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Design 15 – Nera 2

POLO SHIRT
SETASURI PEARLS

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Size 36/38 (44/46, 52/54)

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

Materials: 250 (300, 350) g of Lana Grossa **Setasuri Pearls** (50% Suri alpaca, 22% silk, 16% cotton, 12% glass; 140 m/25 g) in Beige (**col 214**). Size 3.5 and 4 mm needles; short size 3.5 mm circular needle; size 4 mm spare needle or cable needle [cn].

Rib patt:

Multiple of 2. Row 1 (WS): *K1, p1*, rep *-*.

Multiple of 2 + 1. Row 1 (WS): *K1, p1*, rep *-*, end k1.

On foll rows work sts as they appear.

Rev St st: P on RS, k on WS.

Eyelet patt: Multiple of 15 + 9. Work according to chart. Chart shows RS rows only. Read RS rows from right to left. On WS rows work sts as they appear, purl all yos. Work 1 st to patt rep, work 15-st patt rep throughout, work 8 sts to end of chart. Rep rows 1 – 8 for eyelet patt. Note: When working shaping, make sure each yo is paired with a decrease. If there are not enough sts to offset a yo with a decrease or vice versa, work sts in rev St st instead.

Selvage sts: Always knit first and last st.

Two-stitch selvage: At beg of RS row, sl 1 pwise wyif, k1; at end of RS row, k1, sl 1 pwise wyif. At beg of WS row, k1, sl 1 pwise wyif; at end of WS row, sl 1 pwise wyif, k1.

Gauge: 19 sts and 24 rows = 10 x 10 cm in eyelet patt on size 4 mm needles.

Back: Using size 3.5 mm needles cast on 101 (116, 131) sts. Beg and end with a WS row work in rib patt until piece meas 4 cm from cast-on. Change to size 4 mm needles. Working first and last st as selvage sts, work chart until piece meas 28 (30, 32) cm from end of rib patt, ending with a WS row. Work 15-st patt rep 6 (7, 8) times across row. Shape armholes: Bind off 4 (5, 6) sts at beg of next 2 rows, 2 sts at beg of next 4 (8, 12) rows = 85 (90, 95) sts. Cont in patt until armhole meas 20 (23, 26) cm, ending with a WS row. Shape shoulders and neck: At each shoulder edge bind off 5 sts 4 (2, 0) times, 6 sts 1 (3, 5) times. At same time, when working 2nd RS shoulder bind-off row, shape neck: Bind off center 17 (18, 19) sts. Working each side separately, bind off 4 sts at each neck edge 1 time, 2 sts 2 times. No sts rem.

Front: Work same as back until armhole meas 1 (4, 7) cm, ending with a WS row. Divide for center slit: Next row (RS): Work in patt to center 3 (2, 3) sts. Sl 1 st to spare needle or cn and hold in front of work, k2tog (k1, k2tog), then k1 from cn, work to end. Place a marker between the 2 crossed sts to mark center of work. Right front: Next row (WS): Work in patt to 2 sts before marker, work two-stitch selvage and turn, leaving rem sts on hold. Cont in patt until piece meas 13 cm from divide, ending with a WS row. Shape neck: At beg of RS rows bind off 4 sts 1 time, 3 sts 1 time, 2 sts 2 times, 1 st 6 (7, 7) times and at same time, when armhole meas 20 (23, 26) cm, shape shoulder at beg of WS rows same as for back. No sts rem. Left front: Return held sts to needle and with WS facing rejoin yarn. Next row (WS): Two-stitch selvage, work in patt to end. Complete as given for right front, reversing all shaping.

Collar: Sew shoulder seams. Using size 3.5 mm circular needle and with WS facing, pick up and k 91 (93, 95) sts evenly along neck edge. Next row (RS): Two-stitch selvage, *p1, k1*, rep *-* to last 3 sts, p1, two-stitch selvage. Maintaining two-stitch selvage, work in rib patt for a total of 10 cm. Loosely bind off all sts.

Sleeves: Using size 3.5 mm needles cast on 57 (72, 87) sts. Beg and end with a WS row work in rib patt until piece meas 4 cm from cast-on. Change to size 4 mm needles. Next row (RS): Selvage st; work row 1 of chart = beginning at A work 9 sts to end of patt rep, work 15-st patt rep 3 (4, 5) times, end with 1 st after patt rep at B; selvage st. Maintaining selvage sts, cont chart for 3 rows, ending with a WS row. Shape sleeve: Inc 1 st at each end of next RS row, then every 6th row 4 times = 67 (82, 97) sts. Work increased sts into patt. Cont in patt until piece meas 15 cm from end of rib patt, ending with a WS row. Shape sleeve cap: Bind off 3 sts at beg of next 10 rows, 2 sts at beg of next 8 (14, 20) rows, 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows. Bind off rem 15 (18, 21) sts.

Finishing: Sew in sleeves. Sew side and sleeve seams.

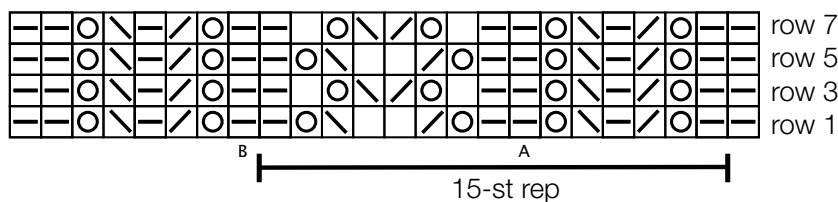
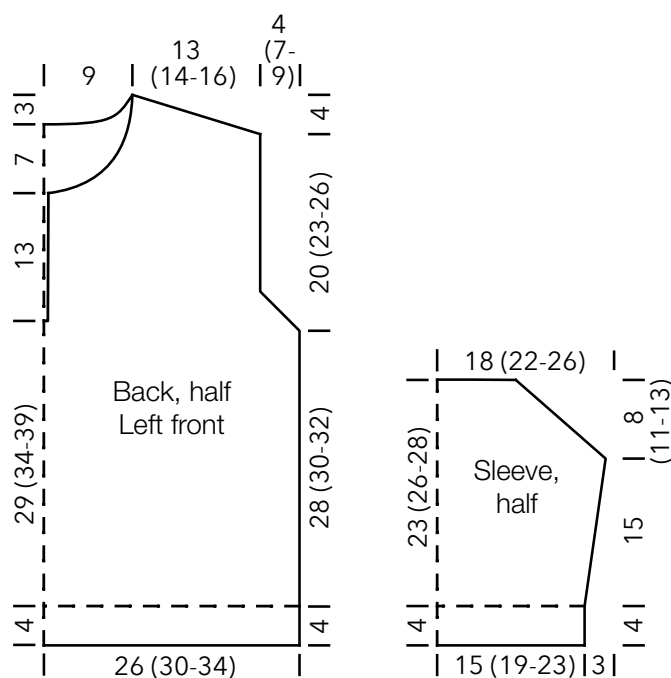


Chart key:

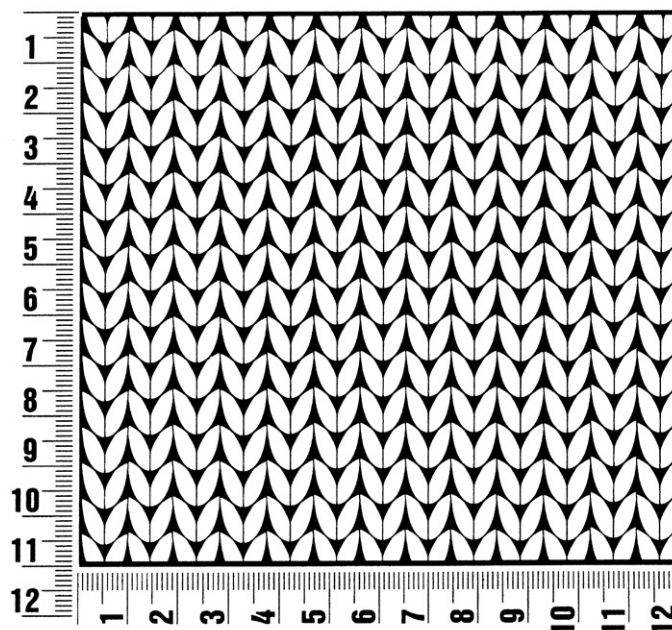
- = p1

Gauge Swatch

Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvedge stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.
