

JACKET • ABOUT BERLIN BULKY

Design 03 – Filati Lookbook 08



Size 36/38 (40/42, 44)

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

Materials: 950 (1000, 1050) g of Lana Grossa About Berlin Bulky (50% cotton, 50% Micromodal; 47 m/50 g) in Light Grey (col 6). Size 10 mm needles.

St st: K on RS, p on WS.

Rev St st: P on RS, k on WS.

Two-stitch selvage: On RS row, sl 1 pwise wyib, k1, patt to last 2 sts, k1, sl 1 pwise wyib. On WS row, p1, sl 1 pwise wyif, patt to last 2 sts, sl 1 pwise wyif, p1.

Slip stitch selvage: On RS row: Ktbl first st, sl last st pwise wyib; on WS row: Ptbl first st, sl last st pwise wyif.

Full-fashion decrease 1: At beg of RS row, two-stitch selvage, p2tog; at end of RS row, work to last 4 sts, p2tog, two-stitch selvage.

Full-fashion decrease 2: At beg of RS row, two-stitch selvage, 1 st in rev St st, skp; at end of RS row, work to last 5 sts, k2tog, 1 st in rev St st, two-stitch selvage.

Full-fashion increase: On RS row, M1L, 2 sts in from each edge.

Gauge: 9 sts and 15 rows = $10 \times 10 \text{ cm}$ in St st and rev St st on size 10 mm needles.

Back: With size 10 mm needles cast on 15 (19, 23) sts. Purl 1 WS row. Working a two-stitch selvage at each edge, work in St st for 12 rows, ending with a WS row. Maintaining two-stitch selvage, work in rev St st and shape sides as foll: Working full-fashion inc, inc 1 st at each end of 5th row worked in rev St st, then every alt 2nd and 4th row 14 times = 45 (49, 53) sts. Work even until piece meas 30 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape armholes: Working full-fashion dec 1, dec 1 st at each end of next 4 RS rows = 37 (41 (45) sts. Work even until piece meas 47 (48, 49) cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape neck: Next row (RS): Bind off center 11 sts. Working each side separately, bind off 2 sts at each neck edge 1 time. Bind off rem 11 (13, 15) sts for each shoulder

Left front: With size 10 mm needles cast on 63 (65, 67) sts. Purl 1 WS row. Next row (RS): Two-stitch selvage, 1 st in rev St st, 57 (59, 61) sts in St st, 1 st in rev St st, two-stitch selvage. Cont in patt as established and shape side as foll: Working full-fashion dec 2, dec 1 st at beg of 6th row from cast-on, then every alt 2nd and 4th row 14 times = 48 (50, 52) sts. Work even until piece meas 30 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape armhole: Working full-fashion dec 1, dec 1 st at beg of next 4 RS rows = 44 (46, 48) sts. Work even until piece meas 49 (50, 51) cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Next row (RS): Bind off 11 (13, 15) sts, work rem 33 sts in St st. **Collar**: Next row (WS): Work in St st to end of row, backloop cast on 7 sts = 40 sts. Cont in St st until collar meas 12 cm from shoulder bind-off. Bind off all sts as foll: * K1, k2tog tbl, sl both sts back to left needle; rep from * to end.

Right front: Work same as left front, reversing all shaping.

Sleeves: With size 10 mm needles cast on 27 sts. Purl 1 WS row. Next row (RS): Two-stitch selvage, 1 st in rev St st, 21 sts in St st, 1 st in rev St st, two-stitch selvage. Cont in patt as established until piece meas 8 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Maintaining two-stitch selvage, work in rev St st across all sts and shape sleeve as foll: Working full-fashion inc, inc 1 st at each end of 9 (9, 7)th row worked in rev St st, then every 8th row 4 times (then every 8th row 2 times, then every 6th row 3 times / then every 6th row 6 times) = 37 (39, 41) sts. Work even until piece meas 40 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Working a slip st selvage at each edge, cont in rev St st and shape sleeve cap as foll: Bind off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows, then 1 st at beg of next 8 rows, [work 2 rows even, bind off 1 st at beg of next 2 rows] 2 times, then bind off 1 st at beg of next 4 rows, 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows (then 1 st at beg of next 8 rows, work 2 rows even, bind off 1 st at beg of next 10 rows, 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows / then 1 st at beg of next 20 rows, 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows). Bind off rem 11 sts.


Pockets: With size 10 mm needles cast on 23 sts for left pocket. Next row (RS): Two-stitch selvage, work in rev St st to end. Cont in patt as established until piece meas 19 cm from cast-on. Bind off all sts. Work right pocket in same way, reversing patt placement.

Finishing: Pin pieces to measurements and block. Sew shoulder seams. With WS facing (so seam forms a ridge on RS), sew collar sts tog with mattress st, then sew collar to back neck edge. Sew in sleeves. Sew side and sleeve seams. Referring to schematic for placement (arrow shows direction of work) sew pockets to fronts, approx. 5 cm up from cast-on edge and 9 cm in from front edge.

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


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Gauge Swatch

Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.



Abbreviations

beg = begin(ning) \cdot **ch** = chain \cdot **cont** = continue \cdot **dec** = decreas(e)(ing) \cdot **inc** = increas(e)(ing) \cdot **k** = knit \cdot **kwise** = as if to knit **meas** = measures \cdot **M1L** = lift strand between sts from front to back and knit this strand through the back loop \cdot **M1R** = lift strand between sts from the back and knit this strand through the front loop \cdot **patt** = pattern \cdot **pm** = place marker \cdot **p** = purl **pwise** = as if to purl \cdot **rem** = remain(ing) \cdot **rep** = repeat(s) \cdot **rev St st** = reverse stockinette stitch \cdot **rnd(s)** = round(s) \cdot **RS** = right side \cdot **sc** = single crochet \cdot **skp** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 1 stitch, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch \cdot **sk2p** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 2 together, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch \cdot **s2kp** = slip 2 stitches as if to knit, k 1 stitch, pass slipped stitches over knitted stitch \cdot **s1** = slip \cdot **st(s)** = stitch(es) \cdot **St st** = stockinette stitch \cdot **tbl** = through the back loop \cdot **tog** = together \cdot **wyib** = with yarn in back of work \cdot **wyif** = with yarn in front of work \cdot **WS** = wrong side \cdot **yo(s)** = yarn over(s)
