# **DESIGN 8**



### **ONLY COTTON PANTS Size** 50/56 (62/68, 74/80)

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes. **Materials: 50 (50, 100) g** of Lana Grossa **Only Cotton** (100% cotton; 110 m/50 g) in White **(col 1)**. Size 4.5 mm needles; size 4.5 mm circular needle, 40 cm long. **Rib pattern:** K1, p1.


Garter st: K every row. Stockinette: K on RS, p on WS. Stockinette in rnds: K every rnd. Gauge: 20 sts and 27 rnds/rows = 10 x 10 c

**Gauge:** 20 sts and 27 rnds/rows =  $10 \times 10$  cm in stockinette on size 4.5 mm needles.

**First leg:** With size 4.5 mm needles cast on 38 (42, 46) sts. Beg and end with a WS row work in garter st for 1 cm. Cut yarn. Put aside. With size 4.5 mm circular needle work **2nd leg** same as first leg, ending with a WS row. Do not cut yarn. Next RS row: K38 (42, 46), place marker [pm], cast on 8 sts for gusset, pm, k38 (42, 46) across first leg, pm, cast on 8 sts for gusset, pm = 92 (100, 108) sts. Join for working in rnds. Work stock-inette in rnds and work gusset dec as foll: Next rnd: Knit. Next dec rnd: \* K to 1 st before marker, k2tog; rep from \*

once more. Rep last 2 rnds until all gusset sts have been decreased and 76 (84, 92) sts rem. Remove gusset markers. Mark center of each leg at outer edge. Work even for 9 (12, 14) rnds. Next dec rnd: Dec 1 st at each marker = 74 (82, 90) sts. Work even until piece meas 13.5 (16.5, 19.5) cm from leg cast-on. Shape back with short-rows: K to one of the markers, turn. Next WS row: Yo, p37 (41, 45) to marker, turn. Next RS row: Yo, k to 3 sts before yo, turn. Next WS row: Yo, p to 3 sts before yo, turn. Rep last 2 rows twice more. Next RS row/rnd 1: Yo, \* k to next yo, ktog yo and next st; rep from \* 3 more times, \*\* k to 1 st before next yo, skp next st and yo; rep from \*\* 3 more times. Cont in rnds. Work rib patt in rnds until piece meas 17.5 (20.5, 23.5) cm from leg cast-on, measured along front of pants. Bind off.

Finishing: Seam legs.



## **DESIGN 9**



### BABY SOFT BLANKET Size 84 x 77 cm

Materials: 150 g of Lana Grossa Baby Soft (60% polyamide, 40% cotton; 150 m/50 g) in Dark Grey (col 11) and 100 g in White (col 1). One set size 4 mm double-pointed needles [dpns], size 4 mm circular needles, various lengths.

Stockinette in rnds: K every rnd.

**Stripe sequence:** Work [2 rnds with Dark Grey, 2 rnds with White] 9 times, 12 rnds with Dark Grey, [2 rnds with White, 2 rnds with Dark Grey] 6 times, 2 rnds with White, 12 rnds with Dark Grey, [2 rnds with White, 2 rnds with Dark Grey] 6 times, 2 rnds with White, 10 rnds with Dark Grey = 122 rnds total.

**Gauge:** 18 sts and 35 rnds =  $10 \times 10$  cm in stockinette on size 4 mm needles. **Instructions:** Blanket is worked in rnds from the inside out. With size 4 mm dpns and Dark Grey cast on 18 sts. Arrange sts on 4 needles: On first and 3rd needle, 3 sts = 1 corner st + 2 sts; on 2nd and 4th needle, 6 sts = 1 corner st + 5 sts. Join for working in rnds, place beg of rnd marker. **Rnd 1:** Knit. **Rnd 2:** Knit and M1R before and after each corner st = 8 sts increased and 26 sts total. Cont in stockinette, follow stripe sequence and work incs as established on every other rnd 60 times more = 506 sts. Change to circular needles as st count increases. Next rnd: Purl for turning ridge. Next rnd: Knit. Dec rnd: \* Knit to 1 st before corner st, s2kp; rep from \* around = 8 sts decreased and 498 sts total. Rep last 2 rnds 4 more times = 466 sts. Bind off.

**Finishing:** Fold outside edge of blanket to WS at turning ridge and sew down. Sew cast-on rnd tog.

# **DESIGN 10**



### PREGO OVERALL Size 62/68 (74/80)

Instructions are given for first size. Figure in parenthesis refers to larger size. When only one figure is given, it applies to both sizes.

Materials: 100 (150) g of Lana Grossa Prego (70% cotton, 30% pure wool; 110 m/50 g) in Grey (col 8). Size 3.5 mm crochet hook; three 14 mm buttons.

**Single crochet (sc):** Beg each row/rnd with ch 1. When working in rnds, sl st in first sc to join.

**Double crochet (dc):** Bech ech row/rnd with ch 3 (counts as dc). When working in rnds, sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch-3 to join.

Pattern: Alternate 1 rnd/row dc, 1 rnd/row sc.

**Gauge:** 19 sts and 14 rows/rnds =  $10 \times 10$  cm in patt on size 3.5 mm crochet hook.

First leg: Ch 38 (42). Working back and forth in rows, work in patt and shape leg as foll: Inc 1 st at each end of every other row 3 times (every 3rd row twice, then every other row once) = 44 (48) sts. Work even until piece meas 6 (7) cm from beg. Fasten off. Put aside. Work 2nd leg same as first leg. Next row/rnd: Work in patt across sts of 2nd leg, work in patt across sts of first leg. Join for working in rnds. Beg of rnd is at center back. Next rnd: Work in patt and dc3tog or sc3tog keeping in patt center 3 sts at center of front and back = 84 (92) sts. Mark center of each leg at outer edge. Work even in patt for 4 (5) rnds. Next dec rnd: Dc3tog or sc3tog keeping in patt at each marker = 80 (88) sts. Work even until piece meas 20 (22) cm from beg. Divide for back and front. Beg working in rows. Back: Work 1 row even. Shape armholes: Leave 3 sts unworked at each end of next row, then leave 2 sts unworked at each end of every other row twice. Dec 1 st at each end of every other row twice = 22 (26) sts. Work even until piece meas 27 (30) cm from beg. Shape neck: Leave center 8 (12) sts unworked = 7 sts rem for each strap. Working each side

separately, work even until strap meas 10 cm. Next row: Work first 3 sts, (ch 1, sk 1) for buttonhole, work rem 3 sts. Fasten off. Front: Work same as for back until piece meas 27 (30) cm from beg. Fasten off.

**Pocket:** Ch 15. Work in patt for 6 cm. Work 1 row rev sc [work sc from left to right]. Fasten off. Work 1 row sc along side and bottom edge. Fasten off. **Finishing:** Sew pocket to front as shown in photo. Seam legs. Work 1 rnd sc around neck edge, straps and armhole edges. Sew buttons to front and pocket.
