

PULLOVER · SILKHAIR PRINT

Design 22 from Meilenweit 05

Size 36/38 (40/42, 44/46)

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

Materials: 350 (400, 400) g of Lana Grossa Silkhair Print (70% superkid mohair, 30% silk; 400 m/50 g) in Greige/Grey/Charcoal (col 306). Size 7 and 8 mm circular needles; one set size 7 mm double-pointed needles [dpns]; stitch holders.

Note: Work with 4 strands of yarn held tog throughout.

Slip stitch selvage: On every row: K first st tbl, sl last st pwise wyif.

Rib patt: K1, p1.

Half-brioche st in rows: Odd number of sts. Row 1 [RS]: SI st selvage, * p1, make a yo, then sI next st as if to purl; rep from * to last 2 sts, p1, sI st selvage. Row 2 [WS]: SI st selvage, * k1, ptog next st and yo; rep from * to last 2 sts, k1, sI st selvage. Rep rows 1 and 2.

Half-brioche st in rnds: Even number of sts. Rnd 1: * P1, make a yo, then sl next st as if to purl; rep from * around. Rnd 2: * P1, ktog next st and yo; rep from * around. Rep rnds 1 and 2.

Full-fashion dec before a purl st: Make a yo, then sl next st as if to purl, k2tog, pass slipped st over knitted st.

Full-fashion dec after a purl st: K3tog.

Gauge: 10 sts and 19 rows/rnds = 10×10 cm in half-brioche st with size 8 mm needles and 4 strands of yarn held tog.

Back and front: Worked in one piece in the rnd to underarm/yoke. With size 7 mm circular needle and 4 strands of yarn held tog cast on 112 (128, 144) sts. Place beg of rnd marker and join for working in rnds. Place side marker after 56 (64, 72) sts. Work in rib patt until piece meas 6 cm from cast-on.

Change to size 8 mm circular needle. Work in half-brioche st for 80 rnds and piece meas approx. 48 cm from cast-on. Next rnd: Bind off first 4 sts, work to 4 sts before side marker, bind off next 8 sts, removing marker, work to last 4 sts, bind off last 4 sts = 47 (55, 63) sts rem for back, 49 (57, 65) sts rem for front. Place sts on holders.

Sleeves: With size 7 mm circular needle and 4 strands of yarn held tog cast on 29 (31, 33) sts. Work in rib patt until piece meas 6 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Change to size 8 mm circular needle. Work in half-brioche st and shape sleeve as foll: Inc 1 st at each end of every 10th row 3 times, then every 8th row 5 times (every 8th row 9 times / every 8th row 7 times, then every 6th row 3 times) = 45 (49, 53) sts. Work increased sts into patt. Work even until 80 rows have been worked in half-brioche st and piece meas approx. 48 cm from cast-on. Bind off 4 sts at beg of next 2 rows. Place rem 37 (41, 45) sts on holder.


Yoke: With size 8 mm circular needle, work in half-brioche st across 47 (55, 63) held back sts, 37 (41, 45) held sleeve sts, k2tog first 2 sts of 49 (57, 65) held front sts, work in halfbrioche st to last 2 front sts, skp = 47 (55, 63) sts for front, work in half-brioche st across 37 (41, 45) held sleeve sts = 168 (192, 216) sts. Place beg of rnd marker and join for working in rnds. Mark purl st at each edge of each piece. Work half-brioche st in rnds and work full-fashion decs before and after each marked purl st every 4th rnd 8 (9, 10) times = 40 (48, 56) sts. Next rnd: For size 40/42 only: Work first back st, skp, patt to last 3 back sts, k2tog, patt to end of sleeve, work first front st, skp, patt to to last 3 front sts, k2tog, patt to end = 44 sts. For size 44/46 only: Work first back st, skp, patt to last 3 back sts, k2tog, work last back st, work first sleeve st, skp, patt to last 3 sleeve sts, k2tog, work last sleeve st, work first front st, skp, patt to last 3 front sts, k2tog, work last front st, work first sleeve st, skp, patt to last 3 sleeve sts, k2tog, work last sleeve st = 48 sts. For all sizes: With dpns work in rib patt for 6 rnds. Bind off all sts in rib.


Finishing: Sew underarm and sleeve seams.

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


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Gauge Swatch

Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.



Abbreviations

beg = begin(ning) \cdot **ch** = chain \cdot **cont** = continue \cdot **dec** = decreas(e)(ing) \cdot **inc** = increas(e)(ing) \cdot **k** = knit \cdot **kwise** = as if to knit **meas** = measures \cdot **M1L** = lift strand between sts from front to back and knit this strand through the back loop \cdot **M1R** = lift strand between sts from the back and knit this strand through the front loop \cdot **patt** = pattern \cdot **pm** = place marker \cdot **p** = purl **pwise** = as if to purl \cdot **rem** = remain(ing) \cdot **rep** = repeat(s) \cdot **rev St st** = reverse stockinette stitch \cdot **rnd(s)** = round(s) \cdot **RS** = right side \cdot **sc** = single crochet \cdot **skp** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 1 stitch, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch \cdot **sk2p** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 2 together, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch \cdot **s2kp** = slip 2 stitches as if to knit, k 1 stitch, pass slipped stitches over knitted stitch \cdot **s1** = slip \cdot **st(s)** = stitch(es) \cdot **St st** = stockinette stitch \cdot **tbl** = through the back loop \cdot **tog** = together \cdot **wyib** = with yarn in back of work \cdot **wyif** = with yarn in front of work \cdot **WS** = wrong side \cdot **yo(s)** = yarn over(s)
