Size 6 (7, 8)

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

Materials: 50 g each of Lana Grossa Baby Soft (60% polyamide, 40% cotton; 150 m/50 g) in Beige (col 21) and Ecru (col 2). One set size 3.5 mm double-pointed needles [dpns].

Rib patt: K1, p1 around.

St st: K on RS, p on WS; k every rnd.

Gauge: 19 sts and 33 rows/rnds = 10 x 10 cm in St st on size 3.5 mm needles.

Cuff: With size 3.5 mm dpns and Ecru cast on 24 (28, 32) sts. Arrange sts evenly on 4 needles = 6 (7, 8) sts per needle. Place beg of rnd marker and join for working in rnds. Work in rib patt until piece meas 1.5 cm from cast-on. Break Ecru, cont with Beige and in rib patt until piece meas 7 (7.5, 8) cm from cast-on.

Heel: Leaving sts on 2nd and 3rd needle on hold, work across the 12 (14, 16) sts on first and 4th needle in St st, back and forth in rows, for 10 (12, 14) rows.

Turn heel: Mark center 4 (4, 6) sts. Next RS row: * K to last center st, skp last center st and next st, turn. Next WS row: SI 1 pwise wyif, p to last center st, ptog last center st and next st, turn, sI 1 pwise wyib. Rep from * until only center 4 (4, 6) sts rem.

Gusset: K to center of heel; with free needle, k 2nd half of the heel sts, pick up and knit 1 st in every other row along left side of heel, picking up back strand only; with free needle, k across sts on 2nd needle; with free needle, k across sts on 3rd needle; with free needle, pick up and knit 1 st in every other row along right side of heel, picking up back strand only; k sts on 4th needle. Cont working St st in rnds and work gusset decs every other rnd as foll: K to last 3 sts on first needle, k2tog, k to end of 3rd needle, k first st on 4th needle, skp, k to end. Work decs until 24 (28, 32) sts rem.

Foot: Work even for 5 (6, 7) cm.

Shape toe: K to last 2 sts on first needle, k2tog, skp first 2 sts on 2nd needle; k to last 2 sts on 3rd needle, k2tog, skp first 2 sts on 4th needle; k to end. Rep dec rnd every other rnd until 8 sts rem. Cut yarn, draw yarn end through rem sts and pull tight. Carefully weave in all ends.

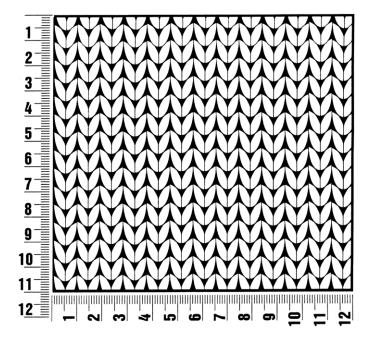


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Gauge Swatch

Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.



Abbreviations

beg = begin(ning) \cdot **ch** = chain \cdot **cont** = continue \cdot **dec** = decreas(e)(ing) \cdot **inc** = increas(e)(ing) \cdot **k** = knit \cdot **kwise** = as if to knit **meas** = measures \cdot **M1L** = lift strand between sts from front to back and knit this strand through the back loop \cdot **M1R** = lift strand between sts from the back and knit this strand through the front loop \cdot **patt** = pattern \cdot **pm** = place marker \cdot **p** = purl **pwise** = as if to purl \cdot **rem** = remain(ing) \cdot **rep** = repeat(s) \cdot **rev St st** = reverse stockinette stitch \cdot **rnd(s)** = round(s) \cdot **RS** = right side \cdot **sc** = single crochet \cdot **skp** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 1 stitch, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch \cdot **sk2p** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 2 together, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch \cdot **s2kp** = slip 2 stitches as if to knit, k 1 stitch, pass slipped stitches over knitted stitch \cdot **s1** = slip \cdot **st(s)** = stitch(es) \cdot **St st** = stockinette stitch \cdot **tbl** = through the back loop \cdot **tog** = together \cdot **wyib** = with yarn in back of work \cdot **wyif** = with yarn in front of work \cdot **WS** = wrong side \cdot **yo(s)** = yarn over(s)
