SHEEP · BABY SOFT Design 64 from Filati Infanti 14

Size 26 cm tall

Materials: 50 g each of Lana Grossa Baby Soft (60% polyamide, 40% cotton; 150 m/50 g) in White (col 1) and Beige (col 21) and small amount in Black. Size 3 mm crochet hook; fiber fill.

Single crochet [sc]: Work in continuous rnds without joining. Place marker to indicate beg of rnds. Move marker up as work progresses. Beg each rnd with ch 1.

Increase (inc): 2 sc in next st.

Decrease (dec): Sc2tog in next 2 sts.

Gauge: 18 sc and 16 rows/rnds = 10×10 cm with size 3 mm hook.

Head: With size 3 mm hook and Beige make an adjustable ring. <u>Rnd 1</u>: 4 sc into ring. Work in continuous rnds without joining. Place marker to indicate beg of rnds. Move marker up as work progresses. <u>Rnd 2</u>: Inc around = 8 sc. <u>Rnd 3</u>: [Inc, sc in next sc] 4 times around = 124 sc. <u>Rnd 4</u>: [Inc, sc in each of next 2 sc] 4 times around = 16 sc. <u>Rnd 5</u>: [Inc, sc in each of next 3 sc] 4 times around = 20 sc. <u>Rnds 6 – 12</u>: Sc around. Stuff with fiber fill. <u>Rnd 13</u>: [Dec, sc in each of next 2 sc] 4 times around = 16 sc. <u>Rnd 14</u>: [Dec, sc in each of next 2 sc] 4 times around = 12 sc. <u>Rnd 15</u>: [Dec, sc in each of next 2 sc] 4 times around = 12 sc. <u>Rnd 15</u>: [Dec, sc in next sc] 4 times around = 8 sc. Stuff with fiber fill. <u>Rnd 15</u>: Dec around = 4 sc. Fasten off and cinch tight. Pull tail yarn to cinch ring closed. Carefully weave in all ends.

Body: With size 3 mm hook and White make an adjustable ring. <u>Rnd 1:</u> 4 sc into ring. Work sc in continuous rnds without joining. Place marker to indicate beg of rnds. Move marker up as work progresses. <u>Rnd 2:</u> Inc around = 8 sc. <u>Rnd 3:</u> Inc around = 16 sc. <u>Rnd 4:</u> [Inc, sc in next sc] 8 times around = 24 sc. <u>Rnd 5:</u> [Inc, sc in each of next 2 sc] 8 times around = 32 sc. <u>Rnds 6 - 16:</u> Sc around. Stuff with fiber fill. <u>Rnd 17:</u> [Dec, sc in each of next 2 sc] 8 times around = 16 sc. <u>Rnd 19:</u> [Dec, sc in next sc] 8 times around = 16 sc. <u>Rnd 20:</u> Dec around = 8 sc. Stuff with fiber fill. <u>Rnd 21:</u> Dec around = 4 sc. Fasten off and cinch tight. Pull tail yarn to cinch ring closed. Carefully weave in all ends.

Arms: Make 2 alike. With size 3 mm hook and Beige make an adjustable ring. <u>Rnd 1:</u> 4 sc into ring. Work sc in continuous rnds without joining. Place marker to indicate beg of rnds. Move marker up as work progresses. <u>Rnd 2:</u> Inc around = 8 sc. <u>Rnd 3:</u> Inc around = 16 sc. <u>Rnds 4 - 7:</u> Sc around. Stuff with fiber fill. <u>Rnd 8:</u> [Dec, sc in each of next 2 sc] 4 times around = 12 sc. <u>Rnd 9:</u> [Dec, sc in next sc] 4 times around = 8 sc. Work even for 9 cm. Fasten off and cinch tight. Pull tail yarn to cinch ring closed. Carefully weave in all ends.

Legs: Make 2 alike. With size 3 mm hook and Beige make an adjustable ring. <u>Rnd 1:</u> 4 sc into ring. Work sc in continuous rnds without joining. Place marker to indicate beg of rnds. Move marker up as work progresses. <u>Rnd 2:</u> Inc around = 8 sc. <u>Rnd 3:</u> Inc around = 16 sc. <u>Rnds 4 - 7:</u> Sc around. Stuff with fiber fill. <u>Rnd 8:</u> [Dec, sc in each of next 2 sc] 4 times around = 12 sc. <u>Rnd 9:</u> [Dec, sc in next sc] 4 times around = 8 sc. Work even for 10 cm. Fasten off and cinch tight. Pull tail yarn to cinch ring closed. Carefully weave in all ends.

Ears: Make 2 alike. With size 3 mm hook and Beige make an adjustable ring. <u>Rnd 1:</u> 4 sc into ring. Work sc in continuous rnds without joining. Place marker to indicate beg of rnds. Move marker up as work progresses. <u>Rnd 2:</u> Inc around = 8 sc. <u>Rnd 3:</u> Inc around = 16 sc. <u>Rnds 4 - 9:</u> Sc around. Fasten off and cinch tight. Pull tail yarn to cinch ring closed. Carefully weave in all ends.

Hat: With size 3 mm hook and White make an adjustable ring. <u>Rnd 1:</u> 4 sc into ring. Work sc in continuous rnds without joining. Place marker to indicate beg of rnds. Move marker up as work progresses. <u>Rnd 2:</u> Inc around = 8 sc. <u>Rnd 3:</u> [Inc, sc in next sc] 4 times around = 12 sc. <u>Rnd 4:</u> [Inc, sc in each of next 2 sc] 4 times around = 16 sc. <u>Rnd 5:</u> [Inc, sc in each of next 3 sc] 4 times around = 20 sc. <u>Rnd 6</u>: Sc around. Fasten off and cinch tight. Pull tail yarn to cinch ring closed. Carefully weave in all ends.

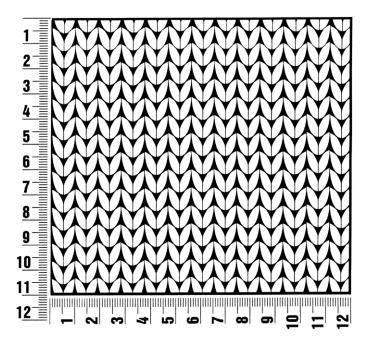
Finishing: Stuff hat lightly with fiber fill. Sew hat to back of head at an angle. Sew body to head; sew arms and legs to body. Sew ears to head using photo as guide. Using Black, embroider face as shown in photo.



Gauge Swatch

Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.



Abbreviations

beg = begin(ning) \cdot **ch** = chain \cdot **cont** = continue \cdot **dec** = decreas(e)(ing) \cdot **inc** = increas(e)(ing) \cdot **k** = knit \cdot **kwise** = as if to knit **meas** = measures \cdot **M1L** = lift strand between sts from front to back and knit this strand through the back loop \cdot **M1R** = lift strand between sts from the back and knit this strand through the front loop \cdot **patt** = pattern \cdot **pm** = place marker \cdot **p** = purl **pwise** = as if to purl \cdot **rem** = remain(ing) \cdot **rep** = repeat(s) \cdot **rev** St st = reverse stockinette stitch \cdot **rnd(s)** = round(s) \cdot **RS** = right side \cdot **sc** = single crochet \cdot **skp** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 1 stitch, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch \cdot **sk2p** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 2 together, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch \cdot **s2kp** = slip 2 stitches as if to knit, k 1 stitch, pass slipped stitches over knitted stitch \cdot **sl** = slip \cdot **st(s)** = stitch(es) \cdot St st = stockinette stitch \cdot **tbl** = through the back loop \cdot **tog** = together \cdot **wyib** = with yarn in back of work \cdot **wyif** = with yarn in front of work \cdot **WS** = wrong side \cdot **yo(s)** = yarn over(s)
