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WRAP · GOMITOLO SILKHAIR & SILKHAIR LUSO

Design 02 from Filati Tücher & Co. 02

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Approx. 45 cm wide x 195 cm long

Materials: 100 g of Lana Grossa **Gomitolo Silkhair** (65% superkid mohair, 30% silk, 5% pure wool; 800 m/100 g) in Pink/Beige Mélange (**col 201**) and 25 g of Lana Grossa **Silkhair Lusso** (78% superkid mohair, 14% silk, 4% polyester, 4% polyamide; 210 m/25 g) in Antique Pink (**col 902**). Size 4 and 4.5 mm circular needles.

Gartr st: K every row.

St st: K on RS, p on WS.

Short rows with 'double st' [dbl st]:

Turn work after having worked the number of sts indicated in pattern. Sl 1 st as if to purl with yarn in front of work, bring yarn to back of work over top of the needle and pull it very tightly; this will rotate the st to the back of the needle so that both 'legs' of the st from the row below are now on the needle. On foll rows, work to dbl st [= 2 loops on needle], insert right needle into both loops and k as you would normally.

K1f&b: K into front and back of same st = 1 st increased.

Ruffle: Worked 5 times. With size 4 mm circular needle and Silkhair Lusso cast on 81 sts. K 1 WS row, then work 13 rows in St st. Next WS row: K3tog across row = 27 sts. Leave sts on needle; cut yarn.

Gauges: 15 sts and 32 rows = 10 x 10 cm in gartr st with Gomitolo Silkhair and size 4.5 mm needles; 18 sts and 26 rows = 10 x 10 cm in St st with Silkhair Lusso and size 4 mm needles.

Instructions: Section 1: With size 4.5 mm circular needle and Gomitolo Silkhair cast on 81 sts. Beg and end with a WS row work in gartr st for 7 rows. Next RS row: * K to last 2 sts, turn, work dbl st, k to end of WS row. Rep from * until 3 sts remain. Next RS row: * K5, M1R; rep from *, end k1 = 97 sts. Work dbl sts as instructed as you come to them.

Section 2: Next WS row: K97. Next RS row: K1f&b, k to last 2 sts, k2tog = 97 sts. Next WS row: K97. Rep last 2 rows until section 2 meas approx. 10 cm. Next RS row [attach first ruffle]: K8; with ruffle sts on size 4 mm circular needle held parallel and in front of work, k first st of each needle tog, k to end of row. Next WS row: K97. Next RS [eyelet] row: K1, * yo, k2tog; rep from * to end of row. Next WS row: K all sts and yos. Next RS row: K1f&b, k to last 2 sts, k2tog = 97 sts. Next WS row: K97. Rep last 2 rows until piece meas approx. 10 cm from eyelet row, ending with a WS row. Next RS row [attach 2nd ruffle]: K50; with ruffle sts on size 4 mm circular needle held parallel and in front of work, k first st of each needle tog, k to end of row. Next WS row: K97. Next RS [eyelet] row: K1, * yo, k2tog; rep from * to end of row. Next WS row: K all sts and yos. Next RS row: K1f&b, k to last 2 sts, k2tog = 97 sts. Next WS row: K97. Rep last 2 rows until piece meas approx. 10 cm from last eyelet row, ending with a WS row. Next RS row [attach 3rd ruffle]: K22; with ruffle sts on size 4 mm circular needle held parallel and in front of work, k first st of each needle tog, k to end of row. Next WS row: K97. Next RS [eyelet] row: K1, * yo, k2tog; rep from * to end of row. Next WS row: K all sts and yos. Next RS row: K1f&b, k to last 2 sts,

k2tog = 97 sts. Next WS row: K97. Rep last 2 rows until piece meas approx. 10 cm from last eyelet row, ending with a WS row. Next RS row [attach 4th ruffle]: K55; with ruffle sts on size 4 mm circular needle held parallel and in front of work, k first st of each needle tog, k to end of row. Next WS row: K97. Next RS [eyelet] row: K1, * yo, k2tog; rep from * to end of row. Next WS row: K all sts and yos. Next RS row: K1f&b, k to last 2 sts, k2tog = 97 sts. Next WS row: K97. Rep last 2 rows until piece meas approx. 10 cm from last eyelet row, ending with a WS row. Next RS row [attach 5th ruffle]: K30; with ruffle sts on size 4 mm circular needle held parallel and in front of work, k first st of each needle tog, k to end of row. Next WS row: K97. Next RS [eyelet] row: K1, * yo, k2tog; rep from * to end of row. Next WS row: K all sts and yos. Next RS row: K1f&b, k to last 2 sts, k2tog = 97 sts. Next WS row: K97. Rep last 2 rows until piece meas approx. 195 cm from cast-on, measured along right side edge, ending with a WS row. Next RS row: * K4, k2tog; rep from *, end k1 = 81 sts.

Section 3: Next WS row: K3, * turn, work dbl st, k to end of RS row. Next WS row: Work to dbl st, k both loops of dbl st tog, k2; rep from * until all sts are in work. Work even in gartr st for 7 rows, then bind off all sts.

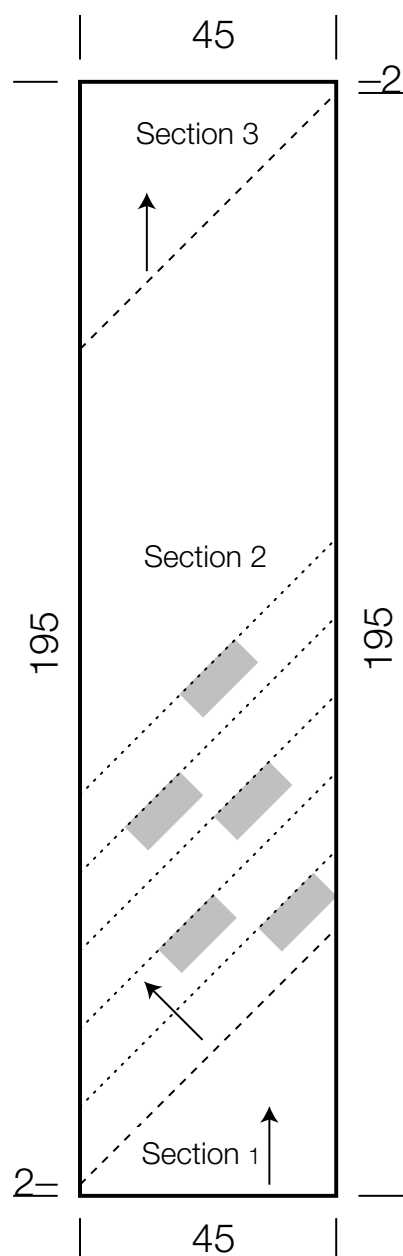
Finishing: Pin piece to measurements and block. Carefully weave in all ends.

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Gauge Swatch

Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.
