

# PUMPKIN • BABY SOFT \& STAR Design 82 - Filati Infanti 16 

Size approx. 48.5 cm in circumference, 11.5 cm tall
Materials: $\mathbf{5 0}$ g of Lana Grossa Baby Soft (60\% polyamide, 40\% cotton; 150 m/50 g) in Ecru (col 2); 50 g each of Lana Grossa Star (100\% cotton; $90 \mathrm{~m} / 50 \mathrm{~g}$ ) in Natural (col 27) and Taupe (col 59). Size 4 mm crochet hook; fiber fill.

Gauge: 22 sc and $20 \mathrm{rnds}=10 \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}$.
Pumpkin: Work sc in continuous rnds without joining. Place marker to indicate beg of rnds. Move marker up as work progresses. With Ecru, make an adjustable ring. Rnd 1: 6 sc into ring. Rnd 2: 2 sc in each sc around $=12 \mathrm{sc}$. Rnd 3: [Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6 times $=18$ sc. Rnd 4: [Sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6 times $=24$ sc. Rnd 5: [Sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6 times $=30$ sc. Rnd 6: [Sc in next $4 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next $\mathrm{sc}] 6$ times $=36 \mathrm{sc}$. Rnd 7: [Sc in next $5 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc] 6 times $=42$ sc. Rnd 8: [Sc in next $6 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc] 6 times $=48 \mathrm{sc}$. Rnd 9: [Sc in next $7 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc] 6 times $=54$ sc. Rnd 10: [Sc in next $8 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc] 6 times $=60 \mathrm{sc}$. Rnd 11: [Sc in next $9 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc] 6 times $=66 \mathrm{sc}$. Rnd 12: [Sc in next $10 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc] 6 times $=72 \mathrm{sc}$. Rnd 13: [Sc in next $11 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc] 6 times $=78 \mathrm{sc}$. Rnd 14: [Sc in next $12 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc] 6 times $=84 \mathrm{sc}$. Rnds $15-21$ :

Sc around. Rnd 22: [Sc in next 12 sc, sc2tog] 6 times $=78$ sc. Rnd 23: [Sc in next 11 sc, sc2tog] 6 times $=72$ sc. Stuff piece with fiber fill. Rnd 24: [Sc in next 10 sc, sc2tog] 6 times $=66$ sc. Rnd 25: [Sc in next 9 sc, sc2tog] 6 times $=60 \mathrm{sc}$. Rnd 26: [Sc in next 8 sc, sc2tog] 6 times $=54$ sc. Rnd 27: [Sc in next $7 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{sc} 2 \mathrm{tog}$ ] 6 times $=48 \mathrm{sc}$. Rnd 28: [Sc in next 6 sc , sc2tog] 6 times $=42$ sc. Rnd 29: [Sc in next 5 sc, sc2tog] 6 times $=36$ sc. Rnd 30: [Sc in next 4 sc, sc2tog] 6 times $=30$ sc. Stuff piece with fiber fill. Rnd 31: [Sc in next $3 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{sc} 2 \mathrm{tog}$ ] 6 times $=24$ sc. Rnd 32: [Sc in next 2 sc, sc2tog] 6 times = 18 sc. Rnd 33: [Sc in next sc, sc2tog] 6 times $=12$ sc. Rnd 34: Sc2tog around $=6$ sc. Fasten off. Stuff piece with fiber fill. Stem: Work sc in continuous rnds without joining. Place marker to indicate beg of rnds. Move marker up as work progresses. With Taupe, make an adjustable ring. Rnd 1: 6 sc into ring. Rnd 2: [Sc in next $2 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc$] 2$ times $=8 \mathrm{sc}$. Rnds 3-7: Sc around. Rnd 8: [Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc] 4 times $=12 \mathrm{sc}$. Rnd 9: [Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6 times $=18 \mathrm{sc}$. Fasten off. Stuff piece with fiber fill.

Finishing: Create 6 segments by wrapping strands of Natural around pumpkin, pulling strand tight, then tacking strand down at center. Sew stem to center of pumpkin.

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## Gauge Swatch

## Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. $12 \mathrm{~cm} \times 12 \mathrm{~cm}$. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm . If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.
