# Design 17 – Filati Infanti 16

**Size** 56/62 (68/74, 80/86)

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

Materials: 100 (100, 150) g of Lana Grossa Fourseason (45% extrafine organic Merino wool, 40% organic cotton, 15% recycled cashmere; 105 m/50 g) in Mint (col 4). Size 4.5 mm needles; size 4.5 mm circular needle, 40 cm long; cable needle [cn]; two 12 mm buttons.

**Seed stitch:** Row 1: K1, p1. Row 2: Purl the knit sts and knit the purl sts. Rep row 2 for seed stitch.

St st: K on RS, p on WS.

Rev St st: P on RS, k on WS.

**Cable A and B:** Work according to charts. Numbers at right edge of charts indicate RS rows; on WS rows, work sts as they appear. Work rows 1 - 20 of <u>cable A</u> once, then rep rows 5 - 20; rep rows 1 - 16 of <u>cable B</u> throughout.


**Gauge:** 20 sts and 24 rows =  $10 \times 10$  cm in St st and rev St st on size 4.5 mm needles.

Jacket: Back and fronts are worked in one piece to underarm. With size 4.5 mm circular needle cast on 76 (84, 92) sts = 20 (22, 24) sts for each front, 36 (40, 44) sts for back. Work in seed st for 2 cm, ending with a WS row. Next row (RS): Selvage st, 3 sts in seed st, 2 sts in rev St st, cable A over 4 sts, 4 sts in rev St st, cable B over 4 sts, 6 (10, 14) sts in rev St st, cable A over 4 sts, 4 sts in rev St st, cable B over 4 sts, 4 sts in rev St st, cable A over 4 sts, 4 sts in rev St st, cable B over 4 sts, 6 (10, 14) sts in rev St st, cable A over 4 sts, 4 sts in rev St st, cable B over 4 sts, 2 sts in rev St st, 3 sts in seed st, selvage st. Cont in patt as established until piece meas 15.5 (16.5, 17.5) cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Next row (RS): Selvage st, 3 sts in seed st, 68 (76, 84) sts in rev St st, 3 sts in seed st, selvage st. Cont in patt as established until piece meas 16.5 (17.5, 18.5) cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Divide for fronts and back: Next row (RS): Selvage st, 3

sts in seed st, 2 sts in rev St st, cable B over 4 sts, 2 sts in rev St st, 7 (9, 11) sts in St st, selvage st and turn, leaving rem sts on hold. Right front: Cont in patt as established until piece meas 22 (24, 26) cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape neck: At beg of RS rows bind off 6 (7, 8) sts 1 time, 3 sts 1 time, 2 sts 1 time, 1 st 1 time. Bind off rem 8 (9, 10) shoulder sts. Back: Return 36 (40, 44) held back sts to needle and with RS facing rejoin yarn. Next row (RS): Selvage st, work in St st to last st, selvage st. Cont in St st until piece meas 23.5 (25.5, 27.5) cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape neck: Next row (RS): Bind off center 14 (16, 18) sts. Working each side separately, bind off 2 sts at each neck edge 1 time, 1 st 1 time. Bind off rem 8 (9, 10) sts for each shoulder. Left front: Return 20 (22, 24) held left front sts to needle and with RS facing rejoin yarn. Complete as given for right front, reversing all shaping and working two buttonholes at end of RS rows when piece meas 17 (19, 21) cm and 20 (22, 24) cm from cast-on as foll: Patt to last 3 sts, [yo, k2tog] for buttonhole, selvage st.

**Sleeves:** With size 4.5 mm needles cast on 34 (36, 38) sts. Work in seed st for 2 cm, ending with a WS row. Next row (RS): Selvage st, 10 (11, 12) sts in rev St st, cable B over 4 sts, 4 sts in rev St st, cable A over 4 sts, 10 (11, 12) sts in rev St st, selvage st. Cont in patt as established and shape sleeve as foll: Inc 1 st at each end of 13 (11, 11)th row worked in patt, then every -- row 0 time (then every 10th row 1 time / then every 10th row 1 time, then every 8th row 1 time) = 36 (40, 44) sts. Work even until piece meas 13 (15, 17) cm from cast-on. Bind off all sts.

**Finishing:** Pin pieces to measurements and block. Sew shoulder seams. <u>Neckband:</u> With size 4.5 mm circular needle, beginning 4 sts in from right front edge and ending 4 sts in from left front edge, pick up and k 47 (51, 55) sts evenly along neck edge. Work in seed st for 2 cm. Bind off all sts. Set sleeves into armholes. Sew sleeve seams. Sew on buttons.

= sl 2 sts to cn and hold in front of work, k2, then k2 from cn



## Gauge Swatch

#### Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.
