# RABBIT WITH OVERALLS • BABY SOFT \& COOL WOOL BABY Design 13 from Filati Infanti 14 



Size approx. 44 cm tall
Materials: $\mathbf{5 0} \mathbf{g}$ each of Lana Grossa Baby Soft (60\% polyamide, $40 \%$ cotton; $150 \mathrm{~m} / 50 \mathrm{~g}$ ) in Beige (col 21 and Ecru (col 2) and $\mathbf{5 0} \mathbf{g}$ each of Lana Grossa Cool Wool Baby ( $100 \%$ pure wool; $220 \mathrm{~m} / 50 \mathrm{~g}$ ) in Pink (col 216) and Charcoal (col 205). Size 3.5 mm needles; one set size 3.5 mm dou-ble-pointed needles [dpns]; size 3 mm crochet hook; tapestry needle; fiber fill.

Garter st: K every row.
St st: K on RS, p on WS; $k$ every rnd.
Single crochet [sc]: Beg each rnd with ch 1. Work in continuous rnds without joining. Place marker to indicate beg of rnds. Move marker up as work progresses.

Stripe patt: Work 1 row/rnd with Ecru, * 2 rows/rnds with Beige, 2 rows/rnds with Ecru; rep from * throughout.

Increase (inc): 2 sc in next st.
Decrease (dec): Sc2tog in next 2 sts.
Gauges: 18 sc and $16 \mathrm{rows} / \mathrm{rnds}=10 \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}$ with size 3 mm hook and; 19 sts and 33 rows $/ \mathrm{rnds}=10 \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}$ in St st with size 3.5 mm needles and Baby Soft.

Head: With size 3 mm hook and Beige make an adjustable ring. Rnd 1: 4 sc into ring. Work sc in continuous rnds without joining. Place marker to indicate beg of rnds. Move marker up as work progresses. Rnd 2: Inc around = 8 sc . Rnd 3: Inc around $=16 \mathrm{sc}$. Rnd 4: [Inc, sc in next sc] 8 times around $=$ 24 sc. Rnd 5: [lnc, sc in each of next 2 sc$] 8$ times around $=$ 32 sc. Rnd 6: [lnc, sc in each of next 3 sc$] 8$ times around $=$ 40 sc . Rnd 7: [Inc, sc in each of next 4 sc$] 8$ times around $=$ 48 sc. Rnds 8 - 12: Sc around. Stuff with fiber fill. Rnd 13: [Dec, sc in each of next 4 sc$] 8$ times around $=40 \mathrm{sc}$. Rnd 14: [Dec, sc in each of next 3 sc$] 8$ times around $=32 \mathrm{sc}$. Rnd 15: [Dec, sc in each of next 2 sc$] 8$ times around $=24 \mathrm{sc}$. Rnd 16: [Dec, sc in next sc] 8 times around $=16 \mathrm{sc}$. Rnd 17: Dec around $=8 \mathrm{sc}$. Stuff with fiber fill. Rnd 18: Dec around $=4 \mathrm{sc}$. Fasten off and cinch tight. Pull tail yarn to cinch ring closed. Carefully weave in all ends.

Body: With size 3 mm hook and Beige make an adjustable ring. Rnd 1: 4 sc into ring. Work sc in continuous rnds without joining. Place marker to indicate beg of rnds. Move marker up as work progresses. Rnd 2: Inc around = 8 sc . Rnd 3: Inc around $=16 \mathrm{sc}$. Rnd 4: [Inc, sc in next sc] 8 times around $=$ 24 sc. Rnd 5: [lnc, sc in each of next 2 sc$] 8$ times around $=$ 32 sc . Rnd 6: [Inc, sc in each of next 3 sc ] 8 times around $=$ 40 sc. Rnds 7-18: Sc around. Stuff with fiber fill. Rnd 19: [Dec, sc in each of next 3 sc ] 8 times around $=32 \mathrm{sc}$. Rnd 20: [Dec, sc in each of next 2 sc$] 8$ times around $=24 \mathrm{sc}$. Rnd 21:


#### Abstract

[Dec, sc in next sc] 8 times around $=16 \mathrm{sc}$. Stuff with fiber fill. Fasten off and cinch tight. Pull tail yarn to cinch ring closed. Carefully weave in all ends.


#### Abstract

Arms: Make 2 alike. With size 3 mm hook and Beige make an adjustable ring. Rnd 1: 4 sc into ring. Work sc in continuous rnds without joining. Place marker to indicate beg of rnds. Move marker up as work progresses. Rnd 2: Inc around $=8$ sc. Rnd 3: Inc around = 16 sc. Rnds 4 and 5: Sc around. Stuff with fiber fill. Rnd 6: [Dec, sc in each of next 2 sc$] 4$ times around $=12$ sc. Rnds 7-21: Sc around. Stuff with fiber fill. Fasten off and cinch tight. Pull tail yarn to cinch ring closed. Carefully weave in all ends.


Legs: Make 2 alike. With size 3 mm hook and Beige make an adjustable ring. Rnd 1: 4 sc into ring. Work sc in continuous rnds without joining. Place marker to indicate beg of rnds. Move marker up as work progresses. Rnd 2: Inc around $=8 \mathrm{sc}$. $\underline{\text { Rnd }}$ 3: Inc around $=16$ sc. Rnd 4: [lnc, sc in next sc] 8 times around $=24 \mathrm{sc}$. Rnds 5-7: Sc around. Stuff with fiber fill. Rnd 8: [Dec, sc in next sc] 8 times around $=16$ sc. Rnds 9-21: Sc around. Stuff with fiber fill. Fasten off and cinch tight. Pull tail yarn to cinch ring closed. Carefully weave in all ends.

Ears: Make 2 alike. With size 3 mm hook and Beige, ch 2. Row 1: Ch 1, 2 sc in 2nd and 3rd ch from hook $=4$ sc. Row 2: Ch 1, inc at beg and end of row $=6 \mathrm{sc}$. Rep row 2 three times more $=12 \mathrm{sc}$. Work 4 rows even. Row 10: Ch 1, dec at beg and end of row $=10 \mathrm{sc}$. Rep row 10 four times more $=2$ sc. Work 1 rnd sc around outer edge. Fasten off.

Finishing: Sew body to head; sew arms and legs to body. Sew ears to head using photo as guide. Using Pink, embroider nose with satin stitch and straight stitch; using Charcoal, embroider eyes with satin stitch.

## Overall

With size 3.5 mm needles and Ecru cast on 22 sts for right leg. Next WS row: Knit. Work in St st and stripe patt until piece meas 3.5 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Leave sts on needle, cut yarn. With size 3.5 mm dpn work left leg same as right leg. Leave sts on dpn, do not cut yarn. Next RS row: K11 across left leg, place first marker, k11 to end of left leg, k11 across right leg, place 2nd marker, k11 to end of right leg, k11 to first marker $=$ beg of rnd marker. Arrange sts evenly on 4 dpns $=11$ sts per needle and join for working in rnds. Work St st in rnds and cont in stripe patt until piece meas 10 cm from leg cast-on ending at side marker. Bind off 22 sts to end of rnd $=22$ sts rem for front. Cont in St st and stripe patt, back and forth in rows, across front sts for 4 cm , ending with 2 rows Ecru. Work in garter st for 2 rows, then bind off all sts.

Finishing: Sew inseams. Straps: Make 2 alike. With size 3 mm hook and Ecru, crochet a 13 cm long chain, then work 1 row sc over the chain. With chains crossed at back, sew chains to top edge of front and back.

## Gauge Swatch

## Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. $12 \mathrm{~cm} \times 12 \mathrm{~cm}$. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm . If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.
