



TUNIC · BABY SOFT

Design 50 from Filati Best of Infanti

Size 50/56 (62/68, 74/80)

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

Materials: 50 (100, 100) g of Lana Grossa **Baby Soft** (60% polyamide, 40% cotton; 150 m/50 g) in Pink (col 13). Size 4 mm circular needle, 40 cm long; size 3.5 mm crochet hook; one 12 mm button.

St st: K on RS, p on WS; k every rnd.

Rev St st: P on RS, k on WS; p every rnd.

Garter st: K every row.

Eyelet patt: Multiple of 9. Work according to chart. Number at right edge of chart indicates rnd; on rnd not shown on chart, knit all sts and yos. Work all rnds from right to left. Work 9-st patt rep between arrows around. Rep rnds 1 and 2.

Pattern sequence: Purl 1 rnd, * work 6 rnds eyelet patt, purl 2 rnds; rep from * throughout.

Gauge: 17.5 sts and 34.5 rows/rnds = 10 x 10 cm in St st with size 4 mm needles.

Tunic: Worked in one piece in the rnd to underarm. With size 4 mm circular needle cast on 108 (126, 144) sts. Place beg of rnd marker and join for working in rnds. Work in patt sequence for 9 rnds as foll: Work 9-st patt rep 12 times around (beg at arrow a, work 4 sts to end of chart, then work 9-st patt rep 13 times, then work first 5 sts of patt rep once more, ending at arrow a / work 9-st patt rep 16 times around). Next rnd: Work 23 (27, 32) sts in St st, work patt sequence as established over next 9 sts, work in St st to end of rnd. Cont in patt as

established until piece meas 17.5 cm from cast-on. Next dec rnd: Purl, decreasing 24 (34, 44) sts evenly around = 84 (92, 100) sts. Purl one more rnd. Divide for front and back: Place last 42 (46, 50) sts worked on holder for back = 42 (46, 50) sts rem for front. **Front:** Work in St st, back and forth in rows across front sts only and shape armholes as foll: Bind off 2 sts at beg of next 4 rows = 32 (36, 40) sts. Cont in St st until piece meas 23 (25, 27) cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape neck: Next row (RS): Bind off center 6 (8, 10) sts. Working each side separately, bind off 3 sts at each neck edge once, 2 sts once, 1 st once = 7 (8, 9) sts rem for each side. Work even until piece meas 26 (28, 30) cm from cast-on. Bind off rem 7 (8, 9) sts for each shoulder. **Back:** Return 42 (46, 50) held back sts to needle and with RS facing, rejoin yarn. Work in St st, back and forth in rows and shape armholes same as for front. **At same time,** on first RS row, divide work at center for back slit. Working each side separately, work even until piece meas 24.5 (26.5, 28.5) cm from cast-on. Shape neck: At each neck edge, bind off 7 (8, 9) sts once, 2 sts once, 1 st once. Bind off rem 7 (8, 9) sts for each shoulder.

Finishing: Pin piece to measurements and block. Sew shoulder seams. **Neck trim:** Pick up and k 48 (52, 56) sts evenly along neck edge. Work in garter st for 2 rows. Bind off all sts. **Armhole trim:** Pick up and k 52 (56, 60) sts evenly around armhole edge. Join for working in rnds. Purl 1 rnd, knit 1 rnd. Bind off all sts. With crochet hook, work 1 row sc along back slit, working a ch-3 button loop at top of left slit edge. Fasten off. Sew on buttons.

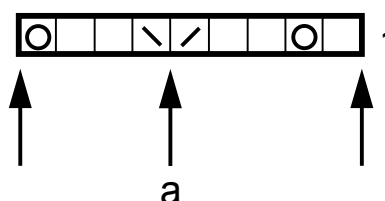
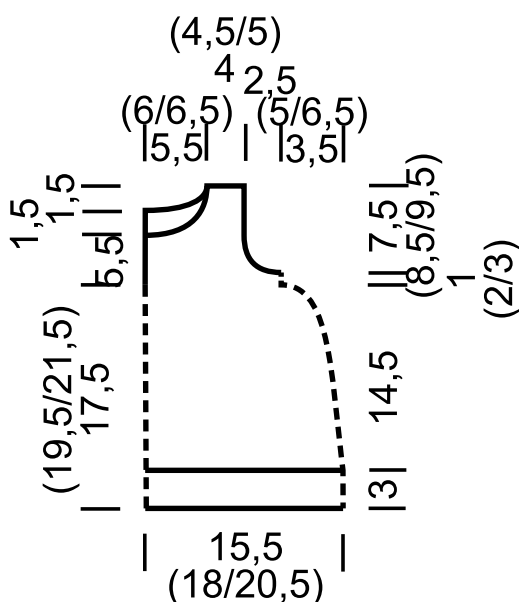


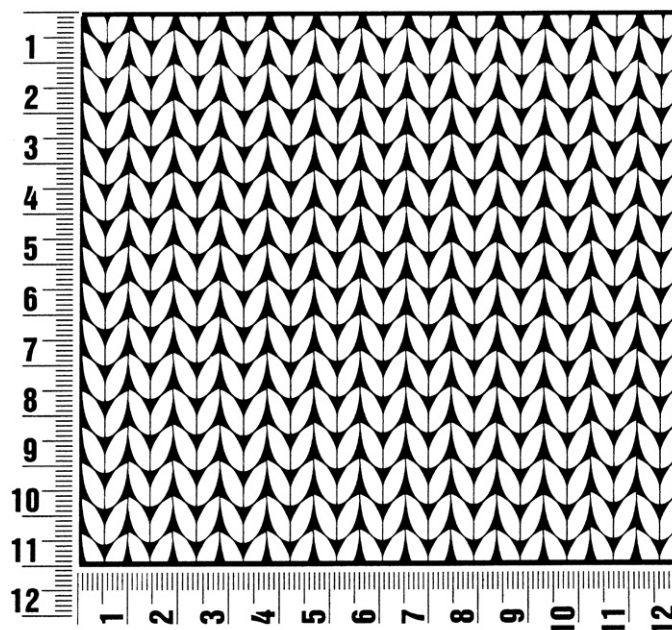
Chart key:

- = k1
- ◻ = yo
- ◻ = k2tog
- ◻ = skp (sl 1 kwise, k1, pass slipped st over knitted st)

Gauge Swatch

Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.



Abbreviations

beg = begin(ning) · **ch** = chain · **cont** = continue · **dec** = decreas(e)(ing) · **inc** = increas(e)(ing) · **k** = knit · **kwise** = as if to knit
meas = measures · **M1L** = lift strand between sts from front to back and knit this strand through the back loop · **M1R** = lift strand between sts from the back and knit this strand through the front loop · **patt** = pattern · **pm** = place marker · **p** = purl
pwise = as if to purl · **rem** = remain(ing) · **rep** = repeat(s) · **rev St st** = reverse stockinette stitch · **rnd(s)** = round(s) · **RS** = right side · **sc** = single crochet · **skp** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 1 stitch, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch · **sk2p** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 2 together, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch · **s2kp** = slip 2 stitches as if to knit, k 1 stitch, pass slipped stitches over knitted stitch · **sl** = slip · **st(s)** = stitch(es) · **St st** = stockinette stitch · **tbl** = through the back loop · **tog** = together · **wyib** = with yarn in back of work · **wyif** = with yarn in front of work · **WS** = wrong side · **yo(s)** = yarn over(s)
