

## COWL





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**Size:** Approx. 135 cm in circumference and 26 cm wide

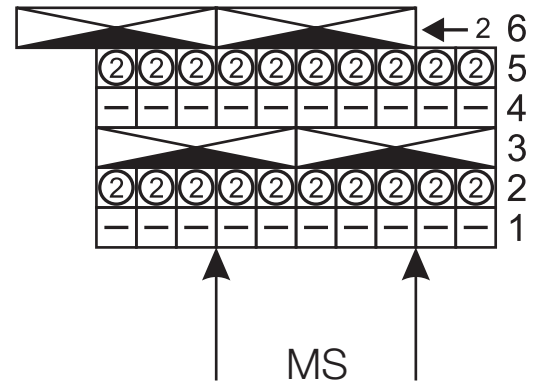
**Materials:** 50 g of Lana Grossa **Silkhair Print** (70% superkid mohair, 30% silk; 400 m/50 g) in Light Blue/Mint/Grey-Beige/Grey (**col 347**). Size 5 mm circular needle.

**Elongated stitch pattern:** Multiple of 5. Worked in rnds according to chart. Numbers at right edge of chart indicate rnds. Work the 5-st pat rep between arrows around. Repeat rnds 1 – 6 throughout. Chart shows 2 pat reps.

**Gauge:** 20 sts and 14 rnds = 10 x 10 cm in elongated st pat on size 5 mm needles.

**Instructions:** With size 5 mm circular needle, loosely cast on 270 sts. Join for working in rnds, place beg of rnd marker and work in elongated st pat according to chart for 36 rnds and piece measures approx. 26 cm from cast-on. Loosely bind off all sts in purl.

## Chart key:

- = p1
- ⊗ = yo twice, then k1
- ⌂ = sl 5 sts as if to purl to right needle, dropping yos and pulling sts up to elongate; slide same 5 sts back to left needle, then k5tog tbl these 5 sts, [yo, k5tog tbl same 5 sts] twice, then sl 5
- ⌂ = sl 5 sts to right needle
- ⌂ = at beg of rnd, sl 2 sts to left needle

## GAUGE SWATCH

Before you begin knitting...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast on and bind off rows, as well as selvaige stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.

## ABBREVIATIONS

**beg** = begin(ning) • **cm** = centimeter(s) • **cont** = continue • **k** = knit • **k1f&b** = knit into front and back of same stitch • **m** = meter • **M1L** = lift strand between sts from front to back and k this strand through the back loop • **M1R** = lift strand between sts from the back and k this strand through the front loop • **mm** = millimeter • **p** = purl • **rem** = remaining; remain(s) • **rep** = repeat • **rnd(s)** = round(s) • **RS** = right side • **SKP** = slip 1 stitch, knit 1 stitch, pass slipped stitch over • **SK2P** = slip 1 stitch, knit 2 together, pass slipped stitch over • **S2KP** = slip 2 stitches, k1 stitch, pass slipped stitches over • **sl** = slip • **st (s)** = stitch(es) • **tbl** = through the back loop • **tog** = together • **WS** = wrong side • **yo** = yarnover
