



RABBIT WITH DRESS · BABY SOFT & COOL WOOL BABY

Design 14 from Filati Infanti 14

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Size approx. 38 cm tall

Materials: 50 g each of Lana Grossa Baby Soft (60% polyamide, 40% cotton; 150 m/50 g) in Beige (col 21 and Ecru (col 2) and 50 g each of Lana Grossa Cool Wool Baby (100% pure wool; 220 m/50 g) in Pink (col 216) and Charcoal (col 205). Size 3.5 mm needles; one set size 3.5 mm double-pointed needles [dpns]; size 3 mm crochet hook; tapestry needle; fiber fill; one 12 mm button.

Garter st: K every row.

St st: K on RS, p on WS; k every rnd.

Single crochet [sc]: Beg each rnd with ch 1. Work in continuous rnds without joining. Place marker to indicate beg of rnds. Move marker up as work progresses.

Increase (inc): 2 sc in next st.

Decrease (dec): Sc2tog in next 2 sts.

Gauges: 18 sc and 16 rows/rnds = 10×10 cm with size 3 mm hook and; 19 sts and 33 rows/rnds = 10×10 cm in St st with size 3.5 mm needles and Baby Soft.

Head: With size 3 mm hook and Beige make an adjustable ring. Rnd 1: 4 sc into ring. Work sc in continuous rnds without joining. Place marker to indicate beg of rnds. Move marker up as work progresses. Rnd 2: Inc around = 8 sc. Rnd 3: Inc around = 16 sc. Rnd 4: [Inc, sc in next sc] 8 times around = 24 sc. Rnd 5: [Inc, sc in each of next 2 sc] 8 times around = 32 sc. Rnd 6: [Inc, sc in each of next 3 sc] 8 times around = 40 sc. Rnd 7: [Inc, sc in each of next 4 sc] 8 times around = 48 sc. Rnds 8 - 12: Sc around. Stuff with fiber fill. Rnd 13: [Dec, sc in each of next 4 sc] 8 times around = 40 sc. Rnd 14: [Dec, sc in each of next 3 sc] 8 times around = 32 sc. Rnd 15: [Dec, sc in each of next 2 sc] 8 times around = 24 sc. Rnd 16: [Dec, sc in next sc] 8 times around = 16 sc. Rnd 17: Dec around = 8 sc. Stuff with fiber fill. Rnd 18: Dec around = 4 sc. Fasten off and cinch tight. Pull tail yarn to cinch ring closed. Carefully weave in all ends.

Body: With size 3 mm hook and Beige make an adjustable ring. Rnd 1: 4 sc into ring. Work sc in continuous rnds without joining. Place marker to indicate beg of rnds. Move marker up as work progresses. Rnd 2: Inc around = 8 sc. Rnd 3: Inc around = 16 sc. Rnd 4: [Inc, sc in next sc] 8 times around = 24 sc. Rnd 5: [Inc, sc in each of next 2 sc] 8 times around = 32 sc. Rnd 6: [Inc, sc in each of next 3 sc] 8 times around =

40 sc. Rnds 7 – 18: Sc around. Stuff with fiber fill. Rnd 19: [Dec, sc in each of next 3 sc] 8 times around = 32 sc. Rnd 20: [Dec, sc in each of next 2 sc] 8 times around = 24 sc. Rnd 21: [Dec, sc in next sc] 8 times around = 16 sc. Stuff with fiber fill. Fasten off and cinch tight. Pull tail yarn to cinch ring closed. Carefully weave in all ends.

Arms: Make 2 alike. With size 3 mm hook and Beige make an adjustable ring. Rnd 1: 4 sc into ring. Work sc in continuous rnds without joining. Place marker to indicate beg of rnds. Move marker up as work progresses. Rnd 2: Inc around = 8 sc. Rnd 3: Inc around = 16 sc. Rnds 4 and 5: Sc around. Stuff with fiber fill. Rnd 6: [Dec, sc in each of next 2 sc] 4 times around = 12 sc. Rnds 7 - 21: Sc around. Stuff with fiber fill. Fasten off and cinch tight. Pull tail yarn to cinch ring closed. Carefully weave in all ends.

Legs: Make 2 alike. With size 3 mm hook and Beige make an adjustable ring. Rnd 1: 4 sc into ring. Work sc in continuous rnds without joining. Place marker to indicate beg of rnds. Move marker up as work progresses. Rnd 2: Inc around = 8 sc. Rnd 3: Inc around = 16 sc. Rnd 4: [Inc, sc in next sc] 8 times around = 24 sc. Rnds 5 – 7: Sc around. Stuff with fiber fill. Rnd 8: [Dec, sc in next sc] 8 times around = 16 sc. Rnds 9 – 21: Sc around. Stuff with fiber fill. Fasten off and cinch tight. Pull tail yarn to cinch ring closed. Carefully weave in all ends.

Ears: Make 2 alike. With size 3 mm hook and Beige, ch 2. Row 1: Ch 1, 2 sc in 2nd and 3rd ch from hook = 4 sc. Row 2: Ch 1, inc at beg and end of row = 6 sc. Rep row 2 three times more = 12 sc. Work 4 rows even. Row 10: Ch 1, dec at beg and end of row = 10 sc. Rep row 10 four times more = 2 sc. Work 1 rnd sc around outer edge. Fasten off.

Finishing: Sew body to head; sew arms and legs to body. Sew ears to head using photo as guide. Using Pink, embroider nose with satin stitch and straight stitch; using Charcoal, embroider eyes with satin stitch.

Dress

With size 3.5 mm dpns and Ecru cast on 56 sts. Arrange sts evenly on 4 needles = 14 sts per needle. Place beg of rnd marker and join for working in rnds. Place side marker after 28 sts. P 1 rnd, then work St st in rnds for 8 rnds. Next dec rnd: K2tog, k to 2 sts before marker, skp, sl marker, k2tog, k to last 2 sts, skp. Rep dec rnd every 8th rnd once more = 48 sts. Work even until piece meas 8.5 cm from cast-on. Next dec rnd: Knit, decreasing 12 sts evenly around = 36 sts. Divide for back and front: K18 to side marker and turn, purl 1 WS row

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across 18 front sts only, leave rem 18 sts on hold for back. Cont in St st, back and forth in rows, across front sts only until piece meas 12 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape neck: Next RS row: Bind off center 10 sts. Working each side separately, work even for 1 cm. Bind off rem 4 sts for each shoulder. **Back**: With WS facing, rejoin yarn to 18 back sts on hold. Next WS row: P9 and turn, leaving rem 9 sts for right half of back on hold. Cont in St st, back and forth in rows, across 9 left half sts only until piece meas 12 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape neck: Bind off 5 sts at beg of next RS row, k4. Work even until piece meas 13 cm from cast-on. Bind off rem 4 shoulder sts. With WS facing, rejoin yarn to sts on hold. Complete right half of back same as left half, reversing neck shaping.

Sleeves: With size 3.5 mm needles and Ecru cast on 21 sts. K 1 WS row, then work in St st until piece meas 3 cm from cast-on. Bind off all sts.

Finishing: Sew shoulder seams. With size 3 mm hook and Ecru work 1 rnd sc around neck edge including center back slit, working a ch-4 buttonloop at top right corner of center back slit in the process. Fasten off. Set sleeves into armholes. Sew sleeve seams. With size 3 mm hook, join Ecru with sl st to bottom edge of dress, * ch 3, skip next st, sc in next st; rep from * around, end ch 3, skip next st, sl st in join. Fasten off. Sew on button.




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Gauge Swatch

Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.



Abbreviations

beg = begin(ning) \cdot **ch** = chain \cdot **cont** = continue \cdot **dec** = decreas(e)(ing) \cdot **inc** = increas(e)(ing) \cdot **k** = knit \cdot **kwise** = as if to knit **meas** = measures \cdot **M1L** = lift strand between sts from front to back and knit this strand through the back loop \cdot **M1R** = lift strand between sts from the back and knit this strand through the front loop \cdot **patt** = pattern \cdot **pm** = place marker \cdot **p** = purl **pwise** = as if to purl \cdot **rem** = remain(ing) \cdot **rep** = repeat(s) \cdot **rev St st** = reverse stockinette stitch \cdot **rnd(s)** = round(s) \cdot **RS** = right side \cdot **sc** = single crochet \cdot **skp** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 1 stitch, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch \cdot **sk2p** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 2 together, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch \cdot **s2kp** = slip 2 stitches as if to knit, k 1 stitch, pass slipped stitches over knitted stitch \cdot **s1** = slip \cdot **st(s)** = stitch(es) \cdot **St st** = stockinette stitch \cdot **tbl** = through the back loop \cdot **tog** = together \cdot **wyib** = with yarn in back of work \cdot **wyif** = with yarn in front of work \cdot **WS** = wrong side \cdot **yo(s)** = yarn over(s)
