Design 2A/B/C – Triangular shawl







You will need **100 g** of Lana Grossa **Gomitolo Silkhair** (65% superkid mohair, 30% silk, 5% Merino wool; 800 m/100 g) in Brown/Mustard Melange (**col 205**) or **100 g** in Grey/Brown Melange (**col 202**) or **100 g** in Blue/Marine Melange (**col 207**). Size 5.5 mm circular needles, 80 and 120 cm long.

Size Approx. 80 x 220 cm

Gauge: 16 sts and 22 rows = 10×10 cm in St st on size 5.5 mm needles.

St st: K on RS, p on WS.

Slip garter selvage: On RS row, sl first st kwise and k last st; on WS row, sl first st pwise and p last st.

Instructions: Shawl is worked from the point up. With shorter size 5.5 mm circular needle cast on 7 sts. Next WS row: Slip garter selvage, p5, slip garter selvage. Row 1 (RS): Slip garter selvage, M1R, k5, M1R, slip garter selvage = 9 sts. Row 2 (WS): Slip garter selvage, M1R, p7, M1R, slip garter selvage = 11 sts. Row 3: Slip garter selvage, M1R, k8, M1R, slip garter selvage, M1R, slip garter selvage, M1R, p11, M1R, slip garter selvage, M1R, p11, M1R, slip garter

selvage = 15 sts. Cont in this manner, inc 1 st at each end of every row until 351 sts are on the needle or until there is just enough yarn left to bind off. Change to longer circular needle as st count increases. Loosely bind off all sts on a RS row.

Finishing: Carefully weave in all ends. Pin piece to measurements and block.
