and 4.5 mm needles; short size 4 mm circular needle.

Garter st in rows: K every row.

Garter st in rnds: *Purl 1 rnd, knit 1 rnd*, rep *-*.

Selvage sts: Always knit first st, slip last st pwise wyif.

St st: K on RS, p on WS.

Full-fashion decrease: At beg of RS row, selvage st, 2 sts in garter st, k2tog; at end of RS row, work to last 5 sts, skp, 2 sts in garter st, selvage st.

Gauge: 19 sts and 28 rows = 10 x 10 cm in St st on size 4.5 mm needles.

Back: Using size 4 mm needles cast on 92 (100, 108, 116) sts. Beg with a RS row and working first and last st as selvage sts, work in garter st for 6 rows. Change to size 4.5 mm needles. Next row (RS): Selvage st, 2 sts in garter st, work in St st to last 3 sts, 2 sts in garter st, selvage st. Work in patt as set by last row until piece meas 15 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Place marker in last st on last WS row to indicate beg of right side seam. Next row (RS): Inc 1 st at beg of row = 93 (101, 109, 117) sts. Work increased st in garter st. Cont in patt until piece meas 25 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Place marker in first st on last WS row to indicate beg of left side seam. Next row (RS): Inc 1 st at end of row = 94 (102, 110, 118) sts. Work increased st in garter st. Cont in patt until piece meas 55 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape armholes: Bind off 1 st at beg of next 2 rows = 92 (100, 108, 116) sts. Working full-fashion dec, dec 1 st at each end of next 12 (13, 14, 15) RS rows = 68 (74, 80, 86) sts. Maintaining garter st edge at armhole edges, cont in St st until armhole meas 19 (21, 23, 25) cm, ending with a WS row. Shape shoulders: At each shoulder edge bind off 5 (6, 7, 8) sts 2 times, 6 (7, 8, 9) sts 1 time. Bind off rem 36 sts.

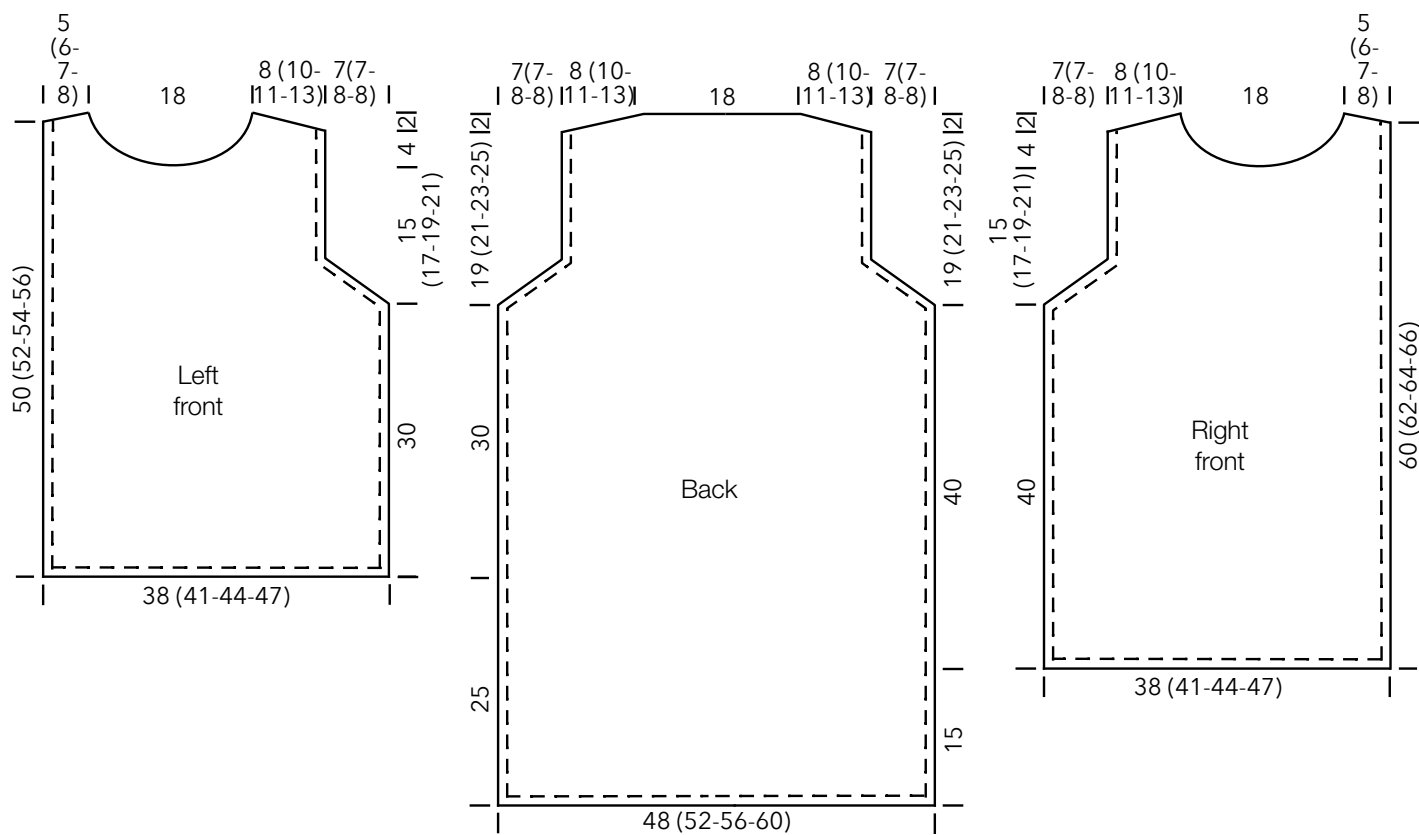
Left front: Using size 4 mm needles cast on 73 (79, 85, 91) sts. Beg with a RS row and working first and last st as selvage sts, work in garter st for 6 rows. Change to size 4.5 mm needles. Next row (RS): Selvage st, 2 sts in garter st, work in St st to last 4 sts, 3 sts in garter st, selvage st. Work in patt as set by last row until piece meas 30 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape armhole: Bind off 1 st at beg of next RS row. Working full-fashion dec, dec 1 st at beg of next 12 (13, 14, 15) RS rows = 60 (65, 70, 75) sts. Maintaining garter st edge at armhole edge, cont until armhole meas 15 (17, 19, 21) cm, ending with a WS row. Shape neck: Next row (RS): Work 26 (29, 32, 35) sts in est patt, bind off 16 sts, work rem 18 (20, 22, 24) sts in est patt. Working each side separately, bind off 3 sts at each neck edge 1 time, 2 sts 2 times, 1 st 3 times and when armhole meas 19 (21, 23, 25) cm, shape shoulders as foll: At beg of RS rows bind off 5 (6, 7, 8) sts 2 times, 6 (7, 8, 9) sts 1 time and at beg of WS rows bind off 4 (5, 6, 7) sts 2 times. No sts rem.

Right front: Using size 4 mm needles cast on 73 (79, 85, 91) sts. Beg with a RS row and working first and last st as selvage sts, work in garter st for 6 rows. Change to size 4.5 mm needles. Next row (RS): Selvage st, 3 sts in garter st, work in St st to last 3 sts, 2 sts in garter st, selvage st. Work in patt as set by last row until piece meas 40 cm from cast-on, ending with a RS row. Shape armhole: Bind off 1 st at beg of next WS row. Working full-fashion dec, dec 1 st at end of next 12 (13, 14, 15) RS rows = 60 (65, 70, 75) sts. Maintaining garter st edge at armhole edge, cont until armhole meas 15 (17, 19, 21) cm, ending with a WS row. Shape neck: Next row (RS): Work 18 (20, 22, 24) sts in est patt, bind off 16 sts, work rem 26 (29, 32, 35) sts in est patt. Working each side separately, bind off 3 sts at each neck edge 1 time, 2 sts 2 times, 1 st 3 times when armhole meas 19 (21, 23, 25) cm, shape shoulders as foll: At beg of RS rows bind off 4 (5, 6, 7) sts 2 times and at beg of WS rows bind off 5 (6, 7, 8) sts 2 times, 6 (7, 8, 9) sts 1 time. No sts rem.

Finishing: With right front placed on top of left front, sew fronts tog along neck edge and shoulders. Join front shoulders to back shoulders. Sew side seams. **Neckband:** Using size 4 mm circular needle, pick up and k 84 sts evenly around neck edge. Place beg of rnd marker and join for working in rnds. Work in garter st for 3 cm. Loosely bind off all sts.

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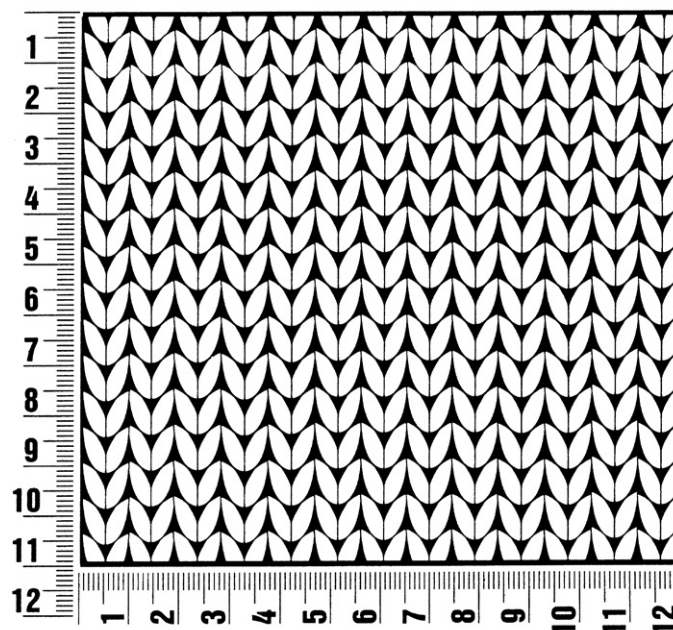
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Gauge Swatch

Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvedge stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.



Abbreviations

beg = begin(ning) · **ch** = chain · **cont** = continue · **dec** = decreas(e)(ing) · **inc** = increas(e)(ing) · **k** = knit · **kwise** = as if to knit
meas = measures · **M1L** = lift strand between sts from front to back and knit this strand through the back loop · **M1R** = lift strand between sts from the back and knit this strand through the front loop · **patt** = pattern · **pm** = place marker · **p** = purl
pwise = as if to purl · **rem** = remain(ing) · **rep** = repeat(s) · **rev St st** = reverse stockinette stitch · **rnd(s)** = round(s) · **RS** = right side · **sc** = single crochet · **skp** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 1 stitch, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch · **sk2p** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 2 together, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch · **s2kp** = slip 2 stitches as if to knit, k 1 stitch, pass slipped stitches over knitted stitch · **sl** = slip · **st(s)** = stitch(es) · **St st** = stockinette stitch · **tbl** = through the back loop · **tog** = together · **wyib** = with yarn in back of work · **wyif** = with yarn in front of work · **WS** = wrong side · **yo(s)** = yarn over(s)
