

HEDGEHOG • BABY SOFT \& STAR
Design 84 - Filati Infanti 16

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Size approx. 13 cm long, 6.5 cm tall
Materials: $\mathbf{5 0} \mathbf{g}$ of Lana Grossa Baby Soft (60\% polyamide, $40 \%$ cotton; $150 \mathrm{~m} / 50 \mathrm{~g}$ ) in Beige (col 21); 50 g each of Lana Grossa Star (100\% cotton; $90 \mathrm{~m} / 50 \mathrm{~g}$ ) in Natural (col 27) and Black (col 20). Size 4 mm crochet hook; two animal eye buttons; fiber fill.

Make bobble [mb]: Dc5tog in same st.
Gauges: With size 4 mm hook: 22 sc and 20 rnds $=10 \times 10$ $\mathrm{cm} ; 17$ sts and $14.5 \mathrm{rnds}=10 \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}$ in bobble patt.

Hedgehog: Work sc in continuous rnds without joining. Place marker to indicate beg of rnds. Move marker up as work progresses. With Natural, make an adjustable ring. Rnd 1: 6 sc into ring. Rnd 2: [Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc] 3 times $=9 \mathrm{sc}$. Rnd 3: Sc around. Rnd 4: Sc in next 4 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in next 4 sc $=11$ sc. Rnd 5: Sc in next 5 sc, 3 sc in next sc, $s c$ in next $5 \mathrm{sc}=13 \mathrm{sc}$. Rnd 6: Sc in next $6 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc, sc in next 6 sc $=15$ sc. Rnd 7: Sc in next 6 sc, 2 sc in next 3 $\mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{sc}$ in next $6 \mathrm{sc}=18 \mathrm{sc}$. Rnd 8: Sc in next $4 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc , sc in next $8 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc, sc in next $3 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next $\mathrm{sc}=21 \mathrm{sc}$. Rnd 9: [Sc in next $6 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc] 3 times $=$ 24 sc. Rnd 10: [Sc in next 7 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 3 times $=27$ sc. Rnd 11: [Sc in next $8 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc] 3 times $=30 \mathrm{sc}$. Break Natural, join Beige and beg bobble patt: Rnd 12: Sc in next 5 sc , [sc in next sc, mb] 10 times, sc in next $5 \mathrm{sc}=30$ sts. Rnd 13: [Sc in next 4 sts, 2 sc in next st] 6 times $=36$ sc. Rnd 14: Sc in next 6 sc, [sc in next sc, mb] 12 times, sc in next 6 sc $=36$ sc. Rnd 15: [Sc in next 5 sts, 2 sc in next st] 6 times $=42$ sc. Rnd 16: Sc in next 8 sc, [sc in next sc, mb] 14 times, 6 in next 6 sc $=42$ sts. Rnd 17: Sc around. Rnd 18: Sc in next $8 \mathrm{sc},[\mathrm{mb}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc] 14 times, sc in next $6 \mathrm{sc},=$ 42 sts. Rnd 19: Sc around. Rnd 20: Sc in next 8 sc, [sc in next sc, mb] 14 times, sc in next 6 sc, $=42$ sts. Rnd 21: [Sc in next 5 sts, sc2tog] 6 times $=36 \mathrm{sc}$. Rnd 22: Sc in next 9 sc , [mb, sc in next sc] 12 times, sc in next 3 sc = 36 sts. Rnd 23: [Sc in next 4 sts, sc2tog] 6 times $=30$ sc. Rnd 24: Sc in next 7 sc , [mb, sc in next sc] 10 times, sc in next $3 \mathrm{sc}=30$ sts. Rnd 25: [Sc in next 3 sts, sc2tog] 6 times $=24$ sc. Rnd 26: Sc in next 6 sc, [sc in next sc, mb] 8 times, sc in next 2 sc $=24$ sts. Rnd 27: [Sc in next 2 sts, sc2tog] 6 times $=18$ sc. Rnd 28: [Sc in next sc, sc2tog] 6 times $=12 \mathrm{sc}$. Fasten off. Stuff piece with fiber fill. Run yarn tail through sts on last rnd and cinch tight.

Finishing: Sew on eyes; embroider snout.

## Gauge Swatch

## Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. $12 \mathrm{~cm} \times 12 \mathrm{~cm}$. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm . If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.
