Size 36/38 (40/42)

Instructions are given for first size. Figure in parenthesis refers to larger size. When only one figure is given, it applies to both sizes.

Materials: 450 (500) g of Lana Grossa **About Berlin Chilly** (100% linen; 95 m/50 g) in Dark Brown (col 8). Size 8 mm needles; size 6 mm crochet hook.

Zigzag patt: Work according to chart. Numbers at right edge of chart indicate RS rows, numbers at left edge of chart indicate WS rows. Work 6-st self-finishing edge to arrow a (9 sts after row 2), then work 3 (6) sts between arrow a and b (c), then work patt rep between arrow c and d 3 times, then work 9 sts between double arrow and arrow d once more, then work 3 (6) sts between arrow d and e (f), then work 6-st self-finishing edge to end of chart (9 sts after row 2). Work rows 1 – 64 once, then rep rows 49 – 64.

St st: K on RS, p on WS.

Gauge: 16 sts and 18.5 rows = 10 x 10 cm in zigzag patt on size 8 mm needles.

Back: With size 8 mm needles cast on 81 (87) sts. Work zigzag patt according to chart for 34 rows and piece meas approx. 18 cm from cast-on. Place marker in first and last st on last row to indicate end of side vents. Cont to foll chart until piece meas 64 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape sleeves: Cast on 4 sts at beg of next 2 rows = 89 (95) sts. Working self-finishing edge over first and last 6 sts (9 sts after incs) as at beg of back and rem sts in patt as established, cont until sleeve meas 22 (23) cm, ending with a WS row. Shape shoulders: Bind off 7 sts at beg of next 2 rows and at same time, dec 3 sts across first and last 9 sts as shown on chart row 35, then bind off 5 (6) sts at beg of next 6 rows. Bind off rem 51 sts. Mark center 41 sts for neck.

Front: Work same as for back until piece meas 1 cm from beg of shoulder shaping. Shape neck: Next row (RS): Bind off center 27 sts. Working each side separately, bind off 4 sts at each neck edge once, 3 sts once. Bind off rem 5 sts for each shoulder.

Finishing: Pin pieces to measurements and block. Sew shoulder seams. Neck edging: With crochet hook work 2 rnds sl st around neck edge, working under back loop only on 2nd rnd. Sew side and sleeve seams, leaving bottom 18 cm of side seams open for vents. Sew seams 1 st in from edge.

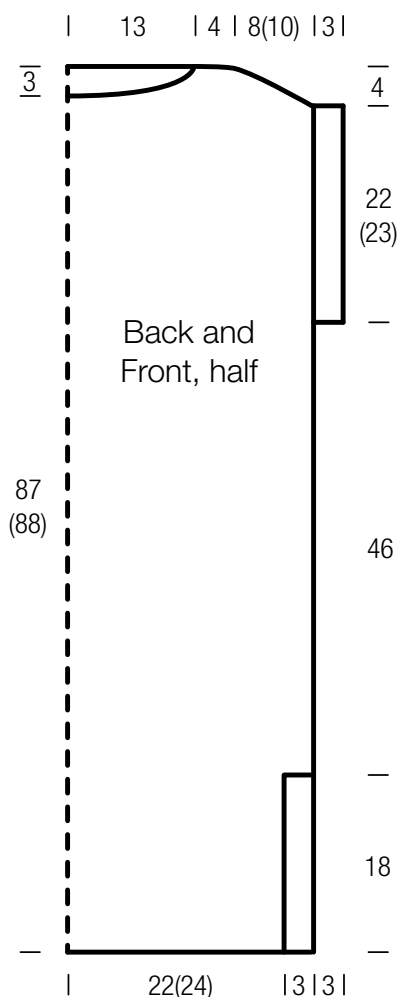


Chart key:

- ☒ = sl 1 pwise wyib
- ☒ = sl 1 pwise wyif
- ☐ = represents "no stitch" (included to keep st count correct)
- ☒ = k2tog
- ☒ = skp: sl 1 kwise, k1, pass slipped st over knitted st
- ☒ = skip first st on left needle; working behind skipped st, ktbl 2nd st, k first st, drop both sts from needle
- ☒ = skip first st on left needle; working in front of skipped st, k 2nd st, k first st, drop both sts from needle

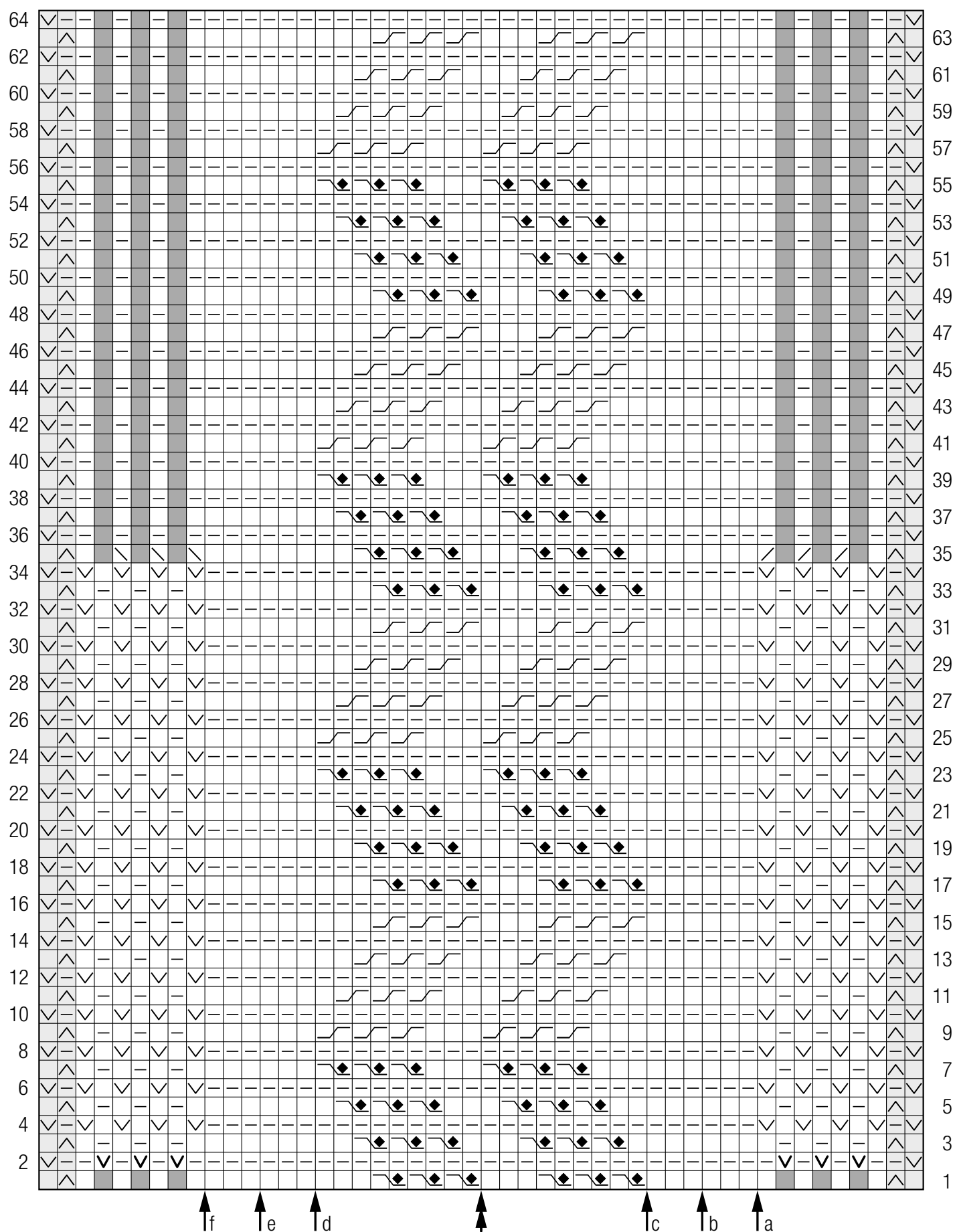

Gauge Swatch

Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.



Abbreviations

beg = begin(ning) · **ch** = chain · **cont** = continue · **dec** = decreas(e)(ing) · **inc** = increas(e)(ing) · **k** = knit · **kwise** = as if to knit
meas = measures · **M1L** = lift strand between sts from front to back and knit this strand through the back loop · **M1R** = lift strand between sts from the back and knit this strand through the front loop · **patt** = pattern · **pm** = place marker · **p** = purl
pwise = as if to purl · **rem** = remain(ing) · **rep** = repeat(s) · **rev St st** = reverse stockinette stitch · **rnd(s)** = round(s) · **RS** = right side · **sc** = single crochet · **skp** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 1 stitch, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch · **sk2p** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 2 together, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch · **s2kp** = slip 2 stitches as if to knit, k 1 stitch, pass slipped stitches over knitted stitch · **sl** = slip · **st(s)** = stitch(es) · **St st** = stockinette stitch · **tbl** = through the back loop · **tog** = together · **wyib** = with yarn in back of work · **wyif** = with yarn in front of work · **WS** = wrong side · **yo(s)** = yarn over(s)
