- = k1
- ▣ = p1
- ▢ = sl 2 sts to cn and hold in front of work, k1, then k2 from cn
- ▣ = sl 1 st to cn and hold in back of work, k2, then k1 from cn
- ▢ = sl 2 sts to cn and hold in front of work, p1, then k2 from cn
- ▣ = sl 1 st to cn and hold in back of work, k2, then p1 from cn
- ▢ = sl 2 sts to cn and hold in front of work, k2, then k2 from cn
- ▣ = sl 2 sts to cn and hold in back of work, k2, then k2 from cn

DESIGN 18



BABY SOFT BATHROBE

Size 74/80 (86/92, 98/104)

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

Materials: 250 (250, 300) g of Lana Grossa **Baby Soft** (60% polyamide, 40% cotton; 150 m/50 g) in Light Green (**col 20**) and 50 g in White (**col 1**). Size 4 mm needles; size 4 mm circular needles, 40 and 80 cm long;

size 3.5 mm crochet hook.

Garter st: K every row.

Gauge: 19 sts and 40 rows = 10 x 10 cm in garter st on size 4 mm needles.

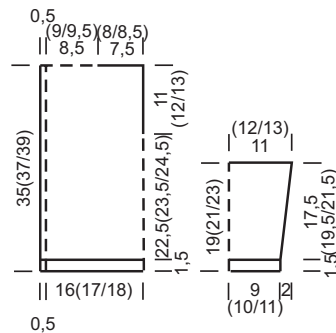
Fronts and back: Worked in one piece to underarm. With size longer 4 mm circular needle and White cast on 128 (136, 144) sts. Mark center 62 (66, 70) sts for back. Beg with a WS row work in garter st for 1.5 cm. Change to Light Green and cont in garter st until piece meas 24 (25, 26) cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Divide for fronts and back: K33 (35, 37) right front sts, place rem 62 (66, 70) back sts and 33 (35, 37) left front sts on separate holders. Turn and work **right front** first as foll: Work even in garter st for 11 (12, 13) cm. Bind off 15 (16, 17) sts at shoulder edge. Place rem 18 (19, 20) sts on a holder. Return 62 (66, 70) held **back** sts to needle and with RS facing rejoin yarn. Work even in garter st for 11 (12, 13) cm. Bind off 15 (16, 17) sts at each shoulder edge. Place rem 32 (34, 36) sts on holder. Return 33 (35, 37) held **left front** sts to needle and with RS facing rejoin yarn. Complete as for right front.

Sleeves: With size 4 mm needles and White cast on 36 (40, 44) sts. Beg with a WS row work in garter st for 1.5 cm. Change to Light Green, cont in garter st and shape sleeve as foll: Inc 1 st at beg and end of 15th (17th, 19th) row worked with Light Green, then every 14th row 3 times (then every 16th row 3 times / then every 18th row twice, then every 16th row

once) = 44 (48, 52) sts. Work even until piece meas 19 (21, 23) cm from cast-on. Bind off all sts.

Belt: With size 4 mm needles and Light Green cast on 6 sts. Work in garter st for 130 cm. Bind off all sts.

Finishing: Sew shoulder seams. **Hood:** Return 18 (19, 20) held right front sts, 32 (34, 36) sts held back sts and 18 (19, 20) held left front sts from holders to shorter size 4 mm circular needle = 68 (72, 76) sts. With Light Green work in garter st for 18.5 (20.5, 22.5) cm, ending with a WS row. Place first 23 (25, 27) sts and last 23 (25, 27) sts on separate holders. * Cont in garter st across center 22 sts and at end of every RS row skp last center st and first st on holder and at end of every WS row k2tog last center st and first st on holder. Rep from * until 22 sts rem. Bind off all sts. With longer size 4 mm circular needle and White pick up and knit 228 (244, 260) sts along right front edge, front edge of hood and left front edge. Work in garter st for 1.5 cm. Bind off all sts. **Belt loops:** With crochet hook attach Light Green to left side edge, 18 (19, 20) cm up from lower edge. Make a 3 cm chain, reattach to side edge. Repeat at right side edge. Sew on sleeves. Sew sleeve seams.



DESIGN 19



BABY SOFT & ELASTICO SMALL DUCK

Size Approx. 18 cm tall

Materials: 50 g of Lana Grossa **Baby Soft** (60% polyamide, 40% cotton; 150 m/50 g) in White (**col 1**) and 50 g of Lana Grossa **Elastico** (96% cotton, 4% polyester; 160 m/50 g) in Apricot (**col 126**) and small amount of Black (**col 24**) and Greige (**col 103**). Size 3 mm crochet hook; fiber fill.

Note: Yarn amounts for both ducks are 100 g in White, 50 g in Apricot and small amounts in Black and Greige.

Gauge: 22 sc and 17 rnds = 10 x 10 cm using Baby Soft and size 3 mm crochet hook.

Note: Work sc in rnds in a continuous spiral without working a sl st at end of rnd.

Head: With size 3 mm crochet hook and White ch4, sl st to first ch to form ring. **Rnd 1:** Ch1, 6 sc into ring = 6 sc. **Rnd 2:** 2 sc in each sc around = 12 sc. **Rnd 3:** [1 sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6 times = 18 sc. **Rnd 4:** [1 sc in each of next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6 times = 24 sc. **Rnd 5:** [1 sc in each of next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6 times = 30 sc. **Rnd 6:** [1 sc in each of next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6 times = 36 sc. **Rnd 7:** [1 sc in each of next 5 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6 times = 42 sc. **Rnd 8:** [1 sc in each of next 6 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6 times = 48 sc.

Rnd 9: [1 sc in each of next 7 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6 times = 54 sc. **Rnd 10:** [1 sc in each of next 8 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6 times = 60 sc. **Rnds 11 – 13:** 1 sc in each sc around. Stuff head with fiber fill. **Rnd 14:** [1 sc in each of next 8 sc, sc2tog] 6 times = 54 sc. **Rnd 15:** [1 sc in each of next 7 sc, sc2tog] 6 times = 48 sc. **Rnd 16:** [1 sc in each of next 6 sc, sc2tog] 6 times = 42 sc. **Rnd 17:** [1 sc in each of next 5 sc, sc2tog] 6 times = 36 sc. **Rnd 18:** [1 sc in each of next 4 sc, sc2tog] 6 times = 30 sc. **Rnd 19:** [1 sc in each of next 3 sc, sc2tog] 6 times = 24 sc. **Rnd 20:** [1 sc in each of next 2 sc, sc2tog] 6 times = 18 sc. Add more fiber fill. **Rnd 21:** [1 sc in next sc, sc2tog] 6 times = 12 sc. Add more fiber fill. **Rnd 22:** Sc2tog around = 6 sc. Cut yarn and fasten off. Draw yarn end through remaining sts.

Body: With size 3 mm crochet hook and White ch4, sl st to first ch to form ring. **Rnd 1:** Ch1, 6 sc into ring = 6 sc. **Rnd 2:** 2 sc in each sc around = 12 sc. **Rnd 3:** [1 sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6 times = 18 sc. **Rnd 4:** [1 sc in each of next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6 times = 24 sc. **Rnd 5:** [1 sc in each of next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6 times = 30 sc. **Rnd 6:** [1 sc in each of next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6 times = 36 sc. **Rnd 7:** [1 sc in each of next 5 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6 times = 42 sc. **Rnd 8:** [1 sc in each of next 6 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6 times = 48 sc. **Rnd 9:** [1 sc in each of next 7 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6 times = 54 sc. **Rnds 10 + 11:** 1 sc in each sc around. Stuff with fiber fill. **Rnd 12:** [1 sc in each of next 7 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6 times = 48 sc. **Rnd 13:** [1 sc in each of next 6 sc, sc2tog] 6 times = 42 sc. **Rnd**
