SHAWL · ABOUT BERLIN CHILLY DÉGRADÉ

Design 09 from Filati Tücher & Co. 03

Size approx. 200 cm wide x 75 cm long

Materials: 150 g each of Lana Grossa About Berlin Chilly Dégradé (100% linen; 390 m/150 g) in Blue Dégradé (col 103) and Turquoise Dégradé (col 104). Size 4 mm circular needle, 80 cm long.


Gauge: 10 sts and 24 rows = $10 \times 10 \text{ cm}$ in patt on size 4 mm needles, measured blocked.

Note: Beg Blue **(col 103)** with darkest shade, beg Turquoise **(col 104)** with lightest shade. When changing colors, carry yarn not in use loosely along side edge.

Shawl: With size 4 mm circular needle and Blue **(col 103)** cast on 9 sts. Next inc row (RS): K1, k1f&b, k1, k1f&b, k1 (= center st) and mark with locking st marker, k1f&b, k1, k1f&b, sl 1 pwise wyif = 13 sts. Next inc row (WS): K1, k1f&b, k3, k1f&b, p1 (= center st), k1f&b, k3, k1f&b, sl 1 pwise wyif = 17 sts. ** Drop Blue **(col 103)**, join Turquoise **(col 104)**. Row 1 (RS): * K1, yo; rep from * to end. Row 2 (WS): Knit to center

st, dropping yos in the process, p1, knit to end, dropping yos in the process. Drop Turquoise (col 104), change to Blue (col **103)**. Row 3: K1, k1f&b, k to 1 st before center st, k1f&b, k1, k1f&b, k to last 2 sts, k1f&b, sl 1 pwise wyif = 4 sts increased. Row 4: K1, k1f&b, k to center st, p1, k to last 2 sts, k1f&b, sl 1 pwise wyif = 2 sts increased. Rep these 4 rows from ** until 185 sts are on the needle. *** Drop Blue (col 103), change to Turquoise (col 104). Row 1: * K1, yo twice; rep from * to end. Row 2: Knit to center st, dropping yos in the process, p1, knit to end, dropping yos in the process. Row 3: K1, k1f&b, k to 1 st before center st, k1f&b, k1, k1f&b, k to last 2 sts, k1f&b, sl 1 pwise wyif = 4 sts increased. Row 4: K1, k1f&b, k to center st, p1, k to last 2 sts, k1f&b, sl 1 pwise wyif = 2 sts increased. Rep these 4 rows from *** until 239 sts are on the needle. Break Turquoise (col 104), change to Blue (col 103). Work rows 3 and 4 once more. Next row (RS): * Cast on 2 sts at beg of row, bind off 4 sts, sl rem st from right to left needle; rep from * to end.

Finishing: Carefully weave in all ends. Pin piece to measurements and block.



Gauge Swatch

Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.



Abbreviations

beg = begin(ning) \cdot **ch** = chain \cdot **cont** = continue \cdot **dec** = decreas(e)(ing) \cdot **inc** = increas(e)(ing) \cdot **k** = knit \cdot **kwise** = as if to knit **meas** = measures \cdot **M1L** = lift strand between sts from front to back and knit this strand through the back loop \cdot **M1R** = lift strand between sts from the back and knit this strand through the front loop \cdot **patt** = pattern \cdot **pm** = place marker \cdot **p** = purl **pwise** = as if to purl \cdot **rem** = remain(ing) \cdot **rep** = repeat(s) \cdot **rev St st** = reverse stockinette stitch \cdot **rnd(s)** = round(s) \cdot **RS** = right side \cdot **sc** = single crochet \cdot **skp** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 1 stitch, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch \cdot **sk2p** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 2 together, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch \cdot **s2kp** = slip 2 stitches as if to knit, k 1 stitch, pass slipped stitches over knitted stitch \cdot **s1** = slip \cdot **st(s)** = stitch(es) \cdot **St st** = stockinette stitch \cdot **tbl** = through the back loop \cdot **tog** = together \cdot **wyib** = with yarn in back of work \cdot **wyif** = with yarn in front of work \cdot **WS** = wrong side \cdot **yo(s)** = yarn over(s)
