

# JACKET · ABOUT BERLIN SPARKLY Design 32 from Filati Journal 57

#### Size 36/38 (40/42)

Instructions are given for first size. Figure in parenthesis refers to larger size. When only one figure is given, it applies to both sizes.

**Materials: 600 (650) g** of Lana Grossa **About Berlin Sparkly** (82% cotton, 18% polyester; 120 m/50 g) in Grey/Petrol/Charcoal **(col 10)**. Size 3 and 5 mm needles; size 3 mm circular needle, 80 cm long.

**2 selvage stitches**: <u>At beg of RS rows</u>, k1, sl 1 pwise wyib, pulling yarn tight; <u>at end of RS rows</u>, work to last 2 sts, sl 1 pwise wyib, pulling yarn tight, k1. <u>At beg of WS rows</u>, sl 1 pwise wyif, pulling yarn tight, p1; <u>at end of WS rows</u>, work to last 2 sts, p1, sl 1 pwise wyif, pulling yarn tight.

Slip stitch selvage: <u>On every row</u>: K first st, sl last st pwise wyif.

Rib patt: K1, p1.

Rev St st: P on RS, k on WS.

**Trinity stitch**: <u>Row 1 (RS)</u>: Selvage st, purl to last st, selvage st. <u>Row 2 (WS)</u>: Selvage st, \* [k1, p1, k1] in next st = 3 sts; p3tog; rep from \*, end selvage st. <u>Row 3 (RS)</u>: Selvage st, purl to last st, selvage st. <u>Row 4 (WS)</u>: Selvage st, \* p3tog, [k1, p1, k1] in next st = 3 sts; rep from \*, end selvage st. Rep rows 1 - 4.

**Gauge**: 24 sts and 22.5 rows =  $10 \times 10$  cm in trinity st on size 5 mm needles.

Back: With size 3 mm needles, cast on 106 (114) sts. Beg and end with a WS row and working a slip st selvage at each edge, work in rib patt until piece meas 5.5 cm from cast-on. Change to size 5 mm needles. Maintaining selvage sts, work in trinity st and shape sides as foll: Inc 1 st at each end of 5th row, then every 4th row 7 times = 122 (130) sts. Work increased sts into patt. Work even in patt until piece meas 23.5 (25) cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape armholes: Dec row 1 (RS): 2 selvage sts, p2tog, patt to last 4 sts, p2tog, 2 selvage sts. Dec row 2 (WS): 2 selvage sts, k2tog tbl, patt to last 4 sts, k2tog, 2 selvage sts. Rep last 2 rows 4 more times = 102 (110) sts. Note: When working decs, make sure to stay in patt. Next row (RS): 2 selvage sts, 1 st in rev St st, patt to last 3 sts, 1 st in rev St st, 2 selvage sts. Working first 3 sts and last 3 sts as set by last row and rem sts in trinity st, work even until armhole meas 18 (19) cm, ending with a WS

row. Shape neck: Next row (RS): Bind off center 36 sts. Working each side separately, work 4 rows even. Place rem 33 (37) sts for each shoulder on separate holders.

Left front: With size 3 mm needles, cast on 56 (60) sts. Next row (WS): 2 selvage sts, 1 st in rev St st, \* p1, k1; rep from \*, end slip st selvage. Cont in patt as established until piece meas 5.5 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Change to size 5 mm needles. Next row (RS): Slip st selvage, work in trinity st to last 3 sts, 1 st in rev St st, 2 selvage sts. Cont in patt as established, work side shaping at right edge same as for back = 64 (68) sts. Cont until piece meas same length as back to armhole. Shape armhole at right edge same as for back. At same time, when piece meas 26.5 (29) cm from cast-on, shape neck as foll: Next row (WS): Bind off 20 sts, patt to end = 34 (38) sts rem after armhole and neck shaping is complete. Next row (RS): 2 selvage sts, 1 st in rev St st, patt to last 3 sts, 1 st in rev St st, 2 selvage sts. Working first 3 sts and last 3 sts as set by last row and rem sts in trinity st, work even until same length as back to shoulder, ending with a RS row. Next row (WS): K2tog, patt to end. Place rem 33 (37) shoulder sts on holder.

**Right front:** Work same as for left front, reversing all shaping and patt placement.


**Sleeves:** With size 3 mm needles, cast on 99 (103) sts. Beg and end with a WS row and working a slip st selvage at each edge, work in rib patt until piece meas 11 cm from cast-on, decreasing 1 st on last WS row = 98 (102) sts. Change to size 5 mm needles. Next row (RS): 2 selvage sts, 1 st in rev St st, work in trinity st to last 3 sts, 1 st in rev St st, 2 selvage sts. Cont in patt as established until piece meas 41 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape sleeve: Dec row 1 (RS): 2 selvage sts, p2tog, patt to last 4 sts, p2tog, 2 selvage sts. Dec row 2 (WS): 2 selvage sts, k2tog tbl, patt to last 4 sts, k2tog, 2 selvage sts. Rep last 2 rows 4 more times = 78 (82) sts. Note: When working decs, make sure to stay in patt. Next row (RS): K2tog across row and loosely bind off at same time.

**Finishing**: Pin pieces to measurements and block. Join shoulders with 3-needle bind-off. <u>Neckband</u>: With size 3 mm circular needle, cast on 197 sts. Beg with a WS row, work in rib patt for 8 cm. Loosely bind off all sts in rib. Sew bound-off edge of neckband to right front, back and left front neck edge. Sew side edges to right and left neck bind-off row. Sew in sleeves. Sew side and sleeve seams. Sew all seams with mattress st and from RS, 1 st in from edge.






## Gauge Swatch

### Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.



### Abbreviations

**beg** = begin(ning)  $\cdot$  **ch** = chain  $\cdot$  **cont** = continue  $\cdot$  **dec** = decreas(e)(ing)  $\cdot$  **inc** = increas(e)(ing)  $\cdot$  **k** = knit  $\cdot$  **kwise** = as if to knit **meas** = measures  $\cdot$  **M1L** = lift strand between sts from front to back and knit this strand through the back loop  $\cdot$  **M1R** = lift strand between sts from the back and knit this strand through the front loop  $\cdot$  **patt** = pattern  $\cdot$  **pm** = place marker  $\cdot$  **p** = purl **pwise** = as if to purl  $\cdot$  **rem** = remain(ing)  $\cdot$  **rep** = repeat(s)  $\cdot$  **rev** St st = reverse stockinette stitch  $\cdot$  **rnd(s)** = round(s)  $\cdot$  **RS** = right side  $\cdot$  **sc** = single crochet  $\cdot$  **skp** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 1 stitch, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch  $\cdot$  **sk2p** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 2 together, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch  $\cdot$  **s2kp** = slip 2 stitches as if to knit, k 1 stitch, pass slipped stitches over knitted stitch  $\cdot$  **sl** = slip  $\cdot$  **st(s)** = stitch(es)  $\cdot$  St st = stockinette stitch  $\cdot$  **tbl** = through the back loop  $\cdot$  **tog** = together  $\cdot$  **wyib** = with yarn in back of work  $\cdot$  **wyif** = with yarn in front of work  $\cdot$  **WS** = wrong side  $\cdot$  **yo(s)** = yarn over(s)
