

BABY SOFT PANTS Size 62/68 (74/80, 86/92)

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in

parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes. **Materials: 50 (50, 100) g** of Lana Grossa

Baby Soft (60% polyamide, 40% cotton; 150 m/50 g) in Light Green **(col 20)**. Size 4 mm needles; size 4 mm circular needle, 40 cm long.


Rib pattern: K1, p1.

Stockinette in rnds: K every rnd.

Gauge: 18.5 sts and 37 rnds/rows = 10 x 10 cm in stockinette on size 4 mm needles.

First leg: With size 4 mm needles cast on 40 (44, 48) sts. Work in rib patt for 1 cm, ending with a WS row. Cut yarn. Put aside. With size 4 mm circular needle work **2nd leg** same as first leg, ending with a WS row. Do not cut yarn. Next RS row: K40 (44, 48), place marker [pm], cast on 8 sts

for gusset, pm, k40 (44, 48) across first leg, pm, cast on 8 sts for gusset, pm = 96 (104, 112) sts. Join for working in rnds. Work stockinette in rnds and work gusset dec as foll: Next rnd: Knit. Next dec rnd: * K to 1 st before marker, k2tog; rep from * once more. Rep last 2 rnds until all gusset sts have been decreased and 80 (88, 96) sts remain. Remove gusset markers. Mark center of each leg at outer edge. Work even for 19 (23, 27) rnds. Next dec rnd: Dec 1 st at each marker = 78 (86, 94) sts. Work even until piece meas 14 (16, 18) cm from leg cast-on. Work rib patt in rnds for 3 cm. Bind off all sts in rib. **Finishing:** Seam legs.

ORGANICO BLANKET

Size 90 x 106 cm Materials: 350 g of Lana Grossa Organico (100% cotton; 90 m/50 g) in Light Rosewood (col 46) and 100 g in Ecru (col 6). Size 5 mm needles; size 4 mm crochet hook. St st: K on RS, p on WS. K every rnd. Lace patt: Multiple of 10 + 4 + 2 selvage sts. Work according to chart. Numbers at right

edge of chart indicate RS rows; on WS rows,

p all sts and yos. Beg with sts before patt rep, work 10-st patt rep between arrows 11 times, end with selvage st after patt rep. Rep rows 1 – 12. **Main patt:** Work [10 rows in St st, 12 rows in lace patt, 10 rows in St st] 6 times = 192 rows.

Crochet border: Multiple of 20. Work according to chart. SI st at top right corner of bound-off edge to join. Work [20-st patt rep 5 times, 14 sts to corner, work next patt rep 6 times, 14 sts to corner] twice. Work rnds 1 - 9 once. Sts that meet at the bottom are all worked in one st. Sts that meet at the top show the number of sts to be decreased.


Gauge: 17 sts and 23 rows = 10×10 cm in main patt on size 5 mm needles. **Instructions:** With size 5 mm needles and Light Rosewood cast on 116 sts. Work the 192 rows of main patt. Bind off. Finishing: Pin piece to measurements and block. Work crochet border around entire edge of blanket. Work rnd 1 with Light Rosewood, rem rnds with Ecru.
