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PULLOVER · GOMITOLO DENIM Design 07 from Filati Gomitolo 03



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Size 36-38 (40-42, 44-46)

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

Materials: 400 g of Lana Grossa **Gomitolo Denim** (80% cotton, 20% polyamide; 740 m/200 g) in Purple **(col 6)**. Size 4 mm needles; size 3.5 mm crochet hook.

Half-brioche rib: Multiple of 2 + 1 + 2 selvage sts. Work according to chart. Numbers at right edge of chart indicate RS rows, number at left edge of chart indicates WS row. Work to patt rep, work 2 sts between arrows for patt rep, work to end of chart. Work rows 1 - 3 once, then rep rows 2 and 3. Note: 1 st and 1 yo are treated as 1 st.

St st: K on RS, p on WS.

Gauges: <u>On size 4 mm needles</u>: 25 sts and 33 rows = 10×10 cm in St st; 20.5 sts and 35 rows = 10×10 cm in half-brioche rib.


Center panel, back: With size 4 mm needles cast on 47 sts. Work in half-brioche rib according to chart until piece meas 56 (58, 60) cm from cast-on. Bind off all sts.

Center panel, front: Work same as for center panel, back.

Side panels: Make 2 alike. With size 4 mm needles cast on 57 (67, 77) sts. Work in St st until piece meas 31 cm from cast-on. Bind off all sts.

Sleeves: With size 4 mm needles cast on 105 (113, 121) sts. Work in half-brioche rib according to chart until piece meas 29.5 (31.5, 33.5) cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Divide work at center: Next row (RS): Bind off center st. Work-ing each side separately, cont in half-brioche rib until piece meas 34 (36, 38) cm from cast-on. Bind off all sts.

Finishing: Pin pieces to measurements and block. Sew side panels to back and front center panels. Sew on sleeves. Sew sleeve seams. <u>Neck and sleeve edging</u>: With size 3.5 mm hook, work 1 rnd sc around neck edge and around each sleeve edge.






Gauge Swatch

Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.
