Design 1 – Wide Colorblock Scarf



You'll need **200 g** each of Lana Grossa **Shades of Alpaca Silk** (45% pure wool, 35% baby alpaca, 20% silk; 680 m/200 g) in Bordeaux/ Mint/Khaki/Cyclamen (**col 311**) and Pale Pink/Light Turquoise/Light Grey/ Grey-Green (**col 312**). Size 4 mm needles; size 3 mm crochet hook.

Size: 43 cm wide x 205 cm long **Gauge:** 22 sts and 32 rows = 10 x 10 cm

in St st on size 4 mm needles.

St st: K on RS, p on WS.

Rev St st: P on RS, k on WS.

Seed stitch: Row 1: K1, p1. On all foll rows, purl the knit sts and knit the purl sts. **Colorblock and stripe sequence:**

* Pull yarn from outside of col 312, work to end of color repeat, then work 2 rows with Cyclamen;

pull yarn from center of col 311, work to end of color repeat, then work 2 rows with Cyclamen;

pull yarn from center of col 312, work to end of color repeat, then work 2 rows with Cyclamen;

pull yarn from outside of col 311, work to end of color repeat, then work 2 rows with Cyclamen. Rep from * until both balls are used up.

Instructions: Pulling yarn from outside of col 311, unwind first 2 color repeats and put aside for working 2-row horizontal stripes and crocheted vertical stripes later. Pulling yarn from outside of col 312 (= grey-green), cast on 98 sts. Beg and end with a WS row, work seed st for 3 rows. Next RS row: Work seed st over 3 sts, work St st over 3 sts, work [rev St st over next st, St st over next 16 sts] 5 times, work rev St st over next st, work St st over next 3 sts, work seed st to end. Cont in patt as established to end of grey-green color repeat. Break yarn. Using cyclamen put aside earlier, work in patt as established for 2 rows. Break yarn. Pulling yarn from center of col 311 (= bordeaux), cont in patt to end of bordeaux color repeat. Break yarn. Using cyclamen put aside earlier, work in patt as established for 2 rows. Cont in patt and colorblock and stripe sequence until both balls are used up, ending with 3 rows seed st across all sts. Bind off all sts.

Finishing: Using cyclamen put aside earlier, work a row of sc over each rev St st section. Work 1 sc in every other row, taking care not to pucker the fabric.

Tip: If you find that the fabric puckers, you might want to work rows of chain sl st in place of sc.

Finishing: Carefully weave in all ends. Pin piece to measurements and block.
