

PULLOVER · CERTO

Design 16 - Linea Pura 13



Size 34/36 (38/40, 42/44)

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

Materials: 350 (400, 450) g of Lana Grossa **Certo** (100% GOTS cotton; 115 m/50 g) in Pink **(col 3)**. Size 5 and 6 mm needles; size 6 mm circular needle, 100 cm long; size 5 mm circular needle, 80 cm long; size 3.5 mm crochet hook.

Slip garter selvage: On every row: SI first st kwise, k last st.

Slip stitch selvage: On every row: K first st, sl last st pwise wyif.

Rib patt: K2, p2.

St st: K on RS, p on WS.

Eyelet rows: Work according to chart A. Number at right edge of chart indicates RS row, number at left edge of chart indicates WS row. Rep rows 1 and 2.

Mesh patt: Work according to chart B. Number at right edge of chart indicates RS row, number at left edge of chart indicates WS row. Work to patt rep, work 2 sts between arrows for patt rep, work to end of chart. Rep rows 1 and 2.

Gauges: On size 6 mm needles: 16.5 sts and $25 \text{ rows} = 10 \times 10 \text{ cm}$ in St st; 13 sts and $22.5 \text{ rows} = 10 \times 10 \text{ cm}$ in mesh patt.

Construction notes: Left half of back and front is worked first and side to side. Right half of back and front is worked next, also side to side. A front and back center panel is worked next, both from the bottom up. Front panels are sewn between the two halves during finishing. Arrows on schematic show direction of work.

Left half: With size 5 mm needles cast on 46 (50, 54) sts. Next row (RS): Slip garter selvage, k1, * p2, k2; rep from * to last 4 sts, p2, k1, slip garter selvage. Cont in rib patt as established for 5 more rows and piece meas 2 cm from cast-on, increasing 3 sts evenly across last WS row = 49 (53, 57) sts. Change to size 6 mm needles. Next row (RS): Slip garter selvage, mesh patt according to chart B over next 18 (20, 22) sts, 4 sts in St st, eyelet rows according to chart A over next 3 sts, 4 sts in St st, mesh patt according to chart B over next 18 (20, 22) sts, slip garter selvage. Cont in patt as established for 15 more rows and piece meas 7 cm from end of rib patt. Cont in patt, cast on 66 sts at beg of next 2 rows for back and front side edge = 181 (185, 189) sts. Work increased sts in St st, change to size 6 mm circular needle as necessary. Working a slip st selvage at each edge, work in St st for 20 (24, 26) rows and body meas 8.5 (10.5, 12.5) cm. Divide for back and front: Next row (RS): Bind off center st. Working each side separately and working a slip st selvage at each neck edge, work even for 21 more rows and piece meas 9 cm from divide. Bind off all sts.

Right half: Work same as left half.

Center panel: Make two. With size 6 mm needles cast on 15 sts. Next row (RS): Slip garter selvage, 5 sts in St st, eyelet rows according to chart A over next 3 sts, 5 sts in St st, slip garter selvage. Cont in patt as established for 143 (145, 149) more rows and piece meas 57.5 (58.5, 59.5) cm from cast-on. Bind off all sts.

Finishing: Pin pieces to measurements and block. Sew side edges of center panels to bound-off edges of left and right half. Sew side and sleeve seams. <u>Bottom ribbing</u>: With size 5 mm circular needle and RS facing, pick up and k 152 (168, 180) sts evenly around bottom edge of body. Place beg of rnd marker and join for working in rnds. Work rib patt in rnds for 6 rnds and ribbing meas 2 cm from pick-up row. Bind off all sts in rib. <u>Neck trim</u>: With size 3.5 mm crochet hook work 1 rnd sc around neck edge.





Chart key:

- st over knitted st






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Gauge Swatch

Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.



Abbreviations

beg = begin(ning) \cdot **ch** = chain \cdot **cont** = continue \cdot **dec** = decreas(e)(ing) \cdot **inc** = increas(e)(ing) \cdot **k** = knit \cdot **kwise** = as if to knit **meas** = measures \cdot **M1L** = lift strand between sts from front to back and knit this strand through the back loop \cdot **M1R** = lift strand between sts from the back and knit this strand through the front loop \cdot **patt** = pattern \cdot **pm** = place marker \cdot **p** = purl **pwise** = as if to purl \cdot **rem** = remain(ing) \cdot **rep** = repeat(s) \cdot **rev St st** = reverse stockinette stitch \cdot **rnd(s)** = round(s) \cdot **RS** = right side \cdot **sc** = single crochet \cdot **skp** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 1 stitch, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch \cdot **sk2p** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 2 together, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch \cdot **s2kp** = slip 2 stitches as if to knit, k 1 stitch, pass slipped stitches over knitted stitch \cdot **s1** = slip \cdot **st(s)** = stitch(es) \cdot **St st** = stockinette stitch \cdot **tbl** = through the back loop \cdot **tog** = together \cdot **wyib** = with yarn in back of work \cdot **wyif** = with yarn in front of work \cdot **WS** = wrong side \cdot **yo(s)** = yarn over(s)
