Wings: Make 2 like. With size 3 mm crochet hook and White ch2, sl st to first ch to form ring. Rnd 1: Ch1, 3 sc into ring $=3 \mathrm{sc}$. Rnd 2: 2 sc in each sc around $=6 \mathrm{sc}$. Rnd 3: [1 sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc] 3 times = 9 sc . Rnd 4: 1 sc in each sc around. Rnd 5: [1 sc in each of next $2 \mathrm{sc}, 2$ sc in next sc] 3 times $=12 \mathrm{sc}$. Rnd 6: 1 sc in each sc around. Rnd 7: [1 sc in each of next $3 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc$] 3$ times $=15 \mathrm{sc}$. Rnds $8-12$ : 1 sc in each sc around. Stuff with fiber fill. Rnd 13: [1 sc in each of next 3 $\mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{sc} 2 \mathrm{tog}] 3$ times $=12 \mathrm{sc}$. Cut yarn and fasten off. Add more fiber fill.
Feet: Make 2 alike. With size 3 mm crochet hook and Apricot ch3. Row

1: 1 sc in each ch. Row 2: 1 sc in each sc. ${ }^{*}$ Row 3: 2 sc in first sc, 1 sc in each sc to last sc, 2 sc in last sc . Row 4: 1 sc in each sc. * Rep between *'s until there are 13 sc . Next, work 1 rnd sc around entire edge, working 3 sc in each corner st. SI st to first sc on last rnd. Cut yarn and fasten off. Beak: With size 3 mm crochet hook and Apricot ch7. Row 1: 1 sc in each ch. Rows $2+3$ : 1 sc in each sc. ${ }^{*}$ Row 4: 2 sc in first $\mathrm{sc}, 1$ sc in each sc to last sc, 2 sc in last sc. Row 5: 1 sc in each sc.* Rep between *'s once more $=11 \mathrm{sc}$. Next 2 rows: 1 sc in each sc. Next, work 1 rnd sc around entire edge, working 3 sc in each corner st. SI st to first sc on last rnd. Cut yarn and fasten off.
Eyes: Make 2 alike. With size 3 mm crochet hook and Black, make a magic ring, 10 sc into ring, sl st to first sc. Cut yarn and fasten off.
Finishing: Sew on head, wings, feet, beak and eyes. Thread a blunt yarn needle with Greige. Embroider center of each eye with a straight st. Using photo as guide, attach 7 fringe in White along top of head.


BABY SOFT \& ELASTICO LARGE DUCK Size Approx. 20 cm tall
Materials: $\mathbf{5 0} \mathbf{g}$ of Lana Grossa Baby Soft ( $60 \%$ polyamide, $40 \%$ cotton; $150 \mathrm{~m} / 50 \mathrm{~g}$ ) in White (col 1) and $\mathbf{5 0} \mathbf{g}$ of Lana Grossa Elastico ( $96 \%$ cotton, $4 \%$ polyester; $160 \mathrm{~m} / 50$ g) in Apricot (col 126) and small amount of Black (col 24) and Greige (col 103). Size 3 mm crochet hook; fiber fill.
Gauge: 22 sc and $17 \mathrm{rnds}=10 \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}$ using Baby Soft and size 3 mm crochet hook.
Note: Work sc in rnds in a continuous spiral without working a sl st at end of $r n d$.
Head: With size 3 mm crochet hook and White ch4, sl st to first ch to form ring. Rnd 1: Ch1, 6 sc into ring $=6 \mathrm{sc}$. Rnd 2: 2 sc in each sc around $=12 \mathrm{sc}$. Rnd 3: [ 1 sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6 times $=18 \mathrm{sc}$. Rnd 4: [ 1 sc in each of next $2 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc] 6 times $=24 \mathrm{sc}$. Rnd 5: $[1 \mathrm{sc}$ in each of next $3 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc$] 6$ times $=30 \mathrm{sc}$. Rnd 6: $[1 \mathrm{sc}$ in each of next $4 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc] 6 times $=36 \mathrm{sc}$. Rnd 11: [ 1 sc in each of next $9 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc] 6 times = 66 sc. Rnds 12-16: 1 sc in each sc around. Stuff head with fiber fill. Rnd 17: [1 sc in each of next $9 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{sc} 2 \mathrm{tog}] 6$ times $=60 \mathrm{sc}$. Rnd 18: [ 1 sc in each of next $8 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{sc} 2 \mathrm{tog}] 6$ times $=54 \mathrm{sc}$. Rnd 19: [1 sc in each of next 7 sc , sc2tog] 6 times $=48 \mathrm{sc}$. Rnd 20: [1 sc in each of next $6 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{sc} 2 \mathrm{tog}$ ] 6 times $=42 \mathrm{sc}$. Rnd 21: [1 sc in each of next $5 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{sc} 2 \mathrm{tog}$ ] 6 times $=36 \mathrm{sc}$. Rnd 22: [ 1 sc in each of next $4 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{sc} 2 \mathrm{tog}] 6$ times $=30$ sc. Rnd 23: [ 1 sc in each of next $3 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{sc} 2 \mathrm{tog}$ ] 6 times $=24 \mathrm{sc}$. Rnd 24: [ 1 sc in each of next $2 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{sc} 2$ tog] 6 times $=18 \mathrm{sc}$. Add more fiber fill. Rnd 25: [ 1 sc in next sc, sc2tog] 6 times $=12 \mathrm{sc}$. Add more fiber fill. Rnd 26: Sc2tog around $=6$ sc. Cut yarn and fasten off. Draw yarn end through remaining sts.
Body: With size 3 mm crochet hook and White ch4, sl st to first ch to form ring. Rnd 1: Ch1, 6 sc into ring $=6 \mathrm{sc}$. Rnd 2: 2 sc in each sc around $=12 \mathrm{sc}$. Rnd 3: $[1 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6 times $=18 \mathrm{sc}$. Rnd 4: [ 1 sc in each of next $2 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc$] 6$ times $=24 \mathrm{sc}$. Rnd 5: [1 sc in each of next $3 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc] 6 times $=30 \mathrm{sc}$. Rnd 6: [1 sc in
each of next $4 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc$] 6$ times $=36 \mathrm{sc}$. Rnd 7: $[1 \mathrm{sc}$ in each of next $5 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc] 6 times $=42 \mathrm{sc}$. Rnd 8: $[1 \mathrm{sc}$ in each of next $6 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc$] 6$ times $=48 \mathrm{sc}$. Rnds $11-17: 1 \mathrm{sc}$ in each sc around. Stuff with fiber fill. Rnd 18: [1 sc in each of next 8 sc , sc2tog] 6 times $=54 \mathrm{sc}$. Rnd 19: [1 sc in each of next $7 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{sc} 2 \mathrm{tog}] 6$ times $=48 \mathrm{sc}$. Rnd 20: [1 sc in each of next $6 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{sc} 2 \mathrm{tog}] 6$ times $=42 \mathrm{sc}$. Rnd 21: [1 sc in each of next $5 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{sc} 2 \mathrm{tog}$ ] 6 times $=36 \mathrm{sc}$. Rnd 3: [ 1 sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc] 3 times $=$ 9 sc . Rnd 4: 1 sc in each sc around. Rnd 5: [1 sc in each of next $2 \mathrm{sc}, 2$ sc in next sc] 3 times $=12 \mathrm{sc}$. Rnd 6: 1 sc in each sc around. Rnd 7: [1 sc in each of next $3 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc] 3 times $=15 \mathrm{sc}$. Rnds 8 - 12: 1 sc in each sc around. Stuff with fiber fill. Rnd 13: [1 sc in each of next 3 sc, sc2tog] 3 times $=12 \mathrm{sc}$. Cut yarn and fasten off. Add more fiber fill.
Feet: Make 2 alike. With size 3 mm crochet hook and Apricot ch3. Row 1: 1 sc in each ch. Row 2: 1 sc in each sc. ${ }^{*}$ Row $3: 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in first sc, 1 sc in each sc to last sc, 2 sc in last sc. Row 4: 1 sc in each sc. * Rep between *'s until there are 13 sc . Next, work 1 rnd sc around entire edge, working 3 sc in each corner st. SI st to first sc on last rnd. Cut yarn and fasten off. Beak: With size 3 mm crochet hook and Apricot ch7. Row 1: 1 sc in each ch. Rows 2 + 3: 1 sc in each sc. * Row 4: 2 sc in first sc, 1 sc in each sc to last sc, 2 sc in last sc . Row 5 : 1 sc in each sc.* Rep between *'s once more $=11 \mathrm{sc}$. Next 2 rows: 1 sc in each sc. Next, work 1 rnd sc around entire edge, working 3 sc in each corner st. SI st to first sc on last rnd. Cut yarn and fasten off.
Eyes: Make 2 alike. With size 3 mm crochet hook and Black, make a magic ring, 10 sc into ring, sl st to first sc. Cut yarn and fasten off.
Finishing: Sew on head, wings, feet, beak and eyes. Thread a blunt yarn needle with Greige. Embroider center of each eye with a straight st. Using photo as guide, attach 7 fringe in White along top of head.

## Stockinette: K on RS, p on WS.

Gauges: On size 3.5 mm needles, 17 sts and 32 rows $=10 \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}$ in garter st; 19 sts and 31 rows $=10 \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}$ in stockinette; 20 sts and 32 rows $=10 \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}$ in overall patt.
Fronts and back: Worked in one piece to underarm. With size 3.5 mm needles and White cast on $114(125,136)$ sts. Next WS row: Purl. Next

RS row: Work 6 sts in garter st for right front band, [3 sts in stockinette, $6(7,8)$ sts in garter st] 11 times, 3 sts in stockinette, remaining 6 sts in garter st for left front band. Mark center $54(59,66)$ sts for back. Cont in patt as established for another 9 rows. Next RS [dec] row: Dec 1 st in each garter st section, except front bands. Rep dec row every 12th row $1(3,3)$ time(s), then every 10 th row $2(0,0)$ times $=20(23,25)$ sts for each front, $30(35,42)$ sts for back and $70(81,92)$ sts total. At same time, work first buttonhole when piece measures $12(13,14) \mathrm{cm}$ from cast-on as foll: Next RS row: K2, k2tog, yo, work to end. Work 3 more buttonholes spaced $3(3.5,4) \mathrm{cm}$ apart. Note that last 2 buttonholes are worked while working yoke. Work even in patt until piece measures 17.5 $(18.5,19.5) \mathrm{cm}$ from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Place sts on holder. Sleeves: With size 3.5 mm needles and White cast on $33(35,37)$ sts. Next WS row: Purl. Next RS row: Selvage st, 2 sts in stockinette, * 2 sts in garter st, 3 sts in stockinette; rep from * to last 5 sts, 2 sts in garter st, 2 sts in stockinette, selvage st (selvage st, * 3 sts in garter st, 3 sts in stockinette; rep from * to last 4 sts, 3 sts in garter st, selvage st / sel-
vage st, 2 sts in garter st, * 3 sts in stockinette, 4 sts in garter st; rep from * to last 6 sts, 3 sts in stockinette, 2 sts in garter st, selvage st). Cont in patt as established and shape sleeve as foll: Inc 1 st at beg and end of every 12th row twice, then every 10th row once (every 10th row 4 times / every 10th row 4 times, then every 8th row once) $=39(43,47)$ sts. Work increased sts into patt. Work even until sleeve measures $14(16,18) \mathrm{cm}$ from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Bind off 1 st at beg of next 2 rows. Place remaining $37(41,45)$ sts on holder.
Yoke: With size 3.5 mm circular needle and from RS work all sts on holders in patt as established: $20(23,25)$ right front sts, $37(41,45)$ sleeve sts, $30(35,42)$ back sts, $37(41,45)$ sleeve sts, $20(23,25)$ left front sts = 144 $(163,182)$ sts. Cont in patt as established for another $3(5,7)$ rows. Next RS [dec] row: Dec 19 sts evenly across sts between front bands = 125 $(144,163)$ sts. Next 3 rows: Work even in garter st across all sts. Cont in garter st and work decs as foll: Next RS [dec] row: Dec $10(12,14)$ sts evenly across sts between front bands. Rep last dec row every other RS row $1(2,3)$ time(s), then every foll RS row $5(4,3)$ times $=55(61,65)$ sts At same time, remember to work remaining 2 buttonholes. Work 1 WS row. Shape neck: Bind off 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows $=45(50,55)$ sts. Shape collar with short-rows: Short-row 1 [RS]: Knit to last 5 sts, turn. Short-row 2 [WS]: Yo, knit to last 5 sts, turn. Short-row 3 [RS]: Yo, knit to

5 sts before yo, turn. Short-row 4 [WS]: Yo, knit to 5 sts before yo, turn. Rep short-rows 3 and 4 once more. Next RS row: Yo, knit to end of row and ktog each yo with next st. Next WS row: Knit to end of row and ktog each yo with next st. Next RS row: K3, purl to last 3 sts, k3. Next WS row: Knit all sts. Rep last 2 rows until collar measures 5.5 cm . Work in garter st across all sts until collar measures 7 cm . Bind off all sts. With Dark Grey, embroider outside of collar with 1 row stem st along garter st section. Fold collar to outside. Sew sleeve seams. With Dark Grey, embroider first row of yoke worked entirely in garter st with stem st. Sew on buttons.

Rib pattern: K1, p1
Garter st: K every row.
Stockinette: K on RS, p on WS.
Stockinette in rnds: K every rnd.
Gauge: 19 sts and 31 rows $/ \mathrm{rnds}=10 \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}$ in stockinette on size 3.5 mm needles.
First leg: With size 3.5 mm needles and White cast on $32(36,40)$ sts. Beg and end with a WS row work in garter st for 2.5 cm . Work in stockinette and shape leg as foll: Inc 1 st at beg and end of 9th row, then every 10th row $1(2,3)$ time(s), then every 8th row once $=38(44,50)$ sts. For size $56 / 62$ only: Cast on 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows, 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows = 48 sts. For size 68/74 only: Inc 1 st at beg and end of every other RS row once, then every foll RS row once, then cast on 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows $=52$ sts. For size 80/86 only: Cast on 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows $=56$ sts. For all sizes: Work even until piece measures $13(15,17) \mathrm{cm}$ from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Cut yarn. Put aside. With size 3.5 mm circular needle work 2nd leg same as first leg, ending with a WS row. Do not cut yarn Next RS row: $\mathrm{K} 48(52,56)$, then $\mathrm{K} 48(52,56)$ across first leg $=96(104,112)$
sts. Join for working in rnds and work stockinette in rnds for $7(9,11) \mathrm{cm}$. Mark center of each leg at outer edge. Shape back with short-rows: K to one of the markers, turn. Next WS row: Yo, p48 $(52,56)$ to marker, turn. Next RS row: Yo, k to 3 sts before yo, turn. Next WS row: Yo, p to 3 sts before yo, turn. Rep last 2 rows twice more. Next RS row/rnd 1: Yo, * k to next yo, ktog yo and next st; rep from * 3 more times, ** k to 1 st before next yo, skp next st and yo; rep from ** 3 more times. Cont in rnds. Work rib patt in rnds until piece meas $22.5(26.5,30.5) \mathrm{cm}$ from leg cast-on, measured along front of pants. Eyelet rnd: * K2tog, yo; rep from * around. Cont in rib patt for 2.5 cm more. Bind off all sts.
Finishing: With Dark Grey embroider 3rd to last row worked in rib patt at bottom of legs with stem st. Seam legs. With size 3 mm crochet hook and Dark Grey crochet a $58(62,66)$ cm long chain. Thread chain through eyelet rnd, then crochet 1 flower at each end of chain as foll: Rnd 1: 5 sc in last ch, 5 sc in first ch, sl st in first sc. Rnd 2: Ch 1, [ch 3, 1 sc in next st] 5 times, sl st in first ch. Cut yarn and fasten off. Embroider center of each flower with 1 satin st in White.
