

# Design 7 – Easy Crochet Shawl



You'll need **200 g** of Lana Grossa **Shades of Alpaca Silk** (45% pure wool, 35% baby alpaca, 20% silk; 680 m/200 g) in Pale Yellow/Rose/Light Grey/Sand (**col 309**). Size 5 mm crochet hook.

**Size:** 120 cm along right side edge, 88 cm wide

**Gauge:** 16 dc and 9.5 rows = 10 x 10 cm with size 5 mm hook.

**Crochet patt:** Work according to chart. Numbers at right edge of chart indicate RS rows, numbers at left edge of chart indicate WS rows. Work increases at left edge as shown on chart.

**Instructions:** Shawl is worked from the point up. Increases are worked at end of RS rows and at beginning of WS rows. Pulling yarn from center of ball (= pale yellow), make a 6 cm tassel. Pulling yarn from outside of ball (= sand), make two more 6 cm tassels. Pulling yarn from center of ball (= pale yellow), make an adjustable ring, ch 3, 3 dc into ring. Work crochet patt according to chart as foll: **Row 1:** Ch 3 (count as dc), dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc, 2 trc in top turning-ch = 6 sts.

**Row 2:** Ch 5 (count as trc), 2 trc in next st, dc in each of next 4 sts, dc in top turning-ch = 8 sts. **Row 3:** Ch 3 (count as dc), dc in each of next 5 sts, 2 dc in next st, 2 trc in top turning-ch = 10 sts.

**Row 4:** Ch 5 (count as trc), 2trc in next st, dc in each of next 8 sts, dc in top turning-ch = 12 sts. **Row 5:** Ch 3 (count as dc), dc in each of next 9 sts, 2 dc in next st, 2 trc in top turning-ch = 14 sts.

**Row 6:** Ch 5 (count as trc), 2 trc in next st, dc in each of next 12 sts, dc in top turning-ch = 16 sts. As of row 7, only 1 st is increased every row. Cont to foll chart through row 12, then rep rows 9 – 12, working in-

creases as established, until yarn is used up. Fasten off.

**Finishing:** Sew on tassels to corners of shawl. Carefully weave in all ends.
