

CAT · BABYSOFT & COOL WOOL BABY

Design 13 – Filati Infanti 16



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Size approx. 10 cm wide, 33 cm long

Materials: 50 g of Lana Grossa **Baby Soft** (60% polyamide, 40% cotton; 150 m/50 g) in White **(col 1)**; **50** g **each** of Lana Grossa **Cool Wool Baby** (100% pure wool; 220 m/50 g) in Pink **(col 216)** and Black **(col 278)**. Size 4 mm needles; tapestry needle; fiber fill.

Garter st: K every row.


Gauge: 16 sts and 34 rows = $10 \times 10 \text{ cm}$ in garter st on size 4 mm needles.

Head: With size 4 mm needles and White cast on 17 sts. Work in garter st for 19 cm. Bind off all sts.

Body: With size 4 mm needles and White cast on 29 sts. Work in garter st for 19.5 cm. Bind off all sts.

Tail: With size 4 mm needles and White cast on 8 sts. Work in garter st for 14.5 cm. Bind off all sts.

Finishing: Fold left half of cast-on edge up, so that ■ matches ■ on schematic. Sew left half of cast-on edge to left side edge. Fold right half of cast-on edge up, so that o matches o on schematic. Sew right half of cast-on edge to right side edge. Fold left half of bound-off edge down, so that □ matches □ on schematic. Sew left half of bound-off edge to left side edge. Fold right half of bound-off edge down, so that ● matches ● on schematic. Sew right half of bound-off edge to right side edge. Stuff with fiber fill, close small center seam. Fold head in half, sew short side edges tog. Stuff with fiber fill. Sew across left and right top corner, sewing through both thicknesses. Embroider face. Cinch bottom edge tog slightly, sew bottom edge of head to body. Fold tail in half. Sew the two halves of the cast-on edge tog, then sew long side edges tog. Stuff with fiber fill. Sew tail to body.






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Gauge Swatch

Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.



Abbreviations

beg = begin(ning) \cdot **ch** = chain \cdot **cont** = continue \cdot **dec** = decreas(e)(ing) \cdot **inc** = increas(e)(ing) \cdot **k** = knit \cdot **kwise** = as if to knit **meas** = measures \cdot **M1L** = lift strand between sts from front to back and knit this strand through the back loop \cdot **M1R** = lift strand between sts from the back and knit this strand through the front loop \cdot **patt** = pattern \cdot **pm** = place marker \cdot **p** = purl **pwise** = as if to purl \cdot **rem** = remain(ing) \cdot **rep** = repeat(s) \cdot **rev St st** = reverse stockinette stitch \cdot **rnd(s)** = round(s) \cdot **RS** = right side \cdot **sc** = single crochet \cdot **skp** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 1 stitch, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch \cdot **sk2p** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 2 together, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch \cdot **s2kp** = slip 2 stitches as if to knit, k 1 stitch, pass slipped stitches over knitted stitch \cdot **s1** = slip \cdot **st(s)** = stitch(es) \cdot **St st** = stockinette stitch \cdot **tbl** = through the back loop \cdot **tog** = together \cdot **wyib** = with yarn in back of work \cdot **wyif** = with yarn in front of work \cdot **WS** = wrong side \cdot **yo(s)** = yarn over(s)
