

PULLOVER • STROMBOLI, CAPRI & SILKHAIR

Design 14 from Lookbook 06

Size 36/38 (40/42, 44/46, 48)

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

Materials: 200 (250, 300, 350) g of Lana Grossa Stromboli (60% cotton, 15% viscose, 15% polyamide; 10% silk; 150 m/50 g) in Green/Beige (col 106), 150 (200, 250, 300) g of Lana Grossa Capri (55% cotton, 30% polyamide, 15% silk; 150 m/50 g) in Stone Grey (col 11) and 50 (75, 100, 125) g of Silkhair (70% mohair, 30% silk; 210 m/25 g) in Moss Green (col 127). Size 4 mm needles; size 4 mm circular needle, 40 cm long.

Garter st: K every row.

St st: K on RS, p on WS; k every rnd.

Stripe sequence A for back and front: Work 36 rows with Moss Green, 24 rows with Green/Beige, 50 rows with Stone Grey, 30 rows with Green/Beige, 6 rows with Stone Grey, 12 rows with Moss Green, remainder with Green/Beige.

Stripe sequence B for sleeves: Work 36 rows with Moss Green, 24 rows with Green/Beige, 50 rows with Stone Grey, remainder with Green/Beige.


Gauge: 21.5 sts and 30 rows = 10 x 10 cm in St st on size 4 mm needles.

Back: With size 4 mm need and Moss Green cast on 120 (128, 138, 146) sts. Beg and end with a WS row work in garter st for 3 rows. Work in St st and stripe sequence A for 10 rows. Shape sides: Inc row (RS): Work in patt, inc 1 st at each end of row = 122(130, 140, 140)148) sts. Cont in patt, rep inc row every 10th row 5 times, then every 8th row 7 times, then every = 94(102, 112, 120)sts. Work even until piece meas 42 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape armholes: Bind off 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows, 2 sts at beg of next 4 rows, 1 st at beg of next 2 rows = 78 (86, 96, 104) sts. Work even until piece meas 56.5 (58.5, 60.5, 62.5) cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape neck: Next row (RS): Bind off center 46 sts. Working each side separately, bind off 3 sts at each neck edge once, 2 sts once, 1 st once. Work even until piece meas 60 (62, 64, 66) cm from cast-on. Bind off rem 10 (14, 19, 23) sts for each shoulder.

Front: Work same as for back until piece meas 49.5 (51.5, 53.5, 55.5) cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape neck: Next row (RS): Bind off center 20 sts. Working each side separately, bind off 3 sts at each neck edge 3 times, 2 sts 4 times, 1 st twice. Work even until piece meas 60 (62, 64, 66) cm from cast-on. Bind off rem 10 (14, 19, 23) sts for each shoulder.

Sleeves: With size 4 mm needles and Moss Green cast on 54 (58, 62, 66) sts. Beg and end with a WS row work in garter st for 3 rows. Work in St st and stripe sequence B for 12 (10, 8, 8) rows. Shape sleeve: Inc row (RS): Work in patt, inc 1 st at each end of row = 56 (60, 64, 68) sts. Cont in patt, rep inc row every 12th row twice, then every 10th row 9 times (every 10th row 7 times, then every 8th row 6 times / every 8th row 15 times / every 8th row 7 times, then every 6th row 11 times) = 78 (86, 94, 104) sts. Work even until piece meas 46 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape sleeve cap: Bind off 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows, 2 sts at beg of next 4 rows, 1 st at beg of next 8 rows, 5 sts at beg of next 2 rows. Bind off rem 14 (22, 30, 40) sts.

Finishing: Pin pieces to measurements and block. Sew shoulder seams. <u>Neck band</u>: With size 4 mm circular needle and Green/Beige, pick up and k 151 sts evenly around neck edge. Join for working in rnds. Work St st in rnds for 1 cm. Bind off all sts. Sew in sleeves. Sew side and sleeve seams.






Gauge Swatch

Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.



Abbreviations

beg = begin(ning) \cdot **ch** = chain \cdot **cont** = continue \cdot **dec** = decreas(e)(ing) \cdot **inc** = increas(e)(ing) \cdot **k** = knit \cdot **kwise** = as if to knit **meas** = measures \cdot **M1L** = lift strand between sts from front to back and knit this strand through the back loop \cdot **M1R** = lift strand between sts from the back and knit this strand through the front loop \cdot **patt** = pattern \cdot **pm** = place marker \cdot **p** = purl **pwise** = as if to purl \cdot **rem** = remain(ing) \cdot **rep** = repeat(s) \cdot **rev** St st = reverse stockinette stitch \cdot **rnd(s)** = round(s) \cdot **RS** = right side \cdot **sc** = single crochet \cdot **skp** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 1 stitch, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch \cdot **sk2p** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 2 together, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch \cdot **s2kp** = slip 2 stitches as if to knit, k 1 stitch, pass slipped stitches over knitted stitch \cdot **sl** = slip \cdot **st(s)** = stitch(es) \cdot St st = stockinette stitch \cdot **tbl** = through the back loop \cdot **tog** = together \cdot **wyib** = with yarn in back of work \cdot **wyif** = with yarn in front of work \cdot **WS** = wrong side \cdot **yo(s)** = yarn over(s)
