[WS]: Selvage st, purl to last st, selvage st. Rows 7 and 8: Work same as rows 5 and 6. Row 9 [RS]: With size 12 mm needles and 3 strands of yarn held tog, selvage st, knit to last st, selvage st. Row 10 [WS]: Selvage st, purl to last st, selvage st. Rows 11 and 12: Work same as rows 9 and 10. Row 13 [RS]: With size 9 mm needles and 2 strands of yarn held tog, selvage st, knit to last st, selvage st. Row 14 [WS]: Selvage st, purl to last st, selvage st. Rows 15 and 16: Work same as rows 13 and 14. Work rows 1 – 16 once.

Gauge: 19.5 sts and 28 rows = 10×10 cm in stockinette with size 6 mm needles and 1 strand of yarn; 7.5 sts = 10 cm in stockinette with size 15 mm needles and 4 strands of yarn held tog.

Back: With size 15 mm needles and 4 strands of yarn held tog, cast on 42 (46, 50) sts and work the 16 rows for the flared hem. At same time, on 7^{th} row from caston, inc 5 (6, 7) sts evenly across row = 47 (52, 57) sts. Repeat last inc row every other row 3 times more = 62 (70, 78) sts. Do not work increases on top of previous increases. Change to size 6 mm needles, work in stockinette with 1 strand of yarn and inc 10 sts evenly across first row = 72 (80, 88) sts.

When back measures 34 cm from last row of flared hem, place a locking marker in first and last st of last WS row. Inc 1 st at beg and end of next RS row, then every foll 4^{th} row 9 times = 92 (100, 108) sts. Cont until back measures 17 (18, 19) cm from markers, ending with a WS row. Shape shoulders: Bind off 5 (6, 7) sts at each shoulder edge once and 6 (7, 8) sts 3 times. At same time, on 3^{rd} row of shoulder shaping, shape neck: Bind off center 36 sts. Working each side separately, bind off 3 sts at each neck edge once and 2 sts once. No sts remain.

Front: Work same as for back until front measures 8 (9, 10) cm from markers, ending with a WS row. Shape neck: Bind off center 20 sts. Working each side separately, bind off 2 sts at each neck edge every other row 4 times, 2 sts every foll 4th row twice and 1 st every foll 4th row once. No sts remain.


Finishing: Pin pieces to measurements and block. Sew shoulder seams. Sew side seams to markers. With crochet hook, work 1 rnd single crochet around neck edge, then work 1 rnd slip stitch around each armhole edge.

decs at beg of row same as for back and at end of row same as for front. When sleeve cap measures 19 (21, 23) cm from beg, bind off 2 sts at beg of next 2 WS rows. After all decs have been worked, bind off remaining 2 sts.

Right sleeve: Work same as for left sleeve, reversing sleeve cap shaping.

Finishing: Pin pieces to measurements and block. Sew all seams. With crochet hook, work 1 rnd single crochet around neck edge. SI st to first sc, cut yarn and fasten off. Emboider front as instructed.







RAGLAN PULLOVER WITH EMBROIDERY · Musica Size 36/38 (40/42, 44/46)

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

Materials: Approx. 300 (350, 400) g of Lana Grossa Musica (97% cotton, 3% polyamide; 75m/50g) in Charcoal/Grey/White (col 10); size 6 and 7 mm needles; size 5 mm crochet hook; sew-on rhinestones [by Union Knopf, item 451701, col 74 grey: 3 in size 16 and 15 in size 10; col 18 light brown: 1 in size 16 and 15 in size 10]; tapestry needle.

Garter st: K every row.

Stockinette: K on RS, p on WS.

Embroidery: Work according to chart on page 77. Photocopy the chart and enlarge it by 200%. Lines on chart show armhole and neck shaping. Work flowers and stems in straight stitch and stem stitch. Outline

flowers in stem stitch. Sew large light brown rhinestone to center of flower at neck edge; sew large grey rhinestones to center of remaining flowers; sew small rhinestones to stems, alternating light brown and grey.

Full-fashion decreases: At beg of RS row, selvage st, k2, k2tog; at end of RS row, work to last 5 sts, SKP [sl1 kwise, k1, psso], k2, selvage st.

Gauge: 13 sts and 18 rows = $10 \times 10 \text{ cm}$ stockinette on size 7 mm needles.

Back: With size 6 mm needles, cast on 62 (67, 72) sts and work in garter st for 2 rows and back measuring 1 cm from cast-on. Change to size 7 mm needles, work in stockinette and shape sides as foll: Dec 1 st at beg and end of 23rd row worked in stockinette = 60 (65, 70) sts. Cont until back measures 25 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape armholes: Working full-fashion decs, dec 1 st at beg and end of next 18 (21, 23) RS rows. Cont until armhole measures 22 (24, 26) cm from beg. Bind off remaining 24 (23, 24) sts.

Front: Work same as for back to armhole shaping. Shape armholes: Working full-fashion decs, dec 1 st at beg and end of next 15 (18, 20) RS rows. At same time, when armhole measures 17 (19, 21) cm from beg, shape neck on next RS row as foll: Bind off center 20 (19, 20) sts. Working each side separately, bind off 2 sts at each neck edge once. When armhole measures 19 (21, 23) cm from beg, bind off remaining 3 sts.

Left sleeve: With size 6 mm needles, cast on 31 (33, 35) sts and work in garter st for 2 rows and sleeve measuring 1 cm from caston. Change to size 7 mm needles, work in stockinette and shape sleeve as foll: Inc 1 st at beg and end of 11^{th} (3^{cd} , 7^{th}) row, then every foll 10^{th} (8^{th} , 6^{th}) 3 (5, 6) times = 39 (45, 49) sts. Cont until sleeve measures 29 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape sleeve cap: Working full-fashion decs, work



TRIANGULAR SHAWL · Silkhair Print

Size: Approx. 66 x 150 cm

Materials: Approx. 100 g of Lana Grossa Silkhair Print (70% superkid mohair, 30% silk; 400m/50g) in Turquoise/Petrol/Olive/Dark Purple (col 328); size 4 mm needles; size 4 mm circular needles, 80 and 120 cm long; size 3 mm crochet hook.

Lace pattern: Work according to chart. Numbers at right edge of chart indicate RS rows; on WS rows, purl all sts and yos. Beg chart pat with 11 sts. Arrow indicates center of chart. Work increases on WS rows as foll: Chart row 2: K1f&b in first and last st = 1 st increased at each edge. Chart row 4: [K1f&b, k1] in first and last st = 2 sts increased at each edge. Repeat last 2 increase rows throughout = 6 sts increased

over 4 rows. Chart shows pattern in its entirety through chart row 57 = 95 sts. Work rows 1 - 58 once, then repeat rows 27 - 58 throughout.

Gauge: 19 sts and 28 rows = $10 \times 10 \text{ cm}$ in lace pat on size 4 mm needles.

Instructions: With size 4 mm needles, cast on 11 sts and work in lace pat according to chart as instructed. Change to circular needles as stitch count increases. After having worked a total of 186 rows and shawl measures 66 cm from cast-on, you will have 287 sts on the needle. Bind off all sts loosely.

Finishing: Pin piece to measurements and block. With crochet hook, work 1 rnd single crochet, then 1 rnd reverse single crochet [work single crochet from left to right] around entire edge.


