## MOHAIR BOOKLET



Size: $32 \times 180(205,230)$ cm
Instructions are given for first length. Figures in parenthesis refer to longer lengths. When only one figure is given, it applies to all lengths.

Materials: $\mathbf{1 0 0} \mathbf{g}$ each of Lana Grossa Silkhair Print (70\% superkid mohair, $30 \%$ silk; $400 \mathrm{~m} / 50 \mathrm{~g}$ ) in Orange/Petrol/Pink/Khaki (col 343) and Red/Blue/Light Green/Dark Violet (col 335) and $\mathbf{5 0} \mathbf{g}$ each in Na tural/Light Blue/Camel/Khaki/Grey-Brown (col 341) and Peach/Greige/Beige/Pale Purple (col 346). Size 15 mm needles; crochet hook for fringe.

Note: Work with 6 strands Silkhair Print held tog throughout as given in instructions.
Slip stitch selvage: Knit the first st of every row tbl and slip the last st of every row as if to purl with yarn in front of work. Work a slip st selvage throughout.
Rib pattern: K1, p1.
Gauge: 8 sts and 8 rows $=10 \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}$ in rib pat (measured unstretched) with size 15 mm needles and 6 strands of yarn held tog.

Instructions: With size 15 mm needles and 6 strands col 346 held tog, cast on 27 sts. Working a slip st selvage throughout, work in rib pat and work stripes as foll: $24(28,32)$ rows with 6 strands of col 346 held tog, 3 rows with 5 strands col 346 and 1 strand col 341 held tog, 3 rows with 4 strands col 346 and 2 strands col 341 held tog, 3 rows with 3 strands col 346 and 3 strands col 341 held tog, 3 rows with 2 strands col 346 and 4 strands col 341 held tog, 3 rows with 1 strand col 346 and 5 strands col 341 held tog, $25(29,33)$ rows with 6 strands col 341 held tog, 3 rows with 5 strands col 341 and 1 strand col 343 held tog, 3 rows with 4 strands col 341 and 2 strands col 343 held tog, 3 rows with 3 strands col 341 and 3 strands col 343 held tog, 3 rows with 2 strands col 341 and 4 strands col 343 held tog, 3 rows with 5 strands col 341 and 1 strand col 343 held tog, $25(29,33)$ rows with 6 strands col 343 held tog, 3 rows with 5 strands col 343
and 1 strand col 335 held tog, 3 rows with 4 strands col 343 and 2 strands col 335 held tog, 3 rows with 3 strands col 343 and 3 strands col 335 held tog, 3 rows with 2 strands col 343 and 4 strands col 335 held tog, 3 rows with 5 strands col 343 and 1 strand col 335 held tog, $25(29,33)$ rows with 6 strands col 335 held tog. Loosely bind off all sts in rib.
Finishing: Make and attach fringe: For each fringe, cut 18 strands of yarn, each strand 46 cm long. With crochet hook, attach 11 fringe in col 346 along cast-on edge and 11 fringe in col 335 along bound-off edge. Trim fringe to 20 cm .

## GAUGE SWATCH

Before you begin knitting...
...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. $12 \mathrm{~cm} x$ 12 cm . Cast on and bind off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm . If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.
