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# SHAWL · SHADES OF ALPACA SILK

Design 06 from Shades 03



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**Size** approx. 190 cm, measured along inner edge

**Materials:** 200 g of Lana Grossa **Shades of Alpaca Silk** (45% Merino wool, 35% baby alpaca, 20% silk; 680 m/200 g) in Black-Green/Grey/Yellow/Petrol (**col 315**). Size 4 mm needles.

**Gauge:** 21 sts and 26 rows = 10 x 10 cm in garter eyelet patt on size 4 mm needles.

**Garter eyelet patt:** Rows 1 – 11: Knit every row. Row 12: \* Yo, k2tog; rep from \* to end. Rep rows 1 – 12.

**Shawl:** With size 4 mm needles cast on 3 sts. Knit 1 WS row. Row 1: K1, k1f&b in next 2 sts = 5 sts. Row 2: Knit all sts. Row 3: K1, k1f&b in next 2 sts, knit to end = 7 sts. Row 4: Knit all sts. Row 5: K1, k1f&b in next 2 sts, knit to end = 9 sts. Row 6: Knit all sts. Row 7: K1, k1f&b in next 2 sts, knit to end = 11 sts. Row 8: Knit all sts. Row 9: K1, k1f&b in next 2 sts, knit to end = 13 sts. Row 10: Knit all sts. Row 11: K1, k1f&b in next 2 sts, knit to end = 15 sts. Row 12: Bind off 6 sts, \* yo, k2tog; rep from \* as often as st count allows, always ending with at least 3 knit sts = 9 sts. Work rows 1 – 12 a total of 39 times = 237 sts. Knit 1 row across all sts. Picot bind-off: Row 1: Bind off 6 sts, k2, turn work. Row 2: K3, turn work. Row 3: K4, turn work. Row 4: K4, turn work. Row 5: K5, turn work. Row 6: K5, turn work. Row 7: K6, turn work. Row 8: K6, turn work. Row 9: K7, turn work. Row 10: K7, turn work. Row 11: K8, turn work. Row 12: K8, turn work. Rep rows 1 – 12 until all sts are bound off. Fasten off last st.

**Finishing:** Carefully weave in all ends. Pin piece to measurements and block.

## Gauge Swatch

### Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.
