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TOP · GOMITOLO DENIM
Design 09 – Filati Gomitolo 05

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Size 36/38 (40/42, 44)

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

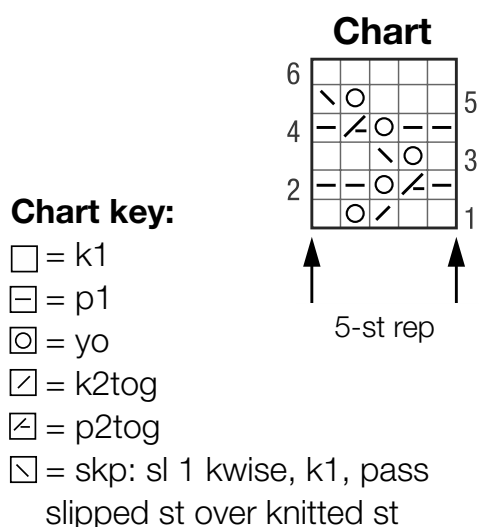
Materials: 200 (200, 400) g of Lana Grossa **Gomitolo Denim** (80% cotton, 20% polyamide; 740 m/200 g) in Emerald (col 9). Size 4 mm needles; size 3.5 mm crochet hook.

Rib patt: P2, k2.

Main patt: Work according to chart. Multiple of 5 + 2 selvage sts (not shown on chart). Numbers at right edge of chart indicate RS rows, numbers at left edge of chart indicate WS rows. Rep rows 1 – 6.

Gauge: 20 sts and 28 rows = 10 x 10 cm in main patt on size 4 mm needles.

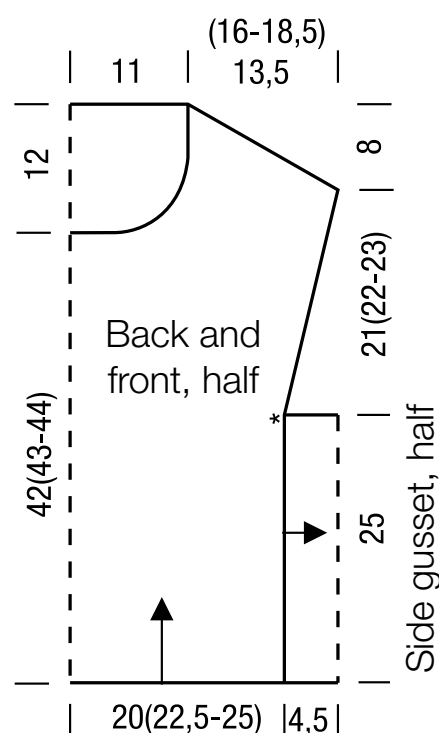
Back: With size 4 mm needles cast on 82 (92, 102) sts. Purl 1 WS row. Next row (RS): Selvage st, work row 1 of main patt chart to last st [= 16 (18, 20) patt reps], selvage st. Cont to foll chart until piece meas 25 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape sleeve caps: Cont in patt, inc 1 st at each end of next RS row, then every 6th row 8 times (then every alt 6th and 8th row 8 times / then every alt 6th and 8th row 8 times) = 100 (110, 120) sts. Work increased sts into patt. Work even until piece meas 46 (47, 48) cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape shoulders/overarms: Bind off 3 (3, 4) sts at beg of next 2 rows, then 3 sts at beg of next 10 rows, 2 sts at beg of next 10 rows (then 3 sts at beg of next 20 rows / then 4 sts at beg of next 8 rows, 3 sts at beg of next 12 rows). Bind off rem 44 sts.



Front: Work same as back until piece meas 42 (43, 44) cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape neck: Next row (RS): Bind off center 14 sts. Working each side separately, bind off 3 sts at each neck edge 1 time, 2 sts 2 times, 1 st 8 times. At same time, when piece meas 46 (47, 48) cm from cast-on, shape shoulders/overarms as foll: At each shoulder edge bind off 3 (3, 4) sts 1 time, then 3 sts 5 times, 2 sts 5 times (then 3 sts 10 times / then 4 sts 4 times, 3 sts 6 times). No sts rem.

Right side gusset: Place marker at right side edge of front, 25 cm up from cast-on edge. With size 4 mm needles and RS facing, pick up and k 68 sts evenly between marker and cast-on edge. Next row (WS): Selvage st, * p2, k2; rep from * to last 3 sts, p2, selvage st. Cont in rib patt as established until piece meas 9 cm from pick-up row. Bind off all sts in rib. Rep for left side gusset at left side edge of front.

Finishing: Pin pieces to measurements and block, omitting side gussets. Sew shoulder seams. Sew top edge of side gussets to right and left side edge of back. Neck edging: With size 3.5 mm crochet hook work 2 rnds sc around neck edge. Armhole edging: With size 3.5 mm crochet hook work 2 rows sc along each armhole edge, omitting top edge of side gusset.



Gauge Swatch

Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.
