

VEST • ABOUT BERLIN FUNKY

Design 08 – Filati Lookbook 08



Size 36/38 (40/42, 44)

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

Materials: 300 (350, 400) g of Lana Grossa About Berlin Funky (83% cotton, 17% polyamide; 115 m/50 g) in Gentian Blue (col 11). Size 5.5 mm needles.

Half-brioche rib: Row 1 (RS): Selvage st, * k1, p1; rep from * to last 2 sts, k1, selvage st. Row 2 (WS): Selvage st, * make a yo, then sl next st pwise, k1; rep from * to last 2 sts, make a yo, then sl next st pwise, selvage st. Row 3 (RS): Selvage st, * ktog slipped st with its yo, p1; rep from * to last 2 sts, ktog slipped st with its yo, selvage st. Work rows 1 – 3 once, then rep rows 2 and 3. Note: Slipped st and yo count as 1 st.

Two-stitch selvage: On RS row, sl 1 pwise wyib, k1, patt to last 2 sts, k1, sl 1 pwise wyib. On WS row, p1, sl 1 pwise wyif, patt to last 2 sts, sl 1 pwise wyif, p1.

St st: K on RS, p on WS.

Full-fashion increase: On RS row, M1R or M1L as needed to stay in patt, 2 sts in from each edge.

Gauge: 12 sts and 30 rows = $10 \times 10 \text{ cm}$ in half-brioche rib on size 5.5 mm needles.


Back: With size 5.5 mm needles cast on 69 (73, 77) sts. Working a two-stitch selvage at each edge, work in half-brioche rib and shape sides as foll: Working full-fashion inc, inc 1 st at each end of 7th row, then every 8th row 9 times = 89 (93, 97) sts. Work increased sts into patt. Work even until piece meas 47 (48, 49) cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape shoulders/overarms: Bind off 2 sts at beg of next 34 rows, 1 st at beg of next 2 rows (2 sts at beg of next 34 rows, 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows, 4 sts at beg of next 2 rows). Bind off rem 19 sts.

Pocket lining: Make 2 alike. With size 5.5 mm needles cast on 18 sts. Work in St st until piece meas 12 cm from cast-on, ending with a RS row. Cut yarn and place sts on holder.

Left front: With size 5.5 mm needles cast on 35 (37, 39) sts. Working a two-stitch selvage at each edge, work in half-brioche rib, work incs for side shaping at right edge same as for back = 45 (47, 49) sts. At same time, when piece meas 15 cm from cast-on, work pocket opening as foll: Next row (RS): Two-stitch selvage, patt over 7 sts, bind off 18 sts for pocket opening, patt to end. Next row (WS): Patt to bound-off sts, with WS of pocket lining facing, work half-brioche rib over 18 sts of lining, patt to end. Cont in patt across all sts until piece meas 47 (48, 49) cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape shoulder/overarm: At beg of RS rows, bind off 2 sts 17 times, 1 st 1 time (2 sts 17 times, 3 sts 1 time / 2 sts 16 times, 3 sts 1 time, 4 sts 1 time) = 10 sts rem for collar. Collar: Next row (RS): Work in patt across collar sts. Next row (WS): Work in patt across collar sts, backloop cast on 1 st and work as selvage st = 11 sts. Work even until collar meas 8 cm from last shoulder bind-off row, ending with a WS row. Place sts on holder.

Right front: Work same as left front, reversing all shaping.

Finishing: Pin pieces to measurements and block. Sew shoulder/overarm seams. Join collar sts with 3-needle bindoff, then sew collar to back neck edge. Sew side seams, leaving top 20 (21, 22) cm open for armholes. Sew pocket linings in place on WS.



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


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Gauge Swatch

Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.



Abbreviations

beg = begin(ning) \cdot **ch** = chain \cdot **cont** = continue \cdot **dec** = decreas(e)(ing) \cdot **inc** = increas(e)(ing) \cdot **k** = knit \cdot **kwise** = as if to knit **meas** = measures \cdot **M1L** = lift strand between sts from front to back and knit this strand through the back loop \cdot **M1R** = lift strand between sts from the back and knit this strand through the front loop \cdot **patt** = pattern \cdot **pm** = place marker \cdot **p** = purl **pwise** = as if to purl \cdot **rem** = remain(ing) \cdot **rep** = repeat(s) \cdot **rev St st** = reverse stockinette stitch \cdot **rnd(s)** = round(s) \cdot **RS** = right side \cdot **sc** = single crochet \cdot **skp** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 1 stitch, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch \cdot **sk2p** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 2 together, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch \cdot **s2kp** = slip 2 stitches as if to knit, k 1 stitch, pass slipped stitches over knitted stitch \cdot **s1** = slip \cdot **st(s)** = stitch(es) \cdot **St st** = stockinette stitch \cdot **tbl** = through the back loop \cdot **tog** = together \cdot **wyib** = with yarn in back of work \cdot **wyif** = with yarn in front of work \cdot **WS** = wrong side \cdot **yo(s)** = yarn over(s)
