

BATHROBE · BABY SOFT

Design 43 – Filati Infanti 16



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Size 68/74 (80/86, 92/98, 104/110)

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

Materials: 150 (200, 200, 250) g of Lana Grossa Baby Soft (60% polyamide, 40% cotton; 150 m/50 g) in Beige (col 21) and 100 (150, 150, 200) g in White (col 1). Size 3.5 mm needles; size 3.5 mm circular needle, 80 cm long; one set size 3.5 mm double-pointed needles [dpns].

Garter st: K every row.

Garter st in rnds: Knit 1 rnd, purl 1 rnd alternately throughout.

St st: K on RS, p on WS.

Stripe patt in rows: 7 rows Beige, * 4 rows White, 8 rows Beige; rep from * throughout.

Stripe patt in rnds: * 8 rnds Beige, 4 rnds White; rep from * throughout.

Gauge: 24 sts and 40 rows/rnds = 10×10 cm in garter st on size 3.5 mm needles.

Bathrobe: Worked in one piece to underarm. With size 3.5 mm needles and Beige cast on 156 (166, 176, 184) sts = 37 (40, 42, 44) sts for each front and 82 (86, 92, 96) sts for back. Beg with a WS row work in garter st and stripe patt until piece meas 24 (25, 26, 27) cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Divide for fronts and back: Next row (RS): Patt across 37 (40, 42, 44) right front sts and turn, leaving rem sts on hold. Right front: Cont in patt until piece meas 35 (37, 39, 41) cm from cast-on, ending with a RS row. Next row (WS): Bind off 18 (19, 21, 22) sts, place rem 19 (21, 21, 22) sts on holder. Back: Return 82 (86, 92, 96) held back sts to needle and with RS facing, rejoin yarn. Work even until piece meas 35 (37, 39, 41) cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Next row (RS): Bind off 18 (19, 21, 22) sts, work across next 46 (48, 50, 52) sts and put on holder, bind off rem 18 (19, 21, 22) sts. Left front: Return 37 (40, 42, 44) held left front sts to needle and with RS facing, rejoin yarn. Complete as given for right front, reversing all shaping.

Finishing 1: Sew shoulder seams.

Sleeves: Sleeves are picked up around armhole edge and worked in rnds to cuff edge. With size 3.5 mm dpns and Beige, beg and end at center of underarm, pick up and k 52 (58, 62, 68) sts evenly around armhole edge. Arrange sts evenly on 4 needles = 13 (14-15-14-15 / 15-16-15-16 / 17) sts per needle, place beg of rnd marker and join for working in rnds. Work in garter st and stripe patt for 9 rnds. Shape sleeve: Next dec rnd: Skp, patt to last 2 sts, k2tog = 50 (56, 60, 66) sts. Cont in patt, rep dec rnd every 10th rnd 5 (6, 6, 2) times, then every 8th rnd 0 (0, 1, 7) times = 40 (44, 46, 48)


sts. Cont in patt until piece meas 18 (20, 22, 24) cm from pick-up rnd. Bind off all sts.

Belt: With size 3.5 mm dpn and Beige cast on 8 sts and work as foll: * Next row (RS): With 2nd dpn, k8, do not turn. SI sts back to beg of needle to work next row from RS, pulling yarn tightly from end of row; rep from * until belt measures 110 (115, 120, 125) cm. Bind off.

Belt loops: Make 2 alike. With size 3.5 mm dpn and Beige cast on 4 sts and work as foll: * Next row (RS): With 2nd dpn, k4, do not turn. SI sts back to beg of needle to work next row from RS, pulling yarn tightly from end of row; rep from * until belt loop measures 10 cm. Bind off.

Hood: Return 19 (21, 21, 22) right front sts, 46 (48, 50, 52) back sts and 19 (21, 21, 22) left front sts from holders to size 3.5 mm circular needle = 84 (90, 92, 96) sts and with RS facing rejoin yarn. Work in garter st and cont stripe patt for 12.5 (13.5, 14.5, 15.5) cm, ending with a WS row. Next row (RS): Patt over 57 (61, 63, 66) sts, k2tog, turn. Next row (WS): Patt over 31 (33, 35, 37) sts, k2tog, turn. Next row (WS): Patt to 1 st before gap, k2tog, turn. Next row (WS): Patt to 1 st before gap, k2tog, turn. Rep last 2 rows to end of row and 32 (34, 36, 38) center sts rem. Bind off rem 32 (34, 36, 38) sts.

Finishing 2: Front edging: With size 3.5 mm circular needle and Beige, pick up and k 260 (276, 292, 310) sts evenly along right front, hood and left front edge. Work in St st for 3 cm. Bind off all sts. Fold edging in half to WS and sew down. Sew belt loops to sides, approx. 15 (16, 17, 18) cm up from bottom edge. Thread belt through belt loops.






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Gauge Swatch

Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.



Abbreviations
