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PULLOVER · CAPRI & STROMBOLI

Design 02 from Filati Journal 57

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Size 36/38 (40/42, 44)

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

Materials: 250 (300, 350) g of Lana Grossa **Capri** (55% cotton, 30% polyamide, 15% silk; 150 m/50 g) in Citrus Yellow (col 13) and 250 (300, 350) g of Lana Grossa **Stromboli** (60% cotton, 15% viscose, 15% polyamide, 10% silk; 150 m/50 g) in Green-Yellow/Petrol (col 107). Size 8 mm needles.

Note: Work with 1 strand of each yarn held tog throughout.

Selvage sts: On every row: Sl first st kwise, k last st. Maintain selvage sts throughout.

Garter st: K every row.

Mesh stitch: Multiple of 2. Row 1 (WS): Selvage st, * yo, sl 1 pwise wyib, k1; rep from *, end selvage st. Row 2 (RS): Selvage st, * k2, sl yo pwise wyib; rep from *, end selvage st. Row 3 (WS): Selvage st, * ktog next st and yo, yo, sl 1 pwise wyib; rep from *, end selvage st. Row 4 (RS): Selvage st, k1, * sl yo pwise wyib, k2; rep from *, end sl yo pwise wyib, k1, selvage st. Row 5 (WS): Selvage st, * yo, sl 1 pwise wyib, ktog next st and yo; rep from *, end selvage st. Work rows 1 – 5 once, then rep rows 2 – 5.

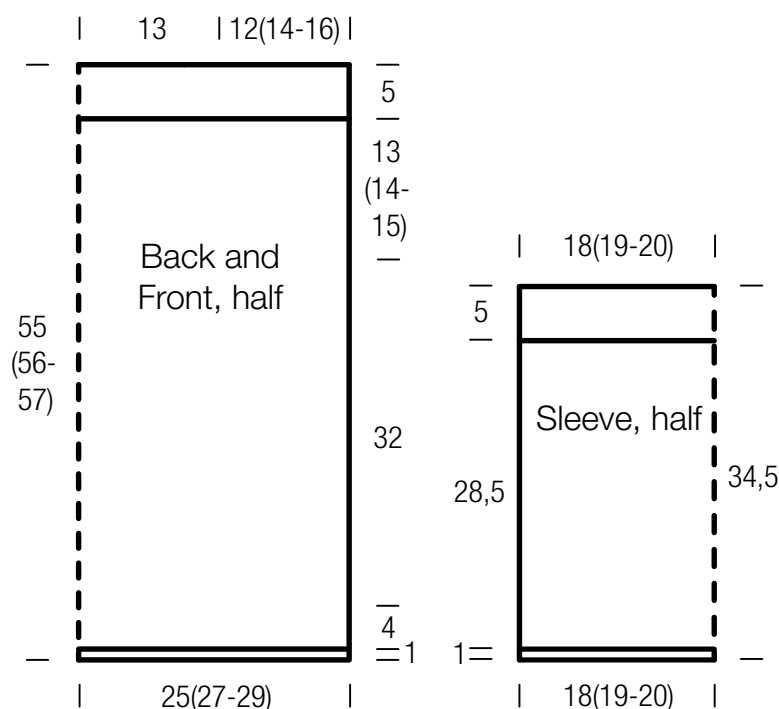
Gauges: On size 8 mm needles with 1 strand of each yarn held tog and measured hanging from needle: 11 sts and 20 rows = 10 x 10 cm in garter st; 11 sts and 22.5 rows = 10 x 10 cm in mesh st.

Back: With size 8 mm needles and 1 strand of each yarn held tog, cast on 56 (62, 66) sts. Work in garter st for 2 rows. Beg with next WS row, work in mesh st until piece meas 37 cm from cast-on. Place marker at each edge to indicate beg of armholes. Cont in patt until piece meas 13 (14, 15) cm from armhole markers, ending with a RS row. Work in garter st for 5 cm. Loosely bind off all sts.

Front: Work same as for back.

Sleeves: With size 8 mm needles and 1 strand of each yarn held tog, cast on 42 (44, 46) sts. Work in garter st for 2 rows. Beg with next WS row, work in mesh st until piece meas 29.5 cm from cast-on, ending with a RS row. Work in garter st for 5 cm. Loosely bind off all sts.

Finishing: Pin pieces to measurements and block. Sew shoulder seams, leaving center 26 cm open for neck. Sew on sleeves between markers. Sew side and sleeve seams, leaving bottom 5 cm of side seams open for vents.



Gauge Swatch

Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.
