Size 36/38 (40/42)

Instructions are given for smaller size. Figure in parenthesis refers to larger size. When only one figure is given, it applies to both sizes.

Materials: 400 (450) g of Lana Grossa **Certo** (100% GOTS cotton; 115 m/50 g) in Orange **(col 1)**. Size 6 mm needles; size 5.5 mm circular needle, 60 cm long; size 5, 5.5 and 6 mm circular needles, each 120 cm long.

Selvage stitches: On every row: SI first st kwise, k last st.

Chart patt: Numbers at right edge of chart indicate RS rows, numbers at left edge of chart indicate WS rows. Work to patt rep, work sts between arrows for patt rep, work to end of chart. Rep rows 1 - 8.

St st: K on RS, p on WS; k every rnd.

Rev St st: P on RS, k on WS; p every rnd.

Welt patt: Work 3 rows/rnds in St st, 3 rows/rnds in rev St st alternately throughout.

Gauge: 14 sts and 26 rows = 10×10 cm in chart patt on size 6 mm needles.

Back: With size 6 mm needles cast on 63 (71) sts. Knit 1 WS row. Work in chart patt for 14 rows and piece meas 6 cm from cast-on. Shape sleeves: Cont in patt, inc 1 st at each end of next 3 RS rows. Work 1 WS row. Cast on 2 sts at beg of next 4 rows, 3 sts at beg of next 6 rows, 4 sts at beg of next 12 rows, 8 sts at beg of next 6 rows = 191 (199) sts. Work increased sts into patt. Change to circular needle when necessary. Work even in patt for 26 (28) rows and sleeve meas 10 (11) cm. Shape neck: Next row (RS): Bind off center 7 sts. Working each side separately, bind off 3 sts at each neck edge 3 times. Bind off rem rem 83 (87) sts for each shoulder/ overarm.

Left front: With size 6 mm needles cast on 7 (11) sts. Knit 1 WS row. Work in chart patt and shape front edge as foll: Cast on 2 sts at end of next RS row, then inc 1 st at end of next 3 RS rows, then every alt RS row 7 times. **At same time**, when 14 rows have been worked in chart patt and piece meas 6 cm from cast-on, shape sleeve at right edge same as for back = 83 (87) sts. Work increased sts into patt. Change to circular needle when necessary. Work even in patt for 34 (36) rows and sleeve meas 13 (14) cm. Bind off rem 83 (87) shoulder/ overarm sts.

Right front: Work same as left front, reversing all shaping and patt placement.

Finishing: Pin pieces to measurements and block. Sew shoulder/overarm seams. <u>Sleeve edging</u>: With shortest size 5.5 mm circular needle, pick up and k 40 (43) sts along bottom edge of sleeve. Beg with a WS row, work in welt patt for 6 rows and edging meas 2 cm from pick-up row. Loosely bind off all sts. Sew side and sleeve seams. <u>Front edging</u>: With size 5 mm circular needle, pick up and k 218 (224) sts evenly around entire edge of bolero. Place beg of rnd marker and join for working in rnds. Work welt patt in rnds for 6 rnds. Change to size 5.5 mm circular needle. Cont in welt patt for 6 rnds. Change to size 6 mm circular needle. Cont in welt patt for 12 rnds and edging meas 7 cm from pick-up rnd. Loosely bind off all sts.




Chart key:

= k1


— = p1

= p3tog





Gauge Swatch

Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.



Abbreviations

beg = begin(ning) \cdot **ch** = chain \cdot **cont** = continue \cdot **dec** = decreas(e)(ing) \cdot **inc** = increas(e)(ing) \cdot **k** = knit \cdot **kwise** = as if to knit **meas** = measures \cdot **M1L** = lift strand between sts from front to back and knit this strand through the back loop \cdot **M1R** = lift strand between sts from the back and knit this strand through the front loop \cdot **patt** = pattern \cdot **pm** = place marker \cdot **p** = purl **pwise** = as if to purl \cdot **rem** = remain(ing) \cdot **rep** = repeat(s) \cdot **rev St st** = reverse stockinette stitch \cdot **rnd(s)** = round(s) \cdot **RS** = right side \cdot **sc** = single crochet \cdot **skp** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 1 stitch, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch \cdot **sk2p** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 2 together, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch \cdot **s2kp** = slip 2 stitches as if to knit, k 1 stitch, pass slipped stitches over knitted stitch \cdot **s1** = slip \cdot **st(s)** = stitch(es) \cdot **St st** = stockinette stitch \cdot **tbl** = through the back loop \cdot **tog** = together \cdot **wyib** = with yarn in back of work \cdot **wyif** = with yarn in front of work \cdot **WS** = wrong side \cdot **yo(s)** = yarn over(s)
